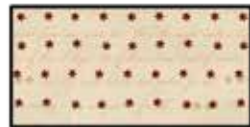

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### Materials

1 yard	Words & Stars - Red (A)	8866-88
¼ yard	Leaf Sprigs - Red (B)	8861-88
⅓ yard	Arrowheads - Cream/Red/Tan (C)	8863-48
½ yard	Leaf Sprigs - Medium Blue (D)	8861-17*
½ yard	Folk Calico - Tan/Cream (E)	8864-38
1 yard	Words & Stars - Cream (Backing)	8866-44

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Words & Stars - Red (A), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 24 ⅛" length of fabric strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 22 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Leaf Sprigs - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 1 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Arrowheads - Cream/Red/Tan (C), cut:

- (3) 1 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 1 ⅞" squares. Cut (24) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (48) triangles.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Leaf Sprigs - Medium Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) triangles.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips for the inner border.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Folk Calico - Tan/Cream (E), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 7" squares and (2) 4 ⅞" squares. Cut the 7" squares across both diagonals to make (12) side setting triangles. Only (10) will be used. Cut the 4 ⅞" squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) corner setting triangles.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Words & Stars - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (1) 30" x 36" strip for the back.

### Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 1 ⅞" Fabric C square on top of (1) 1 ⅞" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 1 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 blocks (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (72) Unit 1 blocks total.

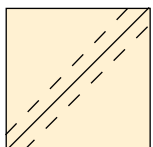

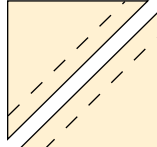

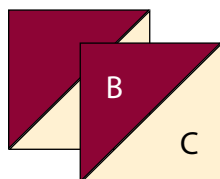

2. Sew (2) Unit 1 blocks and (2) 1 ½" Fabric C squares together to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (24) Unit 2 blocks total.

3. Sew (1) Fabric C triangle to adjacent sides of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) Fabric D triangle to the sewn block to make (1) Unit 3 block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (24) Unit 3 blocks total.

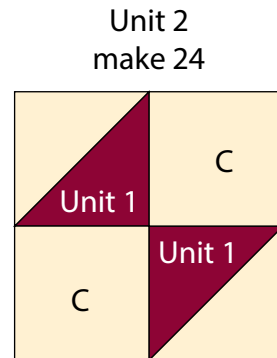

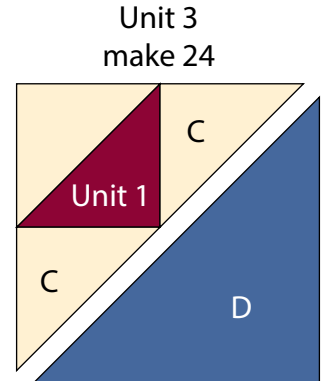

4. Sew (1) Unit 3 block to the left side of (1) Unit 2 block to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 2 block to the left side of (1) unit 3 block to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

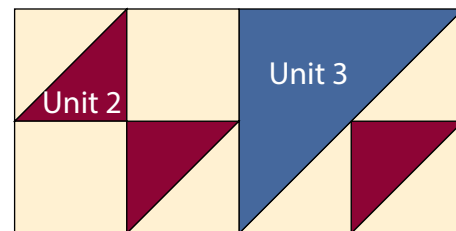
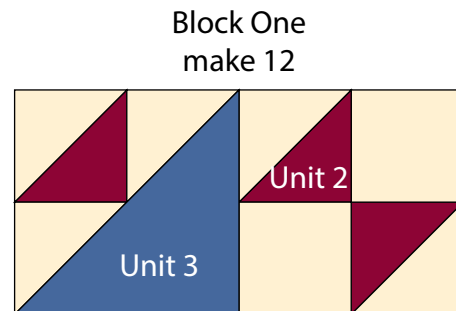

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)*

5. Follow Figure 7 and sew the (12) Block One squares, (6) 4 1/2" Fabric E squares, (10) Fabric E side setting triangles and (4) Fabric E corner setting triangles together to make (1) Quilt Top Center.

