Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric
(WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the Panel - Cream (A), fussy cut:
-(1) $281 / 2$ " $\times 81 / 2$ " panel, centered on the "Summer" panel.

- (1) 31 " x 13 " panel, centered on the "Truck" panel.
- (1) $81 / 2$ " square panel, centered on the "Quilt Block" panel.

From the Words \& Stars - Cream (B), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Bud Flower - Red (C), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Leaf Sprigs - Medium Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 " $\times 111 / 2 "$ strips and
(2) 2 " $\times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Leaf Sprigs - Red (E), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Arrowheads - Green (F), cut:
- (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ square.
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 " $\times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " x $331 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 13 " strips.
-(2) 2 " x 34 " WOF strips.
From the Horseshoes - Blue (G), cut:
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Folk Calico-Olive (H), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Words \& Stars - Red (I), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Arrowheads - Cream/Red/Tan (J), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 " squares.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Folk Calico - Tan/Cream (K), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) $21 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Horseshoes - Cream/Red (L), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Words \& Stars - Navy (M), cut:

- (2) $61 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips. (CUT FIRST)
- (2) $61 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ length of fabric strips from the remaining fabric.

From the Novelty Toss - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 60 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60 " $\times 62$ " back.


## Quilt Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 3 " $\times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) $281 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric A "Summer" panel. Sew (1) 2" x $331 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $321 / 2 " \times 101 / 2$ " to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 13 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 31 " x 13 " Fabric A "Truck" panel. Sew (1) 2" x 34 " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $321 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).

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3. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $81 / 2 "$ Fabric A "Quilt Block" panel. Sew (1) 2" x $111 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel.
Trim the block to measure $101 / 2 "$ square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 3).

4. Sew (3) $21 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric C strips and (2) $21 / 2 " \times 22$ $1 / 2 "$ Fabric B strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 4). Sew the Unit 1 block to the left end of the Unit 2 block to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 5).

5. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric L square on the left side of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

6. Place another $21 / 2 "$ Fabric L square on the right side of the $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (11) Unit 3 strips total.

8. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric D strips and (22) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric J squares to make (11) Unit 4 strips (Fig. 10).
9. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric H strips and (22) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K squares to make (11) Unit 5 strips (Fig. 11).
10. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric C strips and (22) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric L squares to make (11) Unit 6 strips (Fig. 12).

11. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric G strips and (22) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric J squares to make (11) Unit 7 strips (Fig. 13).
12. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using (11) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric F strips and (22) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric K squares to make (11) Unit 8 strips (Fig. 14).
13. Repeat Steps $5-6$ using (16) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric J strips and (32) 2" Fabric E squares to make (16) Unit 9 strips (Fig. 15).

14. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric I square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric J square to each end of (1) Unit 9 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 sewn strip to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (4) Block Four squares total.

## Quilt Top Assembly <br> (Refer to Figure 17 while assembling.)

15. Sew the Block Three rectangle to the top of the Block Two rectangle. Sew the Block One rectangle to the top of the Block Three rectangle to make the Center Block.
16. Sew (17) assorted Unit strips together lengthwise. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
17. Sew (16) assorted Unit strips together lengthwise. Sew (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to each end of the sewn strip.

Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric $M$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of (1) $61 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.

- (1) $101 / 2 "$ block, centered on a truck.

From the Leaf Sprigs - Red (B), cut:

- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 " $\times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (3) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips and
(4) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Words \& Stars - Cream (C), fussy cut:

- (2) $13 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $13 / 4 " \times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
- (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $13 / 4 " \times 12 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{"}$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips and
(4) $1 \frac{112 "}{2} \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Leaf Sprigs - Medium Blue (D), cut:

- (2) $17 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (33) $17 / 8$ " squares.

From the Folk Calico - Gold (E), cut:
-(2) $17 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (33) $17 / 8 "$ squares.

## From the Arrowheads - Green (F), cut:

- (2) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 4 " \times 451 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Horseshoes - Blue (G), cut:
-(3) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 451 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 16 "$ strips.

From the Novelty Toss - Taupe (Backing), cut:

- (1) 32 " $\times 61$ " strip for the back.

1. Sew (1) 2" $\times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure 12 " square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 block.

Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) $1 \frac{1}{/ 2}$ " $\times 141 / 2 / 2$ Fabric F strip, (1) Block One square and (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip together, in that order, to make the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $11 / 4 \times 451 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 16 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Three square to each end of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 451 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the runner top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.
