Assembling Block 1

1. Using colored fabrics 3-16 squares and white fabrics 26-31, sew a colored square to the left side of a white square. Press toward the colored square. Make 21 units.



Make 21 different colored/white units

2. Sew two units from step 1 together to form a 4-patch block. Press open. Make 7 units.




Make 7 different units

3. Sew a step 1 unit to the bottom of a step 2 unit. Press open. Make 2 units.



Make 2 different units


4. Sew 5 step 2 units together in a row. Press open.



5. Sew the step 3 units to each side of Salem 1. Press open.



6. Sew the remainder of the step 1 units in a row. Press open.



7. Sew the step 4-6 rows together as shown below to make Block #1. Press open.



Assembling Block 2

8. Sew the large fabric 17 rectangle to the top of Salem 4. Press open.



9. Sew the fabric 18 rectangle to the bottom of the step 8 unit. Press open.




10. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of fabric 19 to the right side of the step 9 unit to make Block #2. Pess open.

Assembling Block 3

11. Sew the fabric 20 rectangle to the left side of Salem 3 to make Block #3. Press open.





Assembling Block 4


12. Sew the fabric 3 rectangle to the bottom of Salem 6. Press open.



13. Sew the fabric 7 rectangle to the left side of the step 12 unit. Sew the fabric 8 rectangle to the right side. Press open.




14. Sew the fabric 4 rectangle to the bottom of Salem 2. Press open.



15. Sew the fabric 9 rectangle to the left side of step 3. Sew the fabric 10 rectangle to the right side. Press open.



16. Sew the step 13 and step 15 units together to make Block #4. Press open.



Block #4

Assembling Block 5

17. Sew the fabric 2 rectangle to the bottom of Salem 5. Press open.



18. Sew the fabric 11 rectangle to the top of the step 17 unit. Press open.



19. Sew the fabric 6 rectangle to the left side of the step 18 unit. Sew the fabric 5 rectangle to the right side of the unit to make Block #5. Press open.



Block #5

Assembling Block 6

20. Using black/gray fabrics 17-24 squares and white fabrics 26-31, sew a black/gray square to the right side of a white square. Press toward the black/gray square. Make 21 units.



Make 21 different units

21. Sew two units from step 20 together to form a 4-patch block. Press open. Make 7 units.





22. Sew a step 20 unit to the bottom of a step 21 unit. Press open. Make 2 units.



Make 2 different units

23. Sew the remainder of the step 20 units together in a row. Press open.



24. Sew the step 22 units to each side of Salem 7. Press open.



25. Sew 5 step 21 units together in a row. Press open.



26. Sew the step 23-25 rows together to make Block #6. Press open.



Block #6

Assembling the Quilt

27. Sew the blocks into rows as shown below, then sew the rows together. Press seams as indicated.

Inner Border 1 and Inner Border 2

- 28. For inner border 1, measure the width of the quilt through the middle. Trim two fabric 21 borders to this length. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.
- 29. Measure the height of the quilt through the middle. Trim two fabric 21 borders to this length. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders.
- 30. For inner border 2, repeat the procedure in steps 28-29 with the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips fabric 25. (Depending on your quilt size at this point and the total width of fabric 25, you may need to piece these borders.)

Outer Borders

32. Alternating colored fabrics 3-16 squares and the black/gray fabrics 17-24 squares, sew together in 2 rows of 22 squares and 2 rows of 28 squares. Press open. (There will be 4 colored and 1 black/gray square left over.)



- 33. Sew the rows of 22 squares to the top and bottom of the quilt as shown. Press toward the inner borders.
- 34. Sew the rows of 28 squares to the sides of the quilt as shown. Press toward the inner borders.

Finishing the Quilt

- 35. Layer, baste and quilt as desired.
- 36. Sew the binding strips together with diagonal seams pressed open. Fold the binding in half, wrong sides together and press to make a double binding. Sew to the quilt with a 3/8" seam allowance, mitering the corners.
- 37. Trim the excess batting and backing, then turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
