

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Folk Flower Toss - Black (A), cut:

• (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Folio - Chamois (B), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (6) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 3" x 4" strips.

From the Folio - Brown Bag (C), cut:

• (10) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Off White (D), cut:

- (10) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" x 6 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 3 1/8" squares.
- (3) 3 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 3 3/8" squares.

From the Folio - Sepia Brown (E), cut:

- (3) 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 3 1/8" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 72 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63 ½" strips.

From the Folk Flower Toss - Red (F), cut:

• (5) 6 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 6 1/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (60) triangles.

From the Chicken Toss - Black (G), fussy cut:

• (15) 4" squares on point, each centered on a rooster.

From the Berry Branches - Black (H), cut:

• (3) 3 ³/₈" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 3 ³/₈" squares.

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Border Shelf Stripe - Cream (J), cut:

- (2) 6" x 90" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6" x 78" LOF strips.

From the Star Check - Black (K), fussy cut:

- (5) 3 ½" x WOF strips, each centered on (2) rows of squares. Sew the strips together end to end, matching the seams. Cut (2) 3 ½" x 86 ½" strips.
- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips, each centered on (2) rows of squares. Sew the strips together end to end, matching the seams. Cut (2) 3 ½" x 80 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Red (L), cut:


• (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Berry Branches - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (3) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 88" x 100" back.

Sewing Instructions

- 1. Place (1) 3 1/8" Fabric D square on top of (1) 3 1/8" Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two halfsquare triangles. Trim blocks to measure 3 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (60) Unit 1 squares total.
- 2. Repeat Step 1 using (30) 3 \(^3\)e Fabric D squares and (30) 3 %" Fabric H squares to make (60) 3" Unit 2 squares (Fig. 4).



3. Sew (1) 2" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 2" x 6 ½" Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (60) Unit 3 strips total.







- 4. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip to make (1) ABA strip set (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second ABA strip set.
- 5. Cut the (2) ABA strip sets into (22) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Unit 4 strips (Fig. 7).



- 6. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip to make (1) BAB strip set (Fig. 8).
- 7. Cut the BAB strip set into (11) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Unit 5 strips (Fig. 9). Unit 5



8. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 5 strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 block (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (11) Unit 6 blocks total.

- 9. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 block. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 block to make (1) Block One (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (11) Block Ones total.
- 10. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric I square. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (4) Block Twos total.




11. Sew (1) 3" x 4" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 4" Fabric D square. Sew (1) Unit 2 to each end of (1) 3" x 4" Fabric B strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (15) Unit 7 blocks total.



12. Sew (1) Fabric F triangle to each side of (1) Unit 7 block to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (15) Block Threes total.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 13. Sew (1) Block One, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three and (1) Block One together, in that order, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Five.
- 14. Sew (3) Block Threes and (2) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four and Six.
- 15. Sew (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three, (1) Block One, (1) Block Three and (1) Block Two together, in that order, to make Row Three.
- 16. Sew the (6) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.
- 17. Sew (1) 2" x 72 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 63 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Center (1) 6" x 90" Fabric J strip on one side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
- 19. Repeat Step 18 to sew (1) 6" x 78" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 15).


20. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 15), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

21. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 86 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 80 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt

- 22. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 23. Sew the (9) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric L strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and
- 24. Bind as desired.
