

⅓ yard	Scenic - Green (A)	8910-66
3/8 yard	Splash - Night (B)	3504-Night
1/8 yard	Splash - Wine (C)	3504-Wine
1/8 yard	Logs - Ecru (D)	8909-44
1/4 yard	Fishing Lures - Black (E)	8912-99
⅓ yard	Leaves - Rust (F)	8914-33
1/4 yard	Pine Cones - Green (G)	8913-66
½ yard	Animal Pawprints - Brown (H)	8915-39
½ yard	Words with Animals - Black (I)	8908-99
1 ½ yards	Eclipse - Chocolate (J)	3955-Chocolate*
1 ½ yards	Fish Patch - Green (K)	8911-66
4 yards	Patch - Brown (Backing)	8907-39

Cutting Instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic - Green (A), cut:

• (4) 12 ½" squares.

From the Splash - Night (B), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.

From the Splash - Wine (C), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" squares.

From the Logs - Ecru (D), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" squares and (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Fishing Lures - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Leaves - Rust (F), cut:

• (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips, (4) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips and (6) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

From the Pine Cones - Green (G), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips and (4) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Animal Pawprints - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips and (4) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Words with Animals - Black (I), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 14 ½" strips.

Page 1

From the Eclipse - Chocolate (J), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Fish Patch – Green (K), cut:

• (4) 5 ½" x 46 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Patch - Brown (Backing), cut:

• (2) 68" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68" x 68" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 12 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.





- 2. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to make (1) ECE strip. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the ECE strip to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2).
- 3. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3)






- 4. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 4).
- 5. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to the left side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) DC strip. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of the DC strip to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.




- 6. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric E strip to the right side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.
- 7. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric G strip to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric G strip to the top of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.




- 8. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the right side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric F strip to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.
- 9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric H strip to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric H strip to the top of the Unit 6 square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 squares total.

10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½"
Fabric I strip to the right side of (1) Unit 7 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric I strip to the bottom of the Unit 7 square to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Block Threes total.




Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 11. Sew (2) Block Threes and (1) Block One together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 12. Sew (2) Block Ones and (1) Block Two together, alternating them, to make Row Two.
- 13. Sew the rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric H square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric K strip to make (1) top border. Repeat to make (1) bottom border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 17. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 18. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 19. Bind as desired.
