Duckies

- WOF = Width Of Fabric folded selvage to selvage
- All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Press fabric before cutting
- Cut and label all your pieces

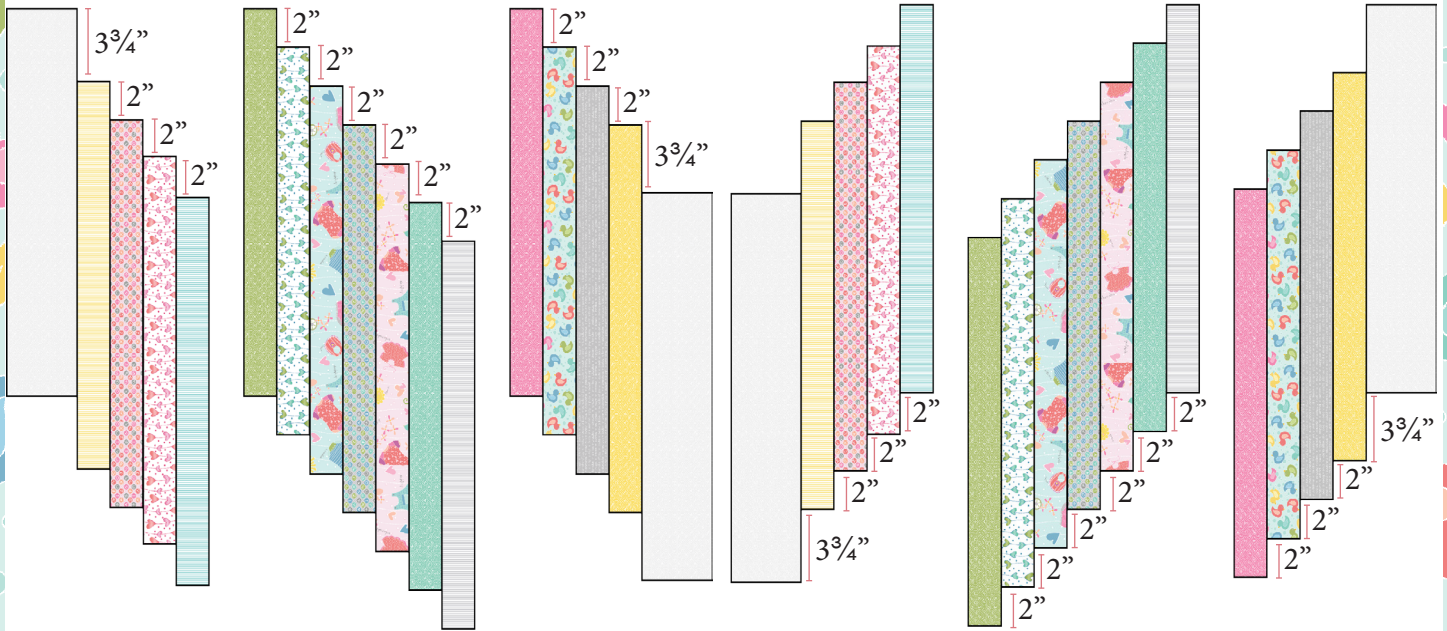

| My Little Sunshine 5 x 5 Packs  | Appliqués | Find the ABC yellow square for the duck's beaks Select 14 squares for the duck's body and 14 squares for the wings | 1 |

| My Little Sunshine Pinstripe Yellow 3129-33  | Sashing Borders | (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip cut into: (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " - Sashing 3 (7) 1" x WOF strips cut into: (12) 1" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " - Sashing 2 Save the remaining strips for Borders 3 & 4 | $\frac{1}{3}$ yd |
| My Little Sunshine Duck Lt Turquoise 3126-04  | Border | (3) 4" x WOF strips - Border 5 | $\frac{1}{2}$ yd |
| My Little Sunshine ABC Turquoise 3128-84  | Binding | (7) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips - Binding | $\frac{3}{8}$ yd |
| My Little Sunshine Duck Lt Grey 3126-13  | Backing | | 3 yds |
| Paper-Backed Fusible 17" wide | Fusible Appliqué | Please follow manufacturer's instructions when using a paper-backed fusible for your appliqués. | 1 |

