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

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#### **Materials**

1 panel Inspirational Blocks - Gray (A) 88	385-90
1 yard Leaves - Green (B) 88	393-66
1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yards Cherubs - Cream (C) 88	390-11
<i>y</i>	888-11
1 ½ yards Floral - Blue (E)	889-70*
½ yard Cross Allover - Gray (F) 88	391-90
4 ½ yards Birds - Gray (Backing) 88	887-90

<sup>\*</sup>Includes binding

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Inspirational Blocks - Gray (A), fussy cut:

• (15) 7 ½" blocks.

#### From the Leaves - Green (B), cut:

- (6) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (30) 2" x 7 ½" strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (30) 2" x 10 ½" strips.

#### From the Cherubs - Cream (C), cut:

• (2) 5 ½" x 60 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

#### From the Butterflies - Cream (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 60 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 53 ½" LOF strips.

#### From the Floral - Blue (E), cut:

- (12) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, matching the pattern, and cut (8) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, matching the pattern, and cut (4) 1 ½" x 53 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Cross Allover - Gray (F), cut:

• (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 3 ½" x 9 ½" strips.


#### From the Birds - Gray (Backing), cut:

• (2) 78" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 78" back.

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#### **Sewing Instructions**

1. Sew (1) 2" x 7 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 ½" Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure 9 ½" square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.



2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 53 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 3 ½" x 53 ½" Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Top/Bottom Border (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Border.

#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

#### (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 3. Sew (5) Block One squares and (5) 3 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric F strips together, alternating them, to make Column One. Repeat to make Column Three.
- 4. Sew (5) 3 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric F strips and (5) Block One squares together, alternating them, to make Column Two.
- 5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 5 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.
- 6. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 5 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric C strip to make (1) Sashing Strip. Repeat to make a second Sashing Strip.
- 7. Sew (1) Side Border, Column One, (1) Sashing Strip, Column Two, (1) Sashing Strip, Column Three and (1) Side Border together lengthwise and in that order to make the quilt top.



### Page 2

- 8. Sew the (2) Top/Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 9. Layer and quilt as desired.

- 10. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 11. Bind as desired.
