



Please Read and Follow Instructions Carefully to Ensure a Successful Project! Did you know? **Cutting Instructions:**

- A. Panel or Theme Fabric (Q4428-449)*: Centering Design, cut 32 1/2" x 40 1/2"
- B. Panel Frame / Inner Border (1895-515): Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF** strips

Subcut (3) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips

Set aside remaining strips for side inner border

the rest of the pattern design. C. Majestic Moose Blocks, Half Square Triangles Dark (1895-39, 1895-51, 1895-173, 1895-464, 1895-545): Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strips from EACH of 5 fabrics

Subcut (4) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares from each for a total of 20 squares

D. Majestic Moose Blocks, Half Square Triangles One Light (1895-597):

Cut (5) 2 7/8" x WOFQ*** strips

Subcut (30) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares - Cut (10) squares in half diagonally

E. Majestic Moose Blocks, Large Accent (1895-239):

Cut (2) 10 7/8" x 10 7/8" squares, Subcut each in half diagonally

F. Outer Border (885-407):

Cut (6) 3" WOF strips

G. Binding (885-407):

Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF

WOF = Width of Fabric Selvage to Selvage *WOFQ = Width of Fat Quarter

Note: All measurements are based on a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

Piecing Instructions:

Panel Border:

Using (2) (B) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Panel Border strips, join to Top and Bottom of Panel Fabric. See Diagram 1. Press seams toward Border


Piecing Continued:

Majestic Moose Blocks:

Half Square Triangles:

Following Diagram 2, below, take one (C) Majestic Moose 2 7/8" square fabric and one (D) Majestic Moose 2 7/8" square fabric. Place the (C) Majestic Moose 2 7/8" square right sides together with a (D) Majestic Moose 2 7/8" square. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of diagonal line. Cut squares on diagonal line to create two half square triangle blocks. Press seams toward Darker fabric. Repeat using remaining (C) 2 7/8" and (D) 2 7/8" fabrics. Make (40) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Half Square Triangle Blocks.










Open block and press seam toward Dark fabric. Blocks will measure 2 1/2" square. Make (40) blocks.

Majestic Moose Blocks:

Following Diagram 3, below, join Half Square Triangle blocks made above, (D) Triangles and (E) Triangles to create your Majestic Moose Blocks. Vary colors and placement in your blocks as desired. Join blocks horizontally in rows, then join rows. When all rows have been joined, including top triangle, join (E) Large Accent Triangle. This is a long bias edge, handle gently to not stretch.













Square will measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2". Make (2).

Reversing the direction of the triangles, repeat above process. Make (2) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares.










Square will measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2". Make (2).


Following Diagram 5, join Majestic Moose blocks into a row. Attach your row to the bottom of Panel segment created on Pg. 1. Add a (B) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Panel/Inner Border strip to the bottom of Majestic Moose row. Top will now measure 48 1/2" x 40 1/2".

Layout Diagram

Following Border instructions, add side Inner Borders and Outer Borders.



Borders:

To determine the length of the inner side borders, measure quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using (B) 2 1/2" Inner Border strips, cut to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach border strips to sides of quilt. Press seams toward inner border.

To determine the length of the outer side borders, measure quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using (F) 3" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach border strips to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer border. Next, measure quilt through the middle from side to side to determine the length of the top and bottom outer borders. Using remaining (F) 3" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach to the top and bottom of quilt and press seams toward outer border. Quilt will now measure 53.5" x 49.5" (if using a 32 1/2" x 40 1/2" center panel).

Quilting:

Sandwich quilt top with batting and backing. Baste layers together and quilt as desired to enhance design. **Binding:**

Join together (G) 2 1/2" Binding strips and bind using your favorite method.