Duckies

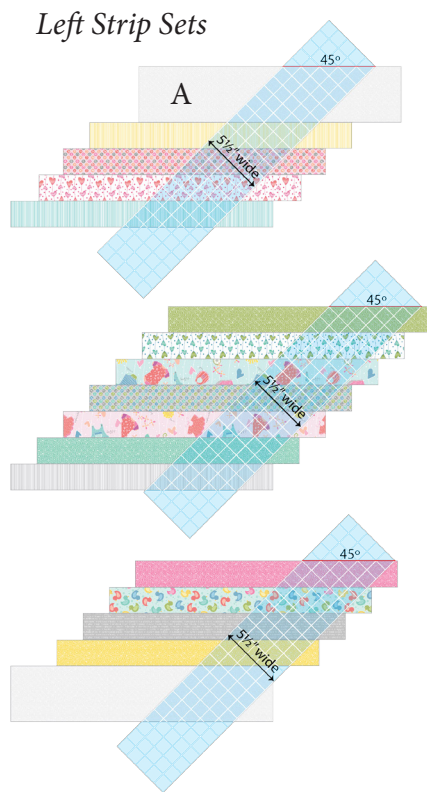
1. Choose (30) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips and (4) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" A strips.
2. Arrange the strips as follows, staggering each strip as indicated; press all seams to the Zig-Zag strips.

- Left Top Set: (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" A strip and (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips.
- Left Middle Set: (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips
- Left Bottom Set: (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips and (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" A strip

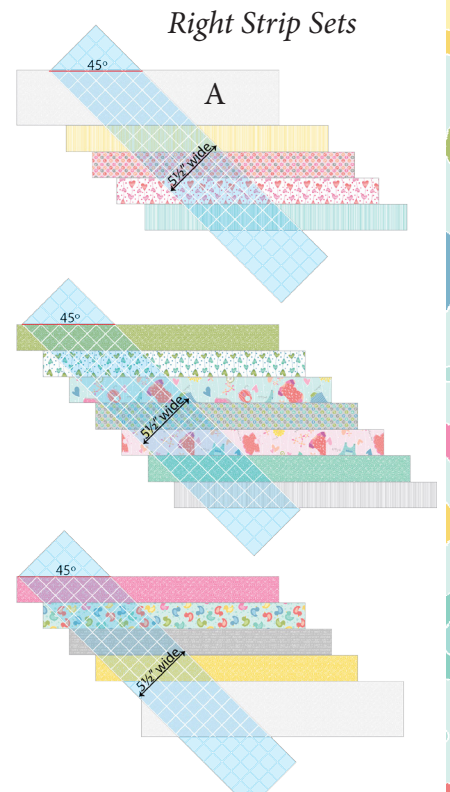
- Right Top Set: (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" A strip and (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips.
- Right Middle Set: (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips
- Right Bottom Set: (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Zig-Zag strips and (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" A strip



1. Following the left strip sets diagram and with the A strip on top, align the 45° line of a 6" x 24" ruler on the top edge of the first strip set.
2. Trim the end at an angle and cut (2) sections each $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.
3. Repeat with the remaining middle and bottom left strip sets.



4. Following the right strip sets diagram and with the A strip on top, align the 45° line of a 6" x 24" ruler on the top edge of the first strip set.
5. Trim the end at an angle and cut (2) sections each $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.
6. Repeat with the remaining middle and bottom right strip sets.



Duckies



- Sew the left top, middle, and bottom strip sets together to make a Zig-Zag strip. Repeat with the right top, middle, and bottom strip sets.
- Cut off the points from A, leaving a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance from the tip of the next strip as indicated.



