



2 yards	Dot - Red (B)	8850-88
1 ¹ / ₄ yards	Wildflower - Dk. Blue (C)	8852-77

1 ½ yards	Master Floral - Dk. Blue (E)	8848-77
1 1/8 yards	108" Solid - Ivory (F)	Ivory-44

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Red Version fabrics are listed second in () if different from Blue Version.

From the Medium Flower Toss - Lt. Blue (Wildflower - Lt. Blue Multi) (A), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.
- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Dot - Red (Wildflower - Red) (B), cut:

- (5) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 1/8" squares.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 ½" squares.

From the Wildflower - Dk. Blue (Dot - Lt. Blue) (C), cut:

- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (6) 2 \%" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 \%" squares.

From the Dot - Lt. Blue (Dot - Red) (D), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 70 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 58 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Master Floral - Dk. Blue (Master Floral - Red) (E), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 66 ½" strips.

From the 108" Solid - Ivory (F), cut:


• (5) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (160) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Master Floral - Lt. Blue (Medium Floral Toss - Red) (Backing), cut:

• (2) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 88" back.

Sewing Instructions

- 1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strip and (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip together lengthwise to make (1) CA strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (10) CA strip sets total.
- 2. Cut the CA strip sets into (160) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).
- 3. Sew (2) Unit 1 strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (80) Unit 2 blocks total.



4. Place (1) 2 %" Fabric F square on top of (1) 2 %" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 4). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5). Trim blocks to measure $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 3 blocks (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (160) Unit 3 blocks total.

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
5. Repeat Step 4 using (80) 2 %" Fabric F squares and (80) 2 %" Fabric B squares to make (160) 2 ½" Unit 4 blocks (Fig. 7).



6. Follow Figure 8 and sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square, (2) Unit 4 blocks, (2) Unit 3 blocks and (1) Unit 2 block together to make (1) Unit 5 block. Repeat to make (80) Unit 5 blocks total.




7. Sew (1) Unit 5 block to each side of 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.



Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 8. Sew (4) Block One squares together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (5) rows total.
- 9. Sew the (5) rows together to make the Center Block.
- 10. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 70 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 72 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 66 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 14. Bind as desired.
