

Bee Kind Quilt

Size: 57" x 69"

Block: 12½" x 12½"



DESIGN 1 (Main Diagram)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bee Kind Collection)

Fabric 1: 1½yd - 110cm - A281.1 (Allium & poppies on light sage)

Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - A282.2 (Peach honeycomb)

Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - A283.1 (Bee hexagons natural)

Fabric 4: ¾yd - 80cm - A284.1 (Lavender on white)

Fabric 5: ¾yd - 80cm - A285.2 (Bees on sage)

Fabric 6: ¾yd - 80cm - BB130 (Candyfloss)

Fabric 7: ⅝yd - 60cm - BB141 (Khaki green)

Wadding and backing 61" x 73"

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING


- 1.** From fabric 1 cut:
2 x 4" x 62½" (sides)
2 x 4" x 57½" (top and bottom)
- 2.** From fabric 2 cut:
40 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once
- 3.** From fabric 3 cut:
20 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice
- 4.** From fabric 4 cut:
20 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice
- 5.** From fabric 5 cut:
80 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once
- 6.** From fabric 6 cut:
40 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once
- 7.** From fabric 7 cut:
2 x 1½" x 60½" (sides)
2 x 1½" x 50½" (top and bottom)

MAKING UP THE BLOCK



Block diagram

The block is made up of flying geese, eight for each block




Sew the small triangles to each side of the large triangle. Stitch two together to make a square


Next sew the squares in rows and then sew them together to make the block

Sew 20 in total

MAKING UP THE QUILT CENTRE



Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch the top row together, pressing the seams to the right. On the next row press the seams to the left. Keep doing this to each row, it will help when you are sewing the rows together



BORDERS

Stitch the inner strips to the sides and then the top and bottom

Next sew the outer borders, sides and then the top and bottom

COMPLETION

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt

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Size: 57" x 69"

DESIGN 2 (Main Diagram)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bee Kind Collection)

Fabric 1: 1½yd - 110cm - A281.3 (Allium & poppies on warm grey)

Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - A282.1 (Blue honeycomb)

Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - A283.3 (Bee hexagons pink)

Fabric 4: ⅞yd - 80cm - A284.3 (Lavender on sage)

Fabric 5: ⅞yd - 80cm - A285.3 (Bees on lavender)

Fabric 6: ⅞yd - 80cm - BB137 (Blackberry juice)

Fabric 7: ⅝yd - 60cm - BB135 (Purple berry)


Wadding and backing 61" x 73"

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING

- 1.** From fabric 1 cut:
2 x 4" x 62½" (sides)
2 x 4" x 57½" (top and bottom)
- 2.** From fabric 2 cut:
40 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once
- 3.** From fabric 3 cut:
20 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice
- 4.** From fabric 4 cut:
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- 5.** From fabric 5 cut:
80 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once
- 6.** From fabric 6 cut:
40 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once
- 7.** From fabric 7 cut:
2 x 1½" x 60½" (sides)
2 x 1½" x 50½" (top and bottom)

MAKING UP THE BLOCK



Block diagram

The block is made up of flying geese, eight for each block




Sew the small triangles to each side of the large triangle. Stitch two together to make a square

Next sew the squares in rows and then sew them together to make the block

Sew 20 in total

MAKING UP THE QUILT CENTRE



Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch the top row together, pressing the seams to the right. On the next row press the seams to the left. Keep doing this to each row, it will help when you are sewing the rows together



BORDERS

Stitch the inner strips to the sides and then the top and bottom

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

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bee Kind Collection)

Fabric 1: 1½yd - 110cm - A281.2 (Allium & poppies on blue)

Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - A282.3 (Pinky red honeycomb)

Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - A283.2 (Bee hexagons green)

Fabric 4: ⅞yd - 80cm - A284.2 (Lavender on pink)

Fabric 5: ⅞yd - 80cm - A285.1 (Bees on grey)

Fabric 6: ⅞yd - 80cm - BB133 (Lavender)

Fabric 7: ⅝yd - 60cm - BB135 (Purple berry)

Wadding and backing 61" x 73"

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING

- 1.** From fabric 1 cut:
2 x 4" x 62½" (sides)
2 x 4" x 57½" (top and bottom)
- 2.** From fabric 2 cut:




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COMPLETION
