

Cutting Instructions - Boy Version

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Blocks Panel - Navy (A), fussy cut:

- (9) 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (B), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (5) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Orange (C), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Words - Navy (D), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Teal (E), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Characters - Teal (F), cut:

- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Bee Honeycomb - Lt. Teal (G), cut:

- (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Tan (H), cut:

- (3) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (I), cut:


- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Characters - Lt. Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 60" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 76" back.

Sewing Instructions - Boy Version

1. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (9) Unit 1 blocks total.



2. Place (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H square on top of (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim blocks to measure 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (32) Unit 2 squares total.



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
3. Repeat Step 2 using (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G squares and (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H squares to make (4) Unit 3 squares (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Step 2 using (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E squares and (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B squares to make (4) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 6).
5. Repeat Step 2 using (12) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C squares and (12) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B squares to make (24) Unit 5 squares (Fig. 7).
6. Repeat Step 2 using (10) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E squares and (10) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D squares to make (20) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 8).




7. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block One (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.




8. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 10).



9. Sew (8) Unit 2 squares together to make (1) border strip. Repeat to make a second border strip. Sew (1) border strip to each side of the Unit 7 block to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 11).



10. Sew (2) Block Ones together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two to make Center Block (Fig. 12).



Quilt Top Assembly - Boy Version

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

11. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip and (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip together lengthwise to make (1) long FI strip. Repeat to make (4) long FI strips total.

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12. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip and (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric I strip together lengthwise to make (1) short FI strip. Repeat to make (4) short FI strips total.

13. Sew (1) Unit 4 and (1) Unit 5 together. Sew (1) long FI strip to the top and to the bottom of the new strip to make (1) side strip. Sew (6) Unit 6 squares and (6) Unit 5 squares together, alternating them. Sew this strip to the side strip lengthwise to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) Unit 4 and (1) Unit 5 together. Sew (1) short FI strip to each side of the new strip to make (1) top strip. Sew (4) Unit 5 squares and (4) Unit 6 squares together, alternating them. Sew this strip and the top strip together lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 1 block to each end of the new


strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the units and strips.

15. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Blocks Panel - Navy (A), fussy cut:

- (9) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (B), cut:

- (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (5) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (22) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Rose (C), cut:

- (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Words - Navy (D), cut:

- (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (E), cut:

- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Characters - Pink (F), cut:

- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Bee Honeycomb - Pink (G), cut:

- (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Tan (H), cut:

- (3) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the Starry Basics - Red (I), cut:


- (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Characters - Lt. Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 60" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 76" back.

Sewing Instructions - Girl Version

1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (9) Unit 1 blocks total.



2. Place (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H square on top of (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim blocks to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Unit 2 squares total.







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3. Repeat Step 2 using (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G squares and (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H squares to make (4) Unit 3 squares (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Step 2 using (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E squares and (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B squares to make (4) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 6).
5. Repeat Step 2 using (12) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C squares and (12) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B squares to make (24) Unit 5 squares (Fig. 7).
6. Repeat Step 2 using (10) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E squares and (10) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D squares to make (20) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 8).
7. Repeat Step 2 using (8) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I squares and (8) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H squares to make (16) Unit 7 squares (Fig. 9).









8. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block One (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.

9. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Unit 8 block (Fig. 11).





10. Sew (8) Unit 2 squares together to make (1) border strip. Repeat to make a second border strip. Sew (1) border strip to each side of the Unit 8 block to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 12).



11. Sew (2) Block Ones together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two to make Center Block (Fig. 13).



Quilt Top Assembly - Girl Version

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* while assembling.)

12. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip and (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make (1) long FE strip. Repeat to make (4) long FE strips total.

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13. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip and (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make (1) short FE strip. Repeat to make (4) short FE strips total.

14. Sew (1) Unit 4 and (1) Unit 5 together. Sew (1) long FE strip to the top and to the bottom of the new strip to make (1) side strip. Sew (6) Unit 6 squares and (6) Unit 5 squares together, alternating them. Sew this strip to the side strip lengthwise to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) Unit 4 and (1) Unit 5 together. Sew (1) short FE strip to each side of the new strip to make (1) top strip. Sew (4) Unit 5 squares and (4) Unit 6 squares together, alternating them. Sew this strip and the top strip together


lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 1 block to each end of the new strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the units and strips.

16. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

17. Layer and quilt as desired.

18. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

19. Bind as desired.
