$5 / 8$ yard Star Check - Black (C) 8805-99
$3 / 8$ yard Folk Flower Toss - Red (D) 8806-88
$3 / 8$ yard Berry Branches - Red (E) 8807-88
$1 / 2$ yard Folio - Off White (F) 7755-04
$1 / 4$ yard Folio - Black (G) 7755-99
$1 / 2$ yard Berry Branches - Black (H) 8807-99*
2 yards Chicken Toss - Red (Backing) 8804-88

Cutting Instructions - Wall Hanging/Runner
Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Welcome Panel - Black (A, Wall), fussy cut: - (1) $201 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ panel

## OR

From the Allover Scenic - Sage Green (A, Runner), fussy cut:

- (1) $201 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ strip.

From the Folio - Red (B), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 221 / 2$ " WOF strips.
From the Star Check - Black (C), fussy cut:
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, each centered on two rows of squares. Piece as needed.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 271 / 2 "$ WOF strips, each centered on two rows of squares.

From the Folk Flower Toss - Red (D), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (27) $31 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Berry Branches - Red (E), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (27) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio - Off White (F), cut:

- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (108) 2" squares.

From the Folio - Black (G), cut:
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 35^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.

From the Berry Branches - Black (H), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Chicken Toss - Red (Backing), cut:

- (1) 43 " $\times 64$ " strip for the back.

Wall Hanging/Runner Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Fabric A panel or strip. Sew (1) 2" x $221 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel or strip. Trim the block to measure $211 / 2 " \times 421 / 2$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) 2" Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

## PLAIN \& SIMPLE

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 2 " Fabric F square to the lower right corner of the $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (26) Unit 1 blocks total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (26) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E squares and (52) 2" Fabric F squares to make (26) Unit 2 blocks (Fig. 6).
6. Place (1) 2" Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "$ away from the sewn seam.
7. Follow Figure 7 for the seam direction to add a $2 "$ Fabric F square to the upper right corner of the $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 3 block (Fig. 7).
8. Repeat Steps 6-7 using (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square and (2) 2 " Fabric F squares to make (1) Unit 4 block (Fig. 8).

Wall Hanging/Runner Top Assembly (Refer to the Figure 9 while assembling.)
9. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (8) Unit 2 blocks and (8) Unit 1 blocks together, alternating them. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks.
11. Sew (6) Unit 1 blocks, (4) Unit 2 blocks and (1) Unit 3 block together. Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks. Sew this strip to the top of the Center Block.
12. Sew (6) Unit 2 blocks, (4) Unit 1 blocks and (1) Unit 4 block together. Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks. Sew this strip to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \gg \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 351 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the wall hanging or runner top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.

## Cutting Instructions - Place Mats

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Word of Wisdom - Brown (A):

- (1) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) $91 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Chicken Toss - Black (B), cut:

- (1) $81 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $91 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Folio - Sepia Brown (C), cut:

- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 1 " x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 1 " x 8 1/2" strips.


## From the Star Check - Red (D), fussy cut:

- (8) 2 " $\times 101 / 2 "$ strips, each centered on (1) row of squares.


## From the Berry Branches - Red (E), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folk Flower Toss - Red (F), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) $31 / 2$ " squares.

From the Folio - Off White (G), cut:
-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (64) 2 " squares.

## From the Folio - Black (H), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Chicken Toss - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 16 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16 " $\times 20$ " strips for the backs

Place Mat Sewing Instructions
17. Sew (1) 1 " $\times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $91 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip. Sew (1) $1 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 block.
18. Sew (1) $1 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $91 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip. Sew (1) 1" x $101 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B strip to make (1) Unit 6 block (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 block.

19. Place (1) 2 " Fabric G square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 13). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

20. Follow Figure 14 for the seam direction to add a 2 " Fabric G square to the lower right corner of the $31 / 2 \prime$ Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 15).
21. Repeat Steps 19-20 to make (16) Unit 7 blocks total.

22. Repeat Steps 19-20 using (16) $31 / 2$ " Fabric E squares and (32) 2" Fabric G squares to make (16) Unit 8 blocks (Fig. 16).

## Place Mat Assembly

## (Refer to the Figures 17 and 18 while assembling.)

23. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 5 block to make (1) Place Mat One Center Block. Repeat to make a second Place Mat One Center Block.
24. Sew (2) Unit 8 blocks and (2) Unit 7 blocks together, alternating them. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of (1) Place Mat One Center Block to make (1) Place Mat One (Fig. 17). Repeat to make a second Place Mat One.

25. Sew (1) $2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 6 block to make (1) Place Mat Two Center Block. Repeat to make a second Place Mat Two Center Block.
26. Sew (2) Unit 8 blocks and (2) Unit 7 blocks together, alternating them. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of (1) Place Mat Two Center Block to make (1) Place Mat Two (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Place Mat Two.
27. Layer and quilt as desired.
28. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Divide the long strip into (4) equal lengths.
29. Bind as desired.