- Sew the trimmed strip sets together to make an A Zig-Zag column.
- Sew a second A Zig-Zag column.
- Repeat the process with the remaining (30) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" Pinwheel strips to make (2) B Zig-Zag columns.

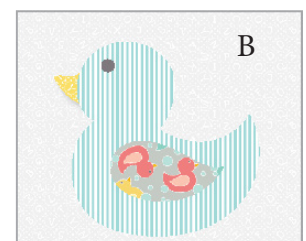
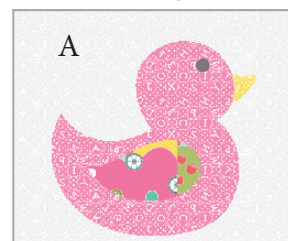
Zig-Zag Columns

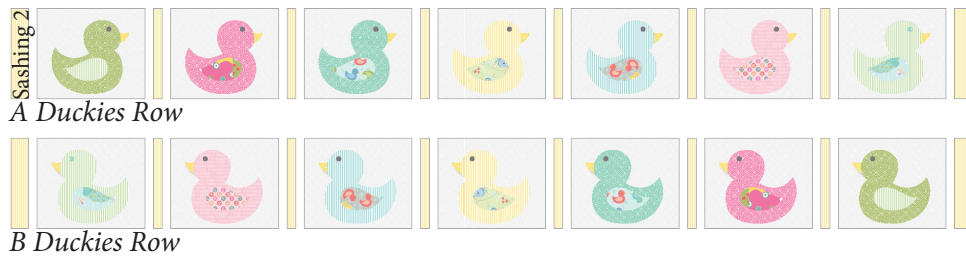
- Use the 5 x 5 squares to prepare (7) A and (7) B appliqué ducks and appliqué onto the 7" x 6" white background rectangles.
- Trim the appliqued duck-backgrounds into $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



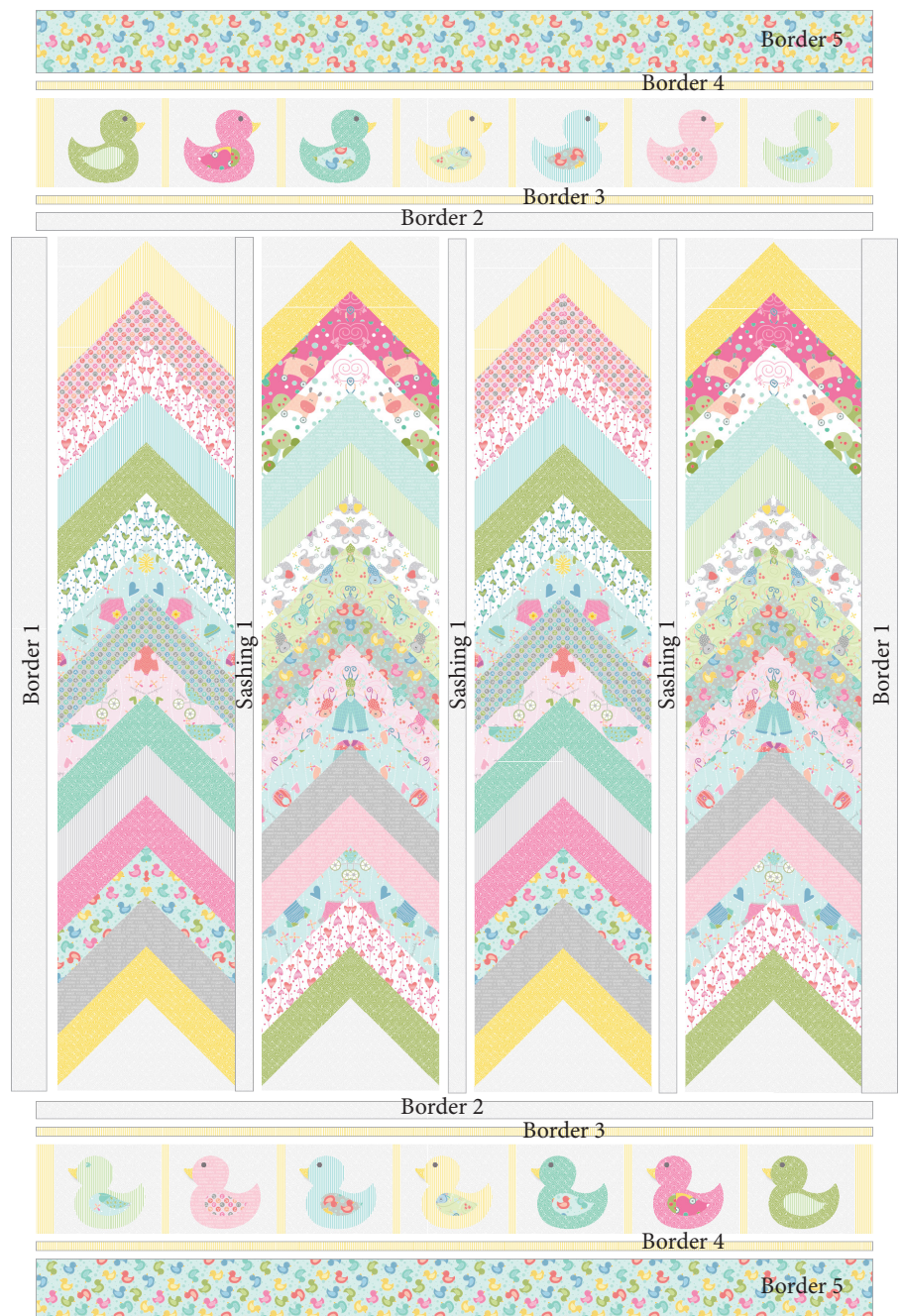
- The trimmed strip sets should measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ ".

