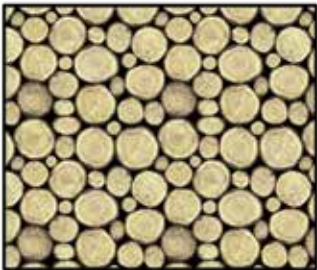

1/8 yard	Logs - Ecru (D)	8909-44
1/4 yard	Fishing Lures - Black (E)	8912-99
3/8 yard	Leaves - Rust (F)	8914-33
1/4 yard	Pine Cones - Green (G)	8913-66
1/2 yard	Animal Pawprints - Brown (H)	8915-39
1/2 yard	Words with Animals - Black (I)	8908-99
1 1/2 yards	Eclipse - Chocolate (J)	3955-Chocolate*
1 1/2 yards	Fish Patch - Green (K)	8911-66
4 yards	Patch - Brown (Backing)	8907-39

Cutting Instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic - Green (A), cut:

- (4) 12 1/2" squares.

From the Splash - Night (B), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

From the Splash - Wine (C), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Logs - Ecru (D), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" squares and (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Fishing Lures - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and (2) 2 1/2" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.

From the Leaves - Rust (F), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips, (4) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (6) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Pine Cones - Green (G), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips and (4) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Animal Pawprints - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips and (4) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Words with Animals - Black (I), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips and (2) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

From the Eclipse - Chocolate (J), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Fish Patch - Green (K), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x 46 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Patch - Brown (Backing), cut:

- (2) 68" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68" x 68" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 12 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.

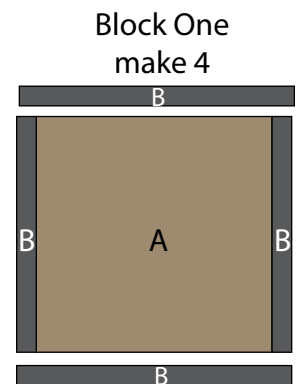

2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square to make (1) ECE strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the ECE strip to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3)

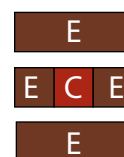

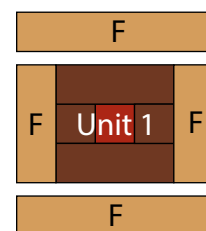

Quilt 1

4. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 4).

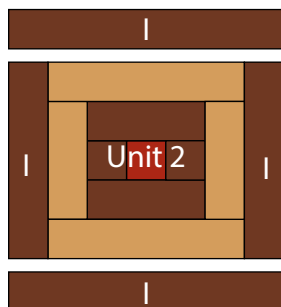

5. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square to make (1) DC strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top of the DC strip to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.

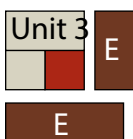

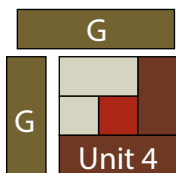

8. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric F strip to the right side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric F strip to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.

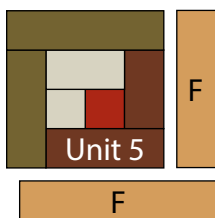

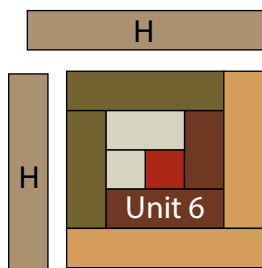

6. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip to the right side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric E strip to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.

7. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric G strip to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.

10. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric I strip to the right side of (1) Unit 7 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric I strip to the bottom of the Unit 7 square to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Block Threes total.