6. Sew (2) 1" x WOF Fabric D strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Measure the sides of the Quilt Top Center and cut (2) strips to match the measurement. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Quilt Top Center.

7. Sew (2) 1" x WOF Fabric D strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Measure the top and bottom of the Quilt Top Center and cut (2) strips to match the measurement. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Top Center. Trim the Quilt Top Center to measure 18 1/2" x 24 1/8"

8. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 24 1/8" Fabric A strip to each side of the Quilt Top Center. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Top Center to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (3) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.

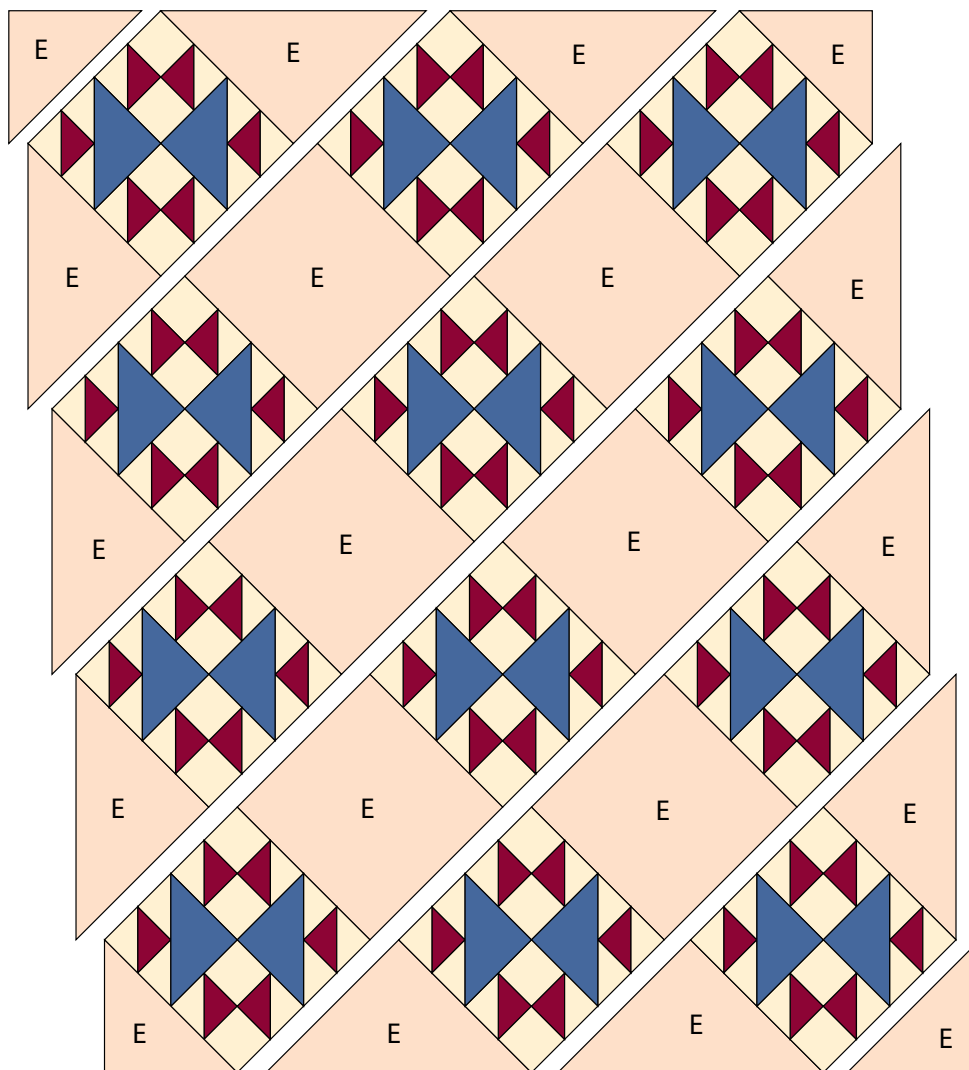
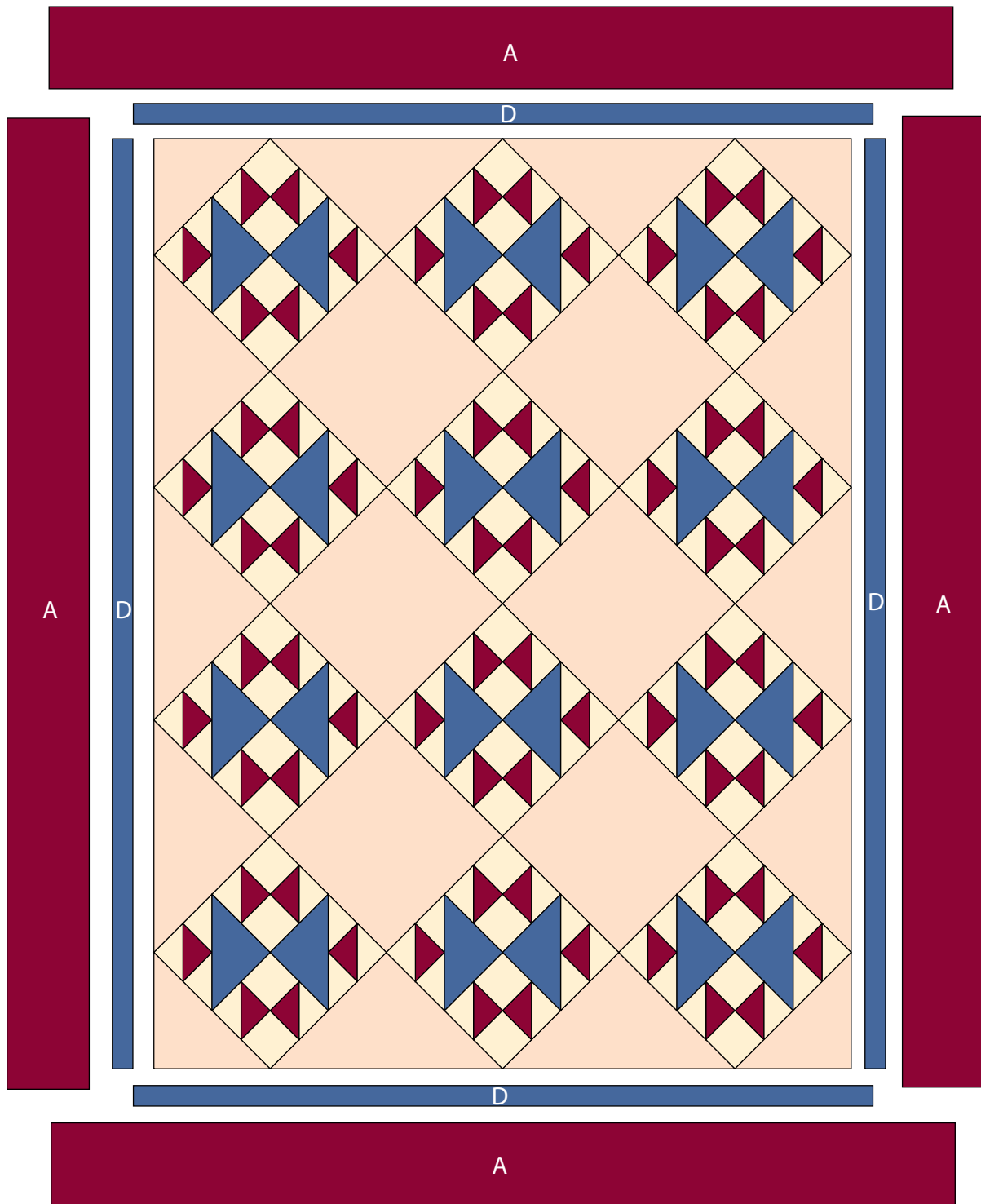
