Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Wall Quilt:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-E used in this design.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/2"x 66" and (2) 9-1/2"x 47" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (6) 2"strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2"x 62-1/2" and (2) 2"x 46-1/2" borders


Fabric D - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 28" strips

2. Piecing Order for Wall Quilt:

- Refer to Wall Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, and borders.
- Stitch Fabric D 2"x width of fabric strips to sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2"x 28" Fabric D strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim quilt center to 25-1/2" x 44-1/2" (unfinished).

3. Center Fabric B 9-1/2" x 66" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric B 9-1/2" x 47" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with hanging stars stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to

sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out. 4. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 5. Stitch Fabric C 2"x 62-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric C 2" x 46-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 6. The wall quilt measures approximately 46-1/2" x 65-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric E) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric D) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Throw Quilt:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-Jused in this design.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut (2) 11-1/2" strips with large wreaths centered in strips, subcut (6) 11-1/2" x 14" rectangles with a large wreath centered

Fabric B - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half / diagonally for 24 triangles Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (20) 2" x 2-1/2" pieces

Fabrics D and H - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (6) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice 🔀 for 24 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half as shown diagonally for 48 triangles Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (4) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (12) 1-3/4" x 11-1/2" strips Cut (6) 1" strips, subcut (12) 1" x 16-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (2) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (18) 3-1/4" squares [then cut in half X diagonally twice for 72 triangles] and (2) 2-7/8" squares

Cut (5) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (70) 2-7/8" squares then cut all 2-7/8" squares in half 🖊 diagonally for 144 triangles Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips, subcut

(15) 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips and (48) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (6) 2" strips, subcut (16) 2" x 12-1/2" strips


Fabric G - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half / diagonally for 48 triangles

Fabric I - Cut (2) 1-7/8" strips, subcut (36) 1-7/8" squares

Arrows and stripe indicate orientation of directional prints.

4. Piecing Order for Throw Quilt:

 Stitch Fabric E 1-3/4" x 11-1/2" strips to sides of a Fabric A rectangle. Add 1"x 16-1/2"Fabric E strips to top and bottomof panel. Make a total of 6 Block 1



(12-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished).

Unit 1a Stitch 1 each Fabrics E and F Make 48 2-7/8" triangles together along Unit 1b long edges. Make a total of 48 Make 24 Unit 1a (2-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner make 24 Unit 1b with Fabrics C and F 2-7/8" triangles.

3. Arrange 2 Unit 1a (U1a) and 2 Unit 2 F DNa Fabric F 2-1/2" squares in 2 rows Make 24 as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 2 (4-1/2" square unfinished).

F Unit 3 Stitch 2 Fabric F 2-7/8" triangles to short sides of a Fabric H 5-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 24 Unit 3 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).

5. Sew 2 Fabric F 3-1/4" triangles Fy Fy Unit 4 to adjacent sides of a Fabric I Make 36 1-7/8" square as shown. Make a total of 36 Unit 4 (3-3/4" x 3-3/4" x 5-1/4").

Stitch a Fabric G 2-7/8" triangle to short edges of a Unit 4. Make a total of 24 Unit 5 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).




Sew 1 each Units 3 and 5 together as shown. Make a total of 24 Unit 6 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



8. Arrange 1 Fabric B 4-1/2" square and 4 each Units 2 (U2) and Unit 6 (U6) in 3 rows as shown.

Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 Block Centers (12-1/2" square unfinished).





9. Stitch Fabric D 5-1/4" triangles to short ends of a Unit 4 (U4) as shown. Add Fabric F 2-7/8" triangles to ends as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 7 (2-1/2"x 8-1/2" unfinished).



10. Sew a Unit 8 - Make 12
(U1b) to both ends of a Unit 7 as shown. Make a total of 12
Unit 8 (2-1/2"x 12-1/2" unfinished).

 Stitch a Unit 8 to right and left sides of a block center.
 Make a total of 6 Block 2 (12-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished).




12. Refer to Throw Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, and pieces.

Arrows and stripe indicate orientation of directional prints.




- 13. Arrange blocks, **Fabric F** 2-1/2"x 16-1/2" strips, **Fabric F** 2"x 12-1/2" strips, and **Fabric C** 2"x 2-1/2" pieces in 9 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.
- 14. The quilt measures approximately 54-1/2" x 58-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric E) and enjoy!!
