





- Clear template plastic, 8½" x 8½"
- Basic sewing, pressing, and rotary-cutting supplies

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

**WOF** = Width of fabric (from selvage to selvage)

#### Fabric A [26358 R] (panel print)

##### Block A

- Centering the 8½" x 8½" clear plastic template over each butterfly motif, cut (4) 8½" x 8½" squares.

#### Fabric B [26359 P] (pink floral)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (1) 7½" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 5½" x 7½" rectangles.

#### Fabric C [26359 Q] (blue floral)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (2) 5½" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 5½" x 7½" rectangles.

##### Backing

- Cut (2) 88" x WOF strips.

#### Fabric D [26360 Q] (blue butterfly)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (44) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (1) 7½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 7½" x 7½" squares.

#### Fabric E [26360 R] (red butterfly)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (2) 7½" x WOF strips. Subcut (6) 5½" x 7½" rectangles. Subcut (2) 7½" x 7½" squares.

#### Binding

- Cut (8) 2¼" x WOF strips.

#### Fabric F [26362 H] (green geometric)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (44) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (1) 7½" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 5½" x 7½" rectangles.

#### Fabric G [26363 P] (pink dot)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (44) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Cornerstones

- Cut (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 1½" x 1½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (1) 7½" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 5½" x 7½" rectangles.

#### Fabric H [26363 Z] (white dot)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (26) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (672) 1½" x 1½" squares.
- Cut (1) 4½" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 4½" x 4½" squares.

#### Fabric I [22083 Z] (white tonal)

##### Sashing Rectangles

- Cut (6) 3½" x WOF strips. Subcut (17) 3½" x 12½" rectangles.

##### Cornerstones

- Cut (2) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 1½" x 1½" squares. Subcut (12) 1½" x 3½" rectangles.

##### Inner Border

- Cut (6) 4½" x WOF strips. Piece strips together (end to end) using 45° seams. Subcut (2) 4½" x 50½" strips. Subcut (2) 4½" x 57½" strips.

#### Fabric J [24174 H] (green scroll)

##### Blocks A and B

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (44) 2½" x 2½" squares.

##### Cornerstones

- Cut (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 1½" x 1½" squares.

##### Outer Border

- Cut (1) 7½" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 5½" x 7½" rectangles.

**Fabric K [24174 SO] (gold scroll)**

**Blocks A and B**

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2½" x 2½" squares.

**Outer Border**

- Cut (2) 5½" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 5½" x 7½" rectangles.

**Cornerstones**

- Cut (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 1½" x 1½" squares.

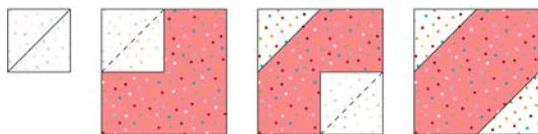
**SEWING INSTRUCTIONS**

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout unless otherwise indicated.

**Unit A**

1. Referring to Diagram 1, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of two 1½" x 1½" Fabric H (white dot) squares. With right sides together and noting orientation of the diagonal line, place one Fabric H square in the upper left corner of one 2½" x 2½" Fabric G (pink dot) square. Sew on the drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press the Fabric H triangle towards the corner. Repeat this step with remaining 1½" x 1½" Fabric H (white dot) square in the opposite corner of the same Fabric G square to complete Unit A. Trim Unit A, if needed, to measure 2½" x 2½".

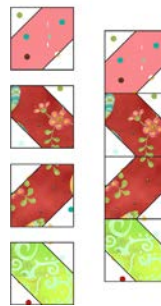


**Block A (make four)**

1. *Unit A.* All Unit A use two Fabric H (white dot) 1½" x 1½" squares. Following step 1, make a total of three Unit A with each of the following 2½" x 2½" squares: Fabric G (pink dot), Fabric F (green geometric), Fabric J (green scroll), and Fabric D (blue butterfly). Make two Unit A with each of the following 2½" x 2½" squares: Fabric C (blue floral), Fabric K (gold scroll), Fabric E (red butterfly), and Fabric B (pink floral). [twenty Unit A required for each Block A]

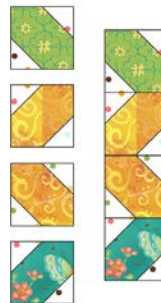
2. *Column 1.* Referring to Diagram 2, sew four Unit A together in the following fabric order: G (pink dot), E (red butterfly), E (red butterfly), J (green scroll) for Column 1. Column 1 should measure 2½" x 8½".

3. *Column 2.* Referring to Diagram 3, sew four Unit A together in the following fabric order: F (green geometric), K (gold scroll), K (gold scroll), D (blue butterfly) for Column 2. Column 2 should measure 2½" x 8½".

4. *Top Row.* Referring to Diagram 4, sew six Unit A together in the following fabric order: G (pink dot), G (pink dot), C (blue floral), C (blue floral), F (green geometric), F (green geometric) for Top Row. Top Row should measure 2½" x 12½".

5. *Bottom Row.* Referring to Diagram 5, sew six Unit A together in the following fabric order: J (green scroll), J (green scroll), B (pink floral), B (pink floral), D (blue butterfly), D (blue butterfly) for Bottom Row. Bottom Row should measure 2½" x 12½".

