□ B. 2 rectangles, 5" x 11 ½"



□A. 1 rectangle, 7 ½" x 20"

□ B. 2 squares, 3 ½" x 3 ½" **□C.** 8 squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½"



□A. 2 strips, 3 ½" x 20"

□ B. 2 strips, 3 ½" x 7 ½"

DC. 2 squares, 3 ½" x 3 ½"


□ D. 8 rectangles, 2 ½" x 3"

Construction

1. With right sides together, pair a blue 3 ½" square with a brown 3 ½"square. Stitch a seam 1/4" from the points on the diagonal, using the "gray band alignment" (b) on the Clearly Perfect Angles. Rotate the square and stitch a second seam 1/4" from the points.


(Yeah! You don't need to draw any lines!)





2. Repeat with the remaining squares. Cut apart between the seams.


3. Using Slotted Trimmer B, square the half-square triangles to 3".

4. Create corner blocks by joining pieces as illustrated.

Construction

5. Press all of the blue 3 1/2" strips in half, the long way, wrong sides together.

Using a matching colored thread, stitch a seam ½" from the fold, creating a tuck.



Open the strips and press the tuck flat. (hint: align the crease with the seam to make sure the tuck is centered on the strip.)




6. Following the diagram, piece the topper together. When adding the blue strips, make sure the tuck is flat.



7. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired, avoiding catching tucks. (Aurifil threads used in sample: Variegated [#3817], Brown [#2360], Blue-green [2845])

8. On longest tucks, measure and mark 3 3/4" from the ends & a second mark 3 3/4" from the first mark.

On short sides, measure and mark 2 1/4" from each end.



9. Thread a needle with variegated thread, doubling thread, tie a knot in the end. Referring to the pictures, pinch tucks at the marks and "wrap" tucks tightly. I went around about 3x at each mark. Bury knots in back/batting.



10. Cut 2 1/4" strips from the remaining bird fabric for the binding. You will need approximately 115 linear inches. Attach binding in the usual manner.
