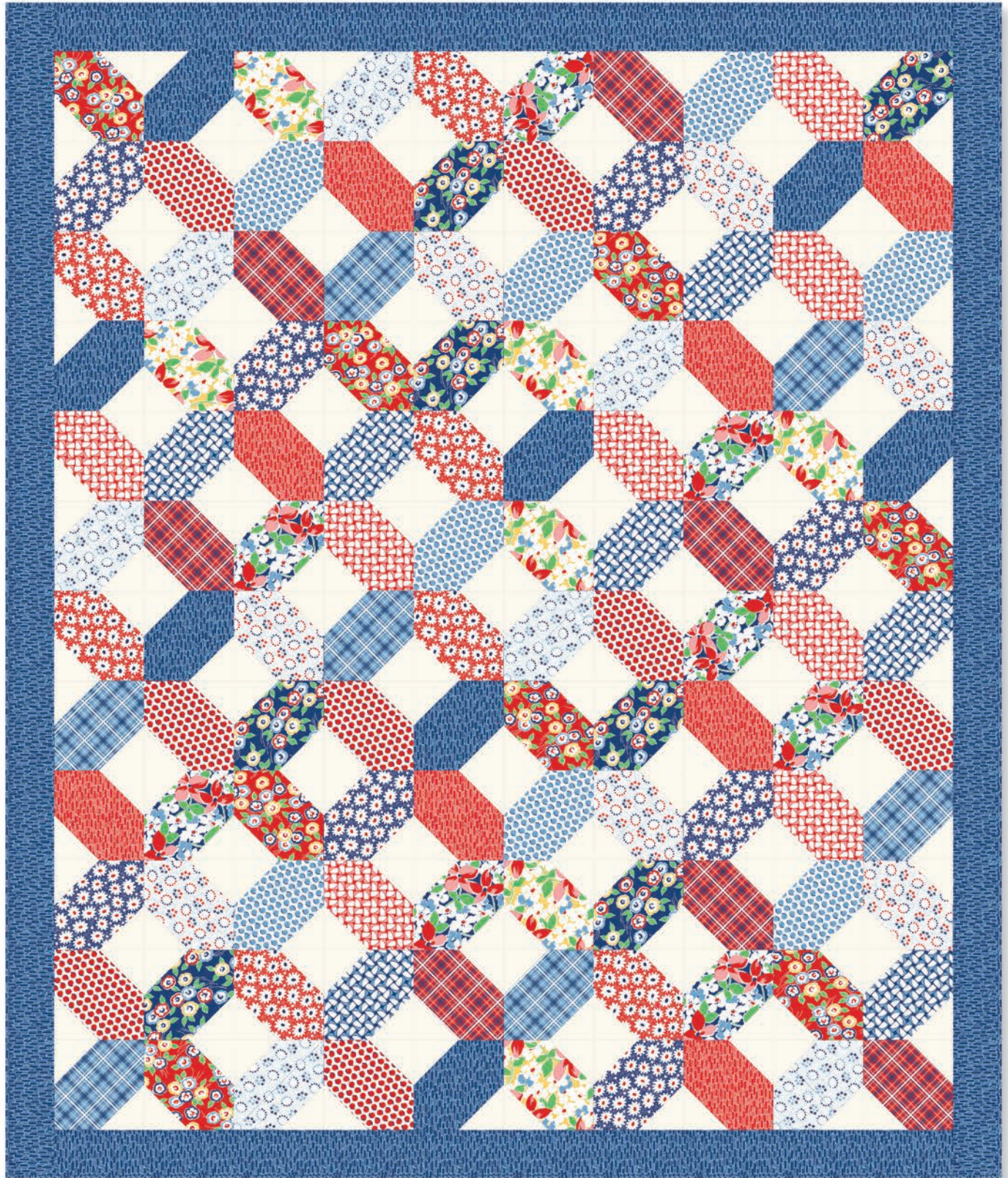


Hi-de-Ho! Picnic Quilt

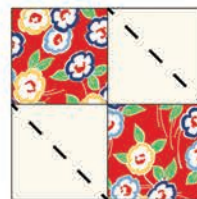

Instructions

1. Diagonally stitch a 3 ½" square of Fabric 1 across opposite corners of the colored 6 ½" squares, right sides together. Trim the excess from the corners and press blue print seams toward the corners and red print seams towards the center.
Make 8 of each Fabrics 2-9.
Make 7 each of Fabrics 10-17.