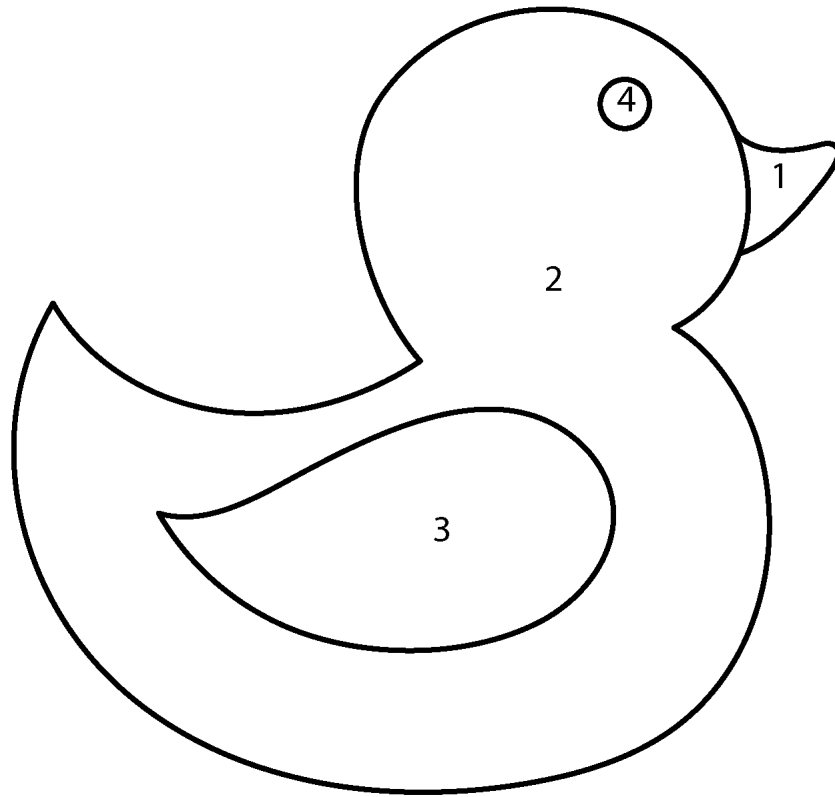
15. Sew (7) appliqued A ducks, with (6) yellow pinstripe 1" x 5½" sashing 2 strips in between the appliqued backgrounds, and finish with the 1½" x 5½" sashing 3 strips on both ends.
16. Repeat with the (7) B appliqued ducks.



