

#### Cutting

**Note:** All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to the selvages) unless noted otherwise. All seams are ½".

### A. 259984 Q (panel)

Cut panel 32½" x 40½"

## B. 25986 J (Garden Mist)

• Cut (3) 4½" strips; subcut (21) 4½" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half to yield forty-two half-square triangles.

# C. 23528 KZ (Color Blends - Ash)

• Cut (2) 5½" strips; subcut (10) 5½" squares and (1) 4½" square. Cut the 5½" squares diagonally in both directions to yield forty quarter-square triangles. Cut the 4½" square diagonally in half to yield two half-square triangles.

## D. 23528 KJ (Color Blends - Charcoal)

- Cut (4) 1½" strips; subcut (2) 1½" x 40½" strips and (2) 1½" x 34½" strips.
- Cut (6) 2½" strips for binding.

### E. 21518 Z (Illusions - White Pinwheel Floral Print)

- Cut (4) 1½" strips. Sew together end to end with diagonal seams; press. Cut (2) 1½" x 36½" strips and (2) 1½" x 42½" strips.
- Cut (5) 1½" strips. Sew together end to end with diagonal seams; press. Cut (2) 1½" x 46½" strips and (2) 1½" x 52½" strips.
- Cut (2) 51/4" strips; subcut (10) 51/4" squares and (2) 41/8" squares. Cut the 51/4" squares diagonally in both directions to yield forty quarter-square triangles. Cut the 41/8" squares diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles.

#### Construction

- 1. Sew one (D) 1½" x 40½" strip to both sides of the panel. Sew one (D) 1½" x 34½" strip to the top and bottom of the panel. Press toward the strips.
- 2. Sew one (E) 1½" x 42½" strip to both sides of the panel. Sew one (E) 1½" x 36½" strip to the top and bottom of the panel. Press toward the strips.
- 3. Sew one (C) 5¼" triangle to one (E) 5¼" triangle as shown. Press toward the (C) triangle. Repeat to make twenty-two units.

**4.** Sew one (B) 4%" triangle to the long side of one unit from step 3. Press toward the (B) triangle. Repeat to complete twenty-two side border units.

**5.** Sew one (C) 51/4" triangle to one (E) 51/4" triangle as shown. Press toward the (C) triangle. Repeat to make eighteen units.

**6.** Sew one (B) 41/8" triangle to the long side of one unit from step 5. Press toward the (B) triangle. Repeat to complete eighteen top/bottom border units.



**7.** Sew one (C) 4% triangle to one (E) 4% triangle. Press toward the (C) triangle. Repeat to make two corner units.

**8.** Sew one (B) 4% triangle to one (E) 4% triangle. Press toward the (B) triangle. Repeat to make two corner units.

**9.** Sew eleven side border units together as shown. Press. Repeat.

10. Sew nine top/bottom border units together as shown. Press. Repeat.

**11.** Sew one of each corner unit to the ends of each top/bottom border as shown. Press toward the corner units.



12. Sew the side borders to the quilt and press toward the inner white borders. Sew the top/bottom borders to the quilt and press toward the inner white borders.



**13.** Sew one (E)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $52\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward the strips. Sew one (E) 11/2" x 461/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the strips.

# **Finishing**

- 1. Prepare backing and press. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Trim layers even with quilt top.
- 3. Prepare binding using (D) 2½" strips. Sew binding to quilt using your preferred method.