**6. Assemble Block A.** Referring to Diagram 6, sew columns to each side of one Fabric A (panel print)  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  square for Block Center. Add top/bottom rows to the Block Center to complete Pieced Block A. Block should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ .

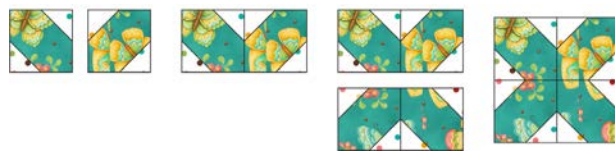
**7.** Repeat Steps 1–6 to make three additional Block A using the remaining three Fabric A (panel print)  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$  squares for the block center.

**Block B (make eight)**

**1. Unit A.** All Unit A use two Fabric H (white dot)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$  squares. Following Step 1, make four Unit A with each of the following  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$  squares: Fabric G (pink dot), Fabric F (green geometric), Fabric J (green scroll), Fabric D (blue butterfly), Fabric C (blue floral), Fabric K (gold scroll), Fabric E (red butterfly), and Fabric B (pink floral). [thirty-two Unit A required for each Block B]

**2. Unit X.** Referring to Diagram 7 and noting orientation of the units, sew four alike Unit A together for one Unit X (two rows of two units each). Unit X should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ . Make a total of eight Unit X (one for each fabric).

**3. Block Row 1.** Referring to Diagram 8, sew three Unit X Blocks together in the following fabric order: K, H, and E for Row 1. Row 1 should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ .

**4. Block Row 2.** Referring to Diagram 9, sew three pieces together in the following order: one Fabric

K (gold scroll) Unit X, one Fabric H (white dot)  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  square, one Fabric E (red butterfly) Unit X for Row 2. Row 2 should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ .

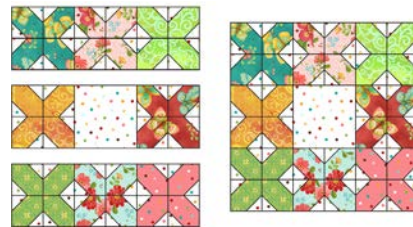
**5. Block Row 3.** Referring to Diagram 10, sew three Unit X Blocks together in the following fabric order: F, C, and G for Row 3. Row 3 should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ .

**6. Assemble Block B.** Referring to Diagram 11, sew the three block rows together in numerical order for Block B. Block B should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ .

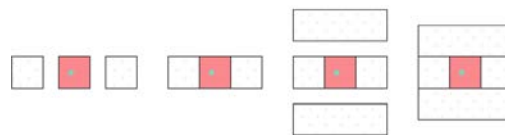


**7.** Repeat Steps 1–6 to make a total of eight Block B.

**Row Cornerstones (make six)**

**1.** Referring to Diagram 12, sew one Fabric G (pink dot)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$  square and two Fabric I (white tonal)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$  squares together for Center Row. Sew Center Row and two Fabric I (white tonal)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles together for one Row Cornerstone. Cornerstone should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ .

**2.** Repeat Step 1 to make a total of two Row Cornerstones with each of the following  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$  squares: Fabric G (pink dot), Fabric K (gold scroll), Fabric J (green scroll). [total of six Row Cornerstones are required]

### Assemble Quilt Center

Refer to the Assembly Diagram for the following steps.

- 1. Block Rows.** Noting orientation and type of block, arrange and sew three blocks and two 3½" x 12½" Fabric I (white tonal) rectangles together into a row. Make a total of four block rows.
- 2. Sashing Rows.** Arrange and sew two Row Sashing Cornerstones and three 3½" x 12½" Fabric I (white tonal) rectangles together into a row. Make a total of three sashing rows.
- 3.** Sew the block rows and sashing rows together to complete the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 42½" x 57½".

### Assemble Quilt Top

Refer to the Assembly Diagram for the following steps.

- 1. Inner Border.** Sew the 4½" x 57½" Fabric I (white tonal) strips to the sides of Quilt Center. Sew the 4½" x 50½" Fabric I (white tonal) strips to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 50½" x 65½".
- 2. Outer Border (Sides).** Arrange and sew together thirteen 5½" x 7½" print rectangles to make one side column. Column should measure 7½" x 65½". Make two columns. Sew columns to each side of the Quilt Center.
- 3. Outer Border (Top/Bottom).** Arrange and sew together ten 5½" x 7½" print rectangles into a row. Add one 7½" x 7½" Fabric D (blue butterfly) square and one 7½" x 7½" Fabric E (red butterfly) square to each row end. Row should measure 7½" x 64½". Make two rows. Sew the top and bottom rows to the Quilt Top to complete the Quilt Top. Quilt Top should measure 64½" x 79½".

### FINISHING

- 1.** If backing is not already prepared, sew two 88" x WOF Fabric C (blue floral) strips together along the selvage edges with a 1" seam. Trim seam to ½" and press to one side. Trim backing to measure 73" x 88".
- 2.** Place the quilt top right side up on the top of the batting and the wrong side of the backing.
- 3.** Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim the backing and batting even with the quilt top.
- 4.** Sew the eight 2¼" x WOF Fabric E (red butterfly) strips together (end to end) using 45° seams to make a continuous strip. Fold strip in half lengthwise (with wrong sides together) and press. Bind as desired.
