

Wilmington Prints: A World of Possibilities

Twin/Large Throw 64" x 69 1/2"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 2 panels to approximately 20-3/4" x 24-3/4"

Fabric B - Cut (2) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 9-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (6) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" and (2) 4-1/2" x 59" borders

Fabric D - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (7) 2"strips, subcut (80) 2"x 3-1/2"strips


Fabric G - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (40) 2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (13) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2"x 67", (2) 2"x 64-1/2", (2) 2"x 56", (2) 2"x 53-1/2", and (1) 2"x 50-1/2" borders

Fabric I - Cut (8) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (4) 2-3/8" x 26" and (4) 2-3/8" x 25" strips

2. Piecing Order:


 Sew Fabric I 2-3/8" x 26" strips to the
 24-3/4" long sides of a Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add Fabric I 2-3/8"x 26" strips




to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 23-1/2" x 27-1/2" (unfinished). Make 2 Section 1.

> Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.


Section 1 Make 2 Arrange 2 Fabric F 2" x 3-1/2" strips,
 Fabric E 3-1/2" square, and 1 Fabric G 2" square in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows.
 Sew rows together. Make a total of 20 Unit 1 (5" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 5 each Units 2-5 using fabrics indicated.




 Arrange 2 each Unit 1,
 Unit 2, and 1 Unit 3 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 1 (9-1/2" square unfinished).




4. Arrange 2 each Units 1, 1 Unit 4, and 1 Unit 5 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 2 (9-1/2" square unfinished).



 Arrange 5 Block 1 and 4 Fabric B 9-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows.
 Sew rows together to complete Section 2 (27-1/2" square unfinished).



 Arrange 5 Block 2 and 4 Fabric B 9-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Section 3 (27-1/2" square unfinished).




- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of sections and borders.
- Arrange sections and Fabric H 2"x 50-1/2" border in 3 rows. Sew sections into rows. Sew rows and border together to complete quilt center (50-1/2"x 56" unfinished).

- Stitch Fabric H 2"x 56" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric H 2"x 53-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 10. Stitch Fabric C 4-1/2" x 59" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric C 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 11. Stitch Fabric H 2"x 67" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric H 2"x 64-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 12. The quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 70" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric D) and enjoy!!


