9400 Cream (hummingbird blocks)—1-1/3 yards

9401 Cream (flower blocks)—2 yards

559 Cream (tone on tone)—1 yard

Binding: 559 Cream (tone on tone)—1/2 yard

Backing for 52-1/2" x 52-1/2" quilt top: 3-1/4 yards—9402 Cream (overall

hummingbirds)

Batting

Cutting Directions:

9400 Cream (hummingbird blocks)—Fussy cut (21) 6-1/2" squares, centering motifs.

9401 Cream (flower blocks)—Fussy cut (16) 6-1/2" squares—when choosing which squares to use, be sure to leave three full rows of blocks uncut for outer borders.

559 Cream (tone on tone)—Cut (2) 6-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips, cross cut into (12) 6-1/2" squares. Cut (2) 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips and (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

559 Cream (tone on tone)—Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF binding strips, set aside.

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Constructing the Quilt Top:

Referring to diagram, sew together **559 Cream (tone on tone)**, **9401 flower blocks**, and **9400 Cream hummingbird blocks** to form rows.

FIRST ROW = (2) **559** Cream tone on tone, (3) **9401** Cream flower blocks, (2) **559** Cream tone on tone



SECOND ROW = (1) 559 Cream tone on tone, (1) 9401 Cream flower block, (3) 9400 Cream hummingbird blocks, (1) 9401 Cream flower block, (1) 559 Cream tone on tone



Continue to form rows, then sew rows together to form center section.

First Border—559 Cream (tone on tone): Add (2) $3-1/2" \times 42-1/2"$ strips to sides of quilt top. Sew together remaining (3) 3-1/2" strips. From this long strip, cut (2) $3-1/2" \times 48-1/2"$ strips. Add to top and bottom of quilt top.

Second Border—9401 Cream (flower blocks)—From remaining 9401 Cream (flower blocks), cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, allowing 1/4" solid cream above flowers. Sew together (3) top strips and cut (1) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (1) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" border from this strip. Repeat with (3) bottom strips to cut (1) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" strip and (1) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" strip.





Sew 48-1/2" strips to sides of quilt top with 1/4" solid cream seam allowance facing toward outside. Sew 52-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt top, leaving 1/4" plain seam allowance to outside of the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Use reserved 559 Cream (tone on tone) strips to bind quilt.