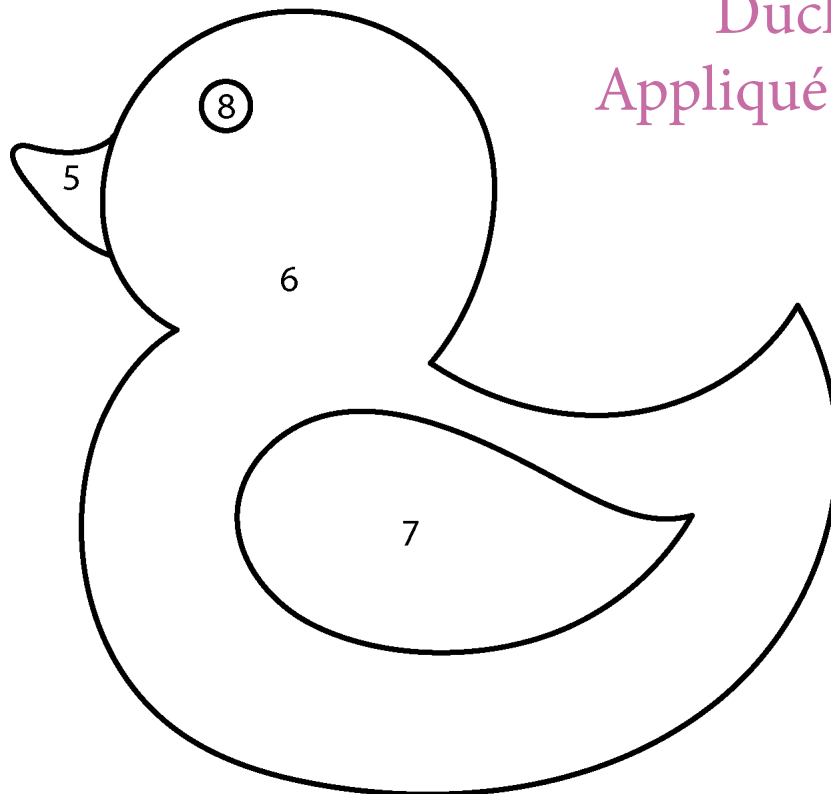
17. Sew (4) 1½" x WOF white sashing 1 strips end to end and cut (3) 1½" x 48½" sashing 1 strips.
18. Sew the Zig-Zag columns and the (3) sashing 1 strips together to make the quilt center.
19. Sew the (3) white 2½" x WOF border 1 strips end to end and cut (2) 2½" x 48½" strips; sew onto the left and right edges of the quilt center.
20. Sew the remainig 1½" white strips end to end and cut (2) 1½" x 47½" border 2 strips; sew onto the top and bottom of the quilt center.
21. Sew the remaining 1" x WOF borders 3 & 4 yellow pinstrip strips end to end and cut into (4) 1" x 47½" strips; sew a 1" x 47½" border 3 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
22. Sew the A Duckies row to the top and the B Duckies row to the bottom of the quilt center.
23. Sew the (2) remainig 1" x 47½" yellow pinstrip border 4 strips to the top and bottom edges of the duckies rows.
24. Sew the (3) turquoise ducks 4" x WOF border 5 strips end to end and cut (2) 4" x 47½" border 5 strips; sew onto the top and bottoms edges of the quilt center
25. Quilt as desired and bind with the (7) ABC turquoise 2¼" x WOF binding strips.