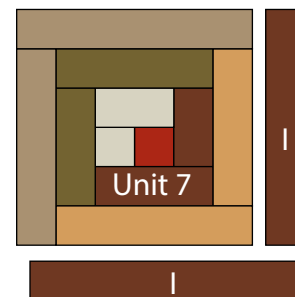

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

11. Sew (2) Block Threes and (1) Block One together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

12. Sew (2) Block Ones and (1) Block Two together, alternating them, to make Row Two.

13. Sew the rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

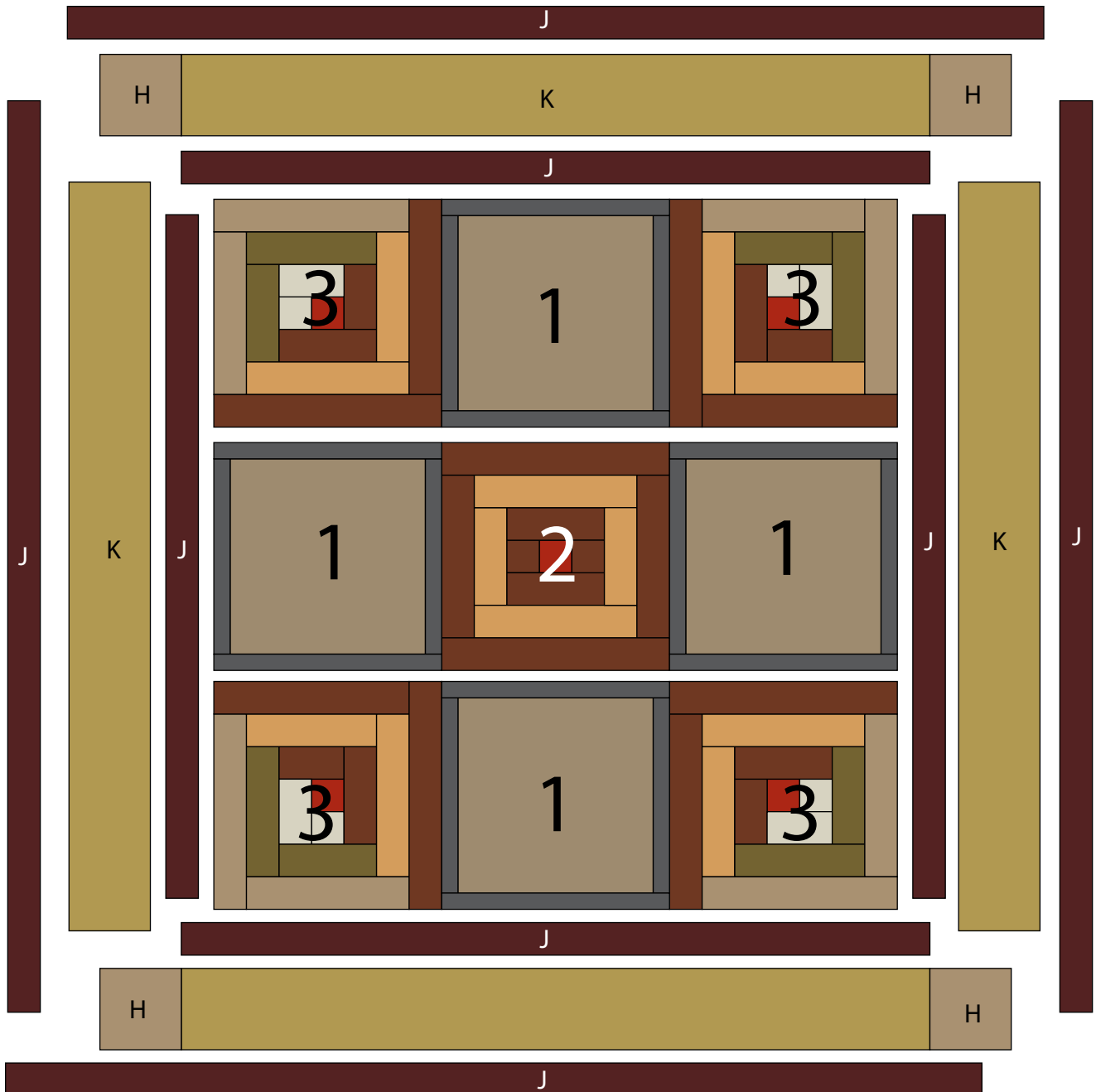
15. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) 5 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric K strip to make (1) top border. Repeat to make (1) bottom border. Sew the borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

17. Layer and quilt as desired.

18. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

19. Bind as desired.
