# Tivoli Garden by Anne Rowan



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Twin Quilt: 64" x 84"

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Queen Quilt: 83" x 93"





Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

### 1. Cut the following for Throw Quilt:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 21-1/2" x 40-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 7" x 67", (1) 7" x 55", (1) 7" x 52", and (1) 7" x 40" floral stripe borders. Cut each border in half lengthwise for (2) 3-1/2" x 67", (2) 3-1/2" x 55", (2) 3-1/2" x 52", and 2) 3-1/2" x 40" floral stripe borders.

Fabric C - Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (30) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 60 triangles

Fabric D - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 32" strips

Fabric E - Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (30) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 60 triangles Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares strips

Fabric F - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" and (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips for flat piping

Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strip for flat piping

### 2. Piecing Order for Throw Quilt:

 Sew 1 each Fabrics C and E 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 60 Triangle Units (3-1/2" square unfinished).



Triangle Unit Make 60

 Refer to Throw Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, triangle units, squares, and borders.

- Stitch Fabric D 5-1/2"x width of fabric strips to sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 3-1/2"x 32" Fabric D strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 30-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).
- 4. Fold and press Fabric F 1-1/2"x 45-1/2" and 1-1/2"x 30-1/2" strips in half lengthwise, right side out, forming 3/4" wide flat piping strips.
- 5. Baste 3/4" x 45-1/2" **Fabric F** flat piping strips on top of sides of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric D** border. Baste 3/4" x 30-1/2" **Fabric F** flat piping on top of top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric D** border.


6. Center Fabric B 3-1/2" x 55" borders on right and left sides of bordered panel and Fabric B 3-1/2" x 40" borders on top and bottom of bordered panel with the dark edges next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.



7. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.

- Arrange 16 triangle units and 1 Fabric E 3-1/2" square in vertical rows on each side of the quilt.
   Sew into rows (3-1/2" x 51-1/2" unfinished).
   Stitch to right and left sides of quilt.
- Arrange 14 triangle units in horizontal rows on top and bottom of the quilt. Sew into rows (3-1/2" x 42-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to top and bottom of quilt.
- 10. Center Fabric B 3-1/2"x 67" borders on right and left sides of bordered panel and Fabric B 3-1/2"x 52" borders on top and bottom of quilt with the floral edges next to quilt center. Refer to Steps 6 and 7 to stitch and miter borders.
- 11. The throw quilt measures approximately 48-1/2" x 63-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric I) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!

#### 3. Cut the following for Twin Quilt:

#### Fabrics A, B, C, D, and E: Refer to Throw Quilt cutting directions

- Fabric F Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
  Cut (9) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to
  end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 68-1/2",
  (2) 1-1/2" x 53-1/2", (2) 1-1/2" x 45-1/2", and
  (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips for flat piping
  Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2"
  strip for flat piping
- Fabric G Cut (6) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 63-1/2" and (2) 3" x 53-1/2" borders
- Fabric H Cut (4) 8-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 8-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders
- Cut (4) 6" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 6" x 68-1/2" borders

### 4. Piecing Order for Twin Quilt:

- Refer to Piecing Order for Throw Quilt Steps
   1-10 to make quilt center.
- Refer to Twin Quilt Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of quilt center, flat piping strips, and borders.
- Stitch Fabric G 3"x 63-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric G 3"x 53-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- Fold and press Fabric F 1-1/2"x 68-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" strips in half lengthwise, right side out, forming 3/4" wide flat piping strips.
- 5. Baste 3/4" x 68-1/2" **Fabric F** flat piping strips on top of sides of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric G** border. Baste 3/4" x 53-1/2" **Fabric F** flat piping on top of top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric G** border.
- 6. Stitch Fabric H 6" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press toward borders leaving flat piping over Fabric G borders. Add Fabric H 8-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward borders leaving flat piping over Fabric G borders.
- 7. The twin quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 84-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric I) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!



#### 5. Cut the following for Queen Quilt:

## Fabrics A, B, D, and E:

Refer to Throw Quilt cutting directions

- Fabric C Cut (4) 9-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 9-1/2"x 68-1/2" borders
- Cut (4) 8" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 8" x 71-1/2" borders
- Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (30) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 60 triangles
- Fabric F Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
  Cut (9) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to
  end and cut into (2) 1-1/2"x 68-1/2",
  (2) 1-1/2"x 53-1/2", (2) 1-1/2"x 45-1/2", and
  (1) 1-1/2"x 30-1/2" strips for flat piping
  Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2"
  strip for flat piping
- Fabric G Cut (6) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 63-1/2" and (2) 3" x 53-1/2" borders
- Fabric H Cut (4) 6-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 6-1/2"x 83-1/2" borders
- Cut (4) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 83-1/2" borders


#### 6. Piecing Order for Queen Quilt:

- Refer to Piecing Order for Throw Quilt Steps
   1-10 to make quilt center.
- Refer to Piecing Order for Twin Quilt Steps
   to add Fabric G border and Fabric F flat piping strips.
- Refer to Queen Quilt Layout (Page 6) for arrangement and placement of quilt center, flat piping strips, and borders.
- 4. Stitch Fabric C 9-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Press borders out so Fabric F flat piping lays over Fabric G border. Add Fabric C 8"x 71-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press borders out so Fabric F flat piping lays over Fabric G border.
- Stitch Fabric H 6-1/2" x 83-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric H 5-1/2" x 83-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- The queen quilt measures approximately 83-1/2" x 93-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric I) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size. Arrow indicates orientation of directional print.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.



Fabric C Q3007-68402-930 S 1/2 yd. Q 2-5/8 yds.



Fabric D Q3007-68404-117 TW 1/2 yd. All sizes 5/8 yd.



Fabric E Q3007-68407-319 All sizes 5/8 yd.



Fabric F (flat insert & binding) Q1825-85507-700 S 7/8 yd. TW 1-1/4yds. Q 5/8 yd. Q1-3/8 yds.



Fabric G Q3007-68405-331 TW 5/8 yd.



Fabric H Q3007-68408-133 TW 1-7/8 yds. Q 1-5/8 yds.



Fabric I (backing only) Q3007-68406-138 OR S 3-1/4 yds. TW 5-1/4 yds. Q 7-3/4 yds.



Fabric I (108" backing) Q1054-2079-109 TW 2-1/8 yds. Q 2-2/3 yds.