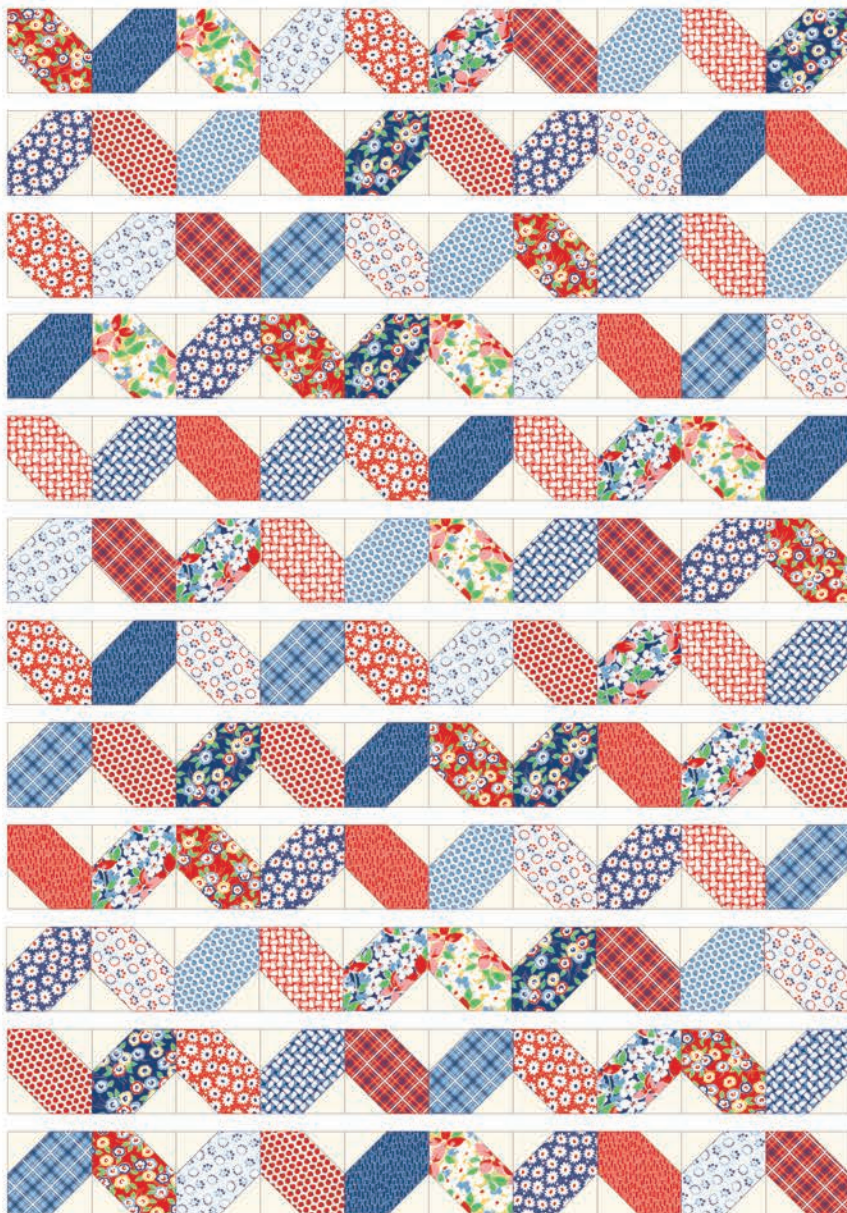
2. Starting with a red block, alternate and rotate red and blue blocks. Make 6 rows of 10 blocks each.












Starting with a blue block, alternate and rotate blue and red colored blocks. Make 6 rows of 10 blocks each.












3. Lay out the rows, match & pin seam intersections. Sew the rows together. Press the seams all one direction.



4. Stitch the 3 ½" x WOF strips of Fabric 2 together in pairs end-to-end to make long strips. Measure the width of the quilt top, and cut two borders to match that width. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Next, measure the length of the quilt and trim two borders to match that length. Sew to the sides of the quilt and press toward the borders.
5. Trim the batting and backing to 2" larger on all sides than the quilt top. Layer, baste and quilt as desired.
6. Before binding, hand-baste a scant 1/4" from the edge of the quilt to prevent the layers from shifting or stretching as the binding is sewn on.
7. Join the fabric 2 binding strips with diagonal seams pressed open. Fold the binding in half, wrong sides together and press to make a double binding. Sew to the quilt with a 1/4" seam allowance, mitering the corners. Trim the excess batting and backing, turn to the back side and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
