Fabric Requirements

2 yards Tonga-B5305 Breeze
1⁵/₈ yards Tonga-B5029 Basil
1/3 yard Tonga-B9230 Plum
1/4 yard Tonga-B5975 Coffee
1/3 yard Tonga-B5975 Berry
1/4 yard Tonga-B5971 Herb
2/3 yard Tonga-B5973 Hazel
1/3 yard Tonga-B5979 Canary
5/8 yard Tonga-B5977 Olive
1/3 yard Tonga-B5978 Lime
1/3 yard Tonga-B5974 Chocolate
3¹/₃ yards Tonga Cranberry backing fabric of your choice
60" x 76" batting

Cutting

For easier assembly, label the cut pieces A-X (there is no I). Note that batiks are used in this design so the cut pieces can be flipped to use either side as the right side, and they're non-directional. Some templates can be cut on the cross grain. Nest pieces for best fabric use and cut the pieces in the order shown.

From Tonga-B5305 Breeze:

- Cut four 3¹/₂" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut thirty-two 3¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles (A).
- Cut fifty-six Template 1 (T).
- Cut thirty-two Template 2 (M).
- Cut thirty-two Template 3 (S).

From Tonga-B5029 Basil:

- Cut five 1¹/₂" x WOF sashing strips.
- Cut six 2" x WOF border strips.
- Cut six 2¹/₄" x WOF binding strips.
- Cut nine Template 6 (B).
- Cut three Template 4 (C).

From Tonga-B9230 Plum:

- Cut four Template 4 (D).

From Tonga-B5975 Coffee:

- Cut three Template 6 (E).
- Cut one Template 5 (F).
- Cut one Template 4 (G).

From Tonga-B5975 Berry:

- Cut four Template 6 (H).
- Cut one Template 4 (J).

From Tonga-B5971 Herb:

- Cut two Template 5 (K).

From Tonga-B5973 Hazel:

- Cut four 3¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-eight 3¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles (L).
- Cut two 2¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut sixteen 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles (N).
- Cut two 1¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut sixteen 1¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" strips (O).

From Tonga-B5979 Canary:

- Cut five Template 4 (P).

From Tonga-B5977 Olive:

- Cut twelve Template 5 (Q).
- Cut eight Template 4 (R).

From Tonga-B5978 Lime:

- Cut five Template 4 (U).

From Tonga-B5974 Chocolate:

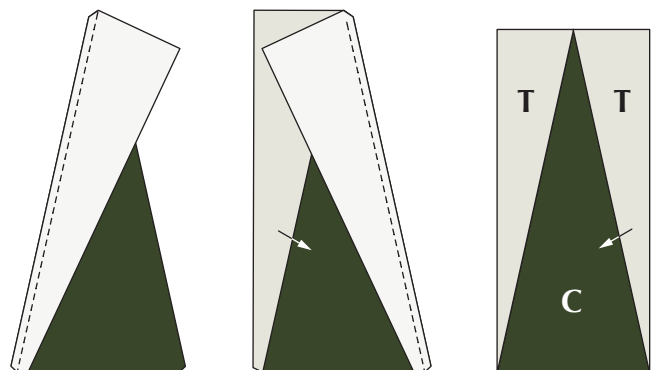
- Cut one Template 5 (V).
- Cut one Template 4 (W).

Block Construction

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Stitch a B5305 Breeze Template 1 (T) to each side of a B5029 Basil Template 4 (C) (figure 1). Press the seams toward the tree.

Sew a 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" B5973 Hazel (L) rectangle to the bottom of the tree unit. Press the seam toward the base of the tree (figure 2). Make a total of twenty-eight tall trees in the same manner.

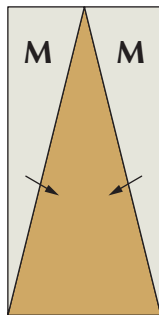

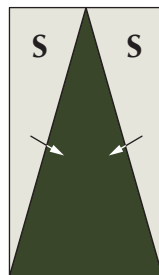
Make 28.

- Repeat step 1 sewing a B5305 Breeze Template 2 (M) to each side of the Template 5 medium trees. Press the seams toward the tree. Make a total of sixteen medium trees.

Make 16.

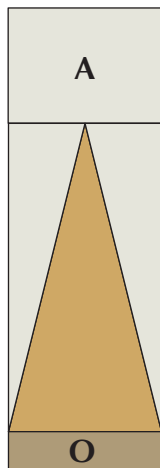


Make 16.

- Repeat step 1 sewing a B5305 Breeze Template 3 (S) to each side of the Template 6 small trees. Press the seams toward the tree. Make a total of sixteen small trees. (figure 3)

- Stitch a 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" B5973 Hazel strip (O) to the bottom of all the medium trees. Stitch a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" B5973 Hazel rectangle (N) to the bottom of all the small trees.

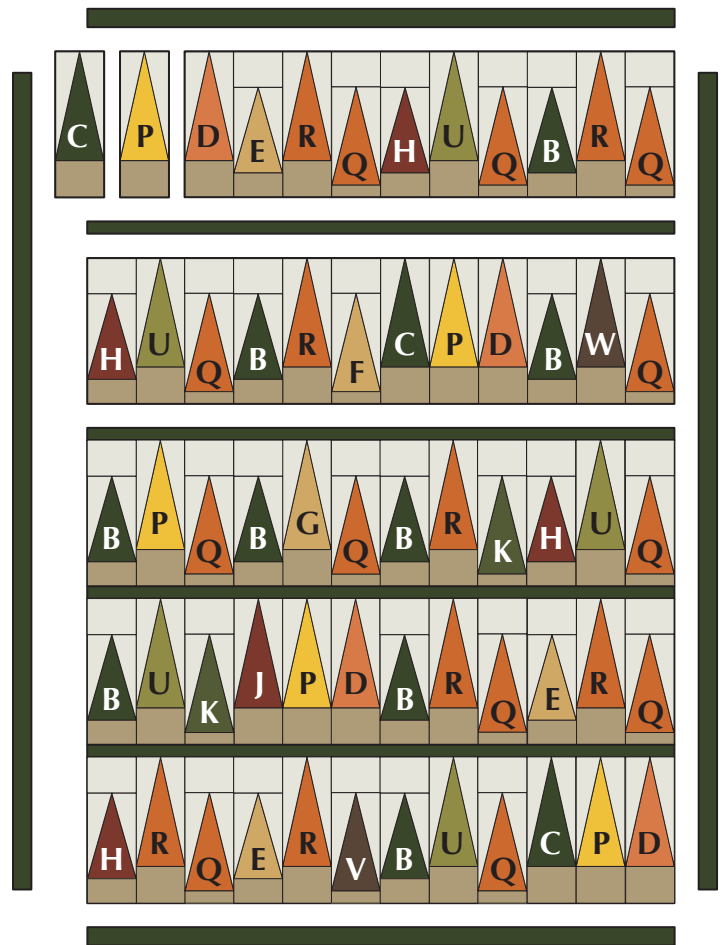

Press seams toward the base of the tree. Add a 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Tonga B-5305 Breeze rectangle (A) to the top of each medium and small tree. Press seams towards the top (figure 4).

Quilt Top Assembly

- Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for placement and orientation, lay out five rows of twelve blocks each. Number the rows for easier assembly.
- Stitch the blocks together in each row, matching adjacent seams. For the sashing, sew the five 1 1/2" x WOF B5029 Basil strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the width of the first row and cut four strips that size. Sew a sashing strip to the bottom of Rows 1, 2, 3 and 4.
- Stitch the rows together in numerical order. Press the seams in one direction.

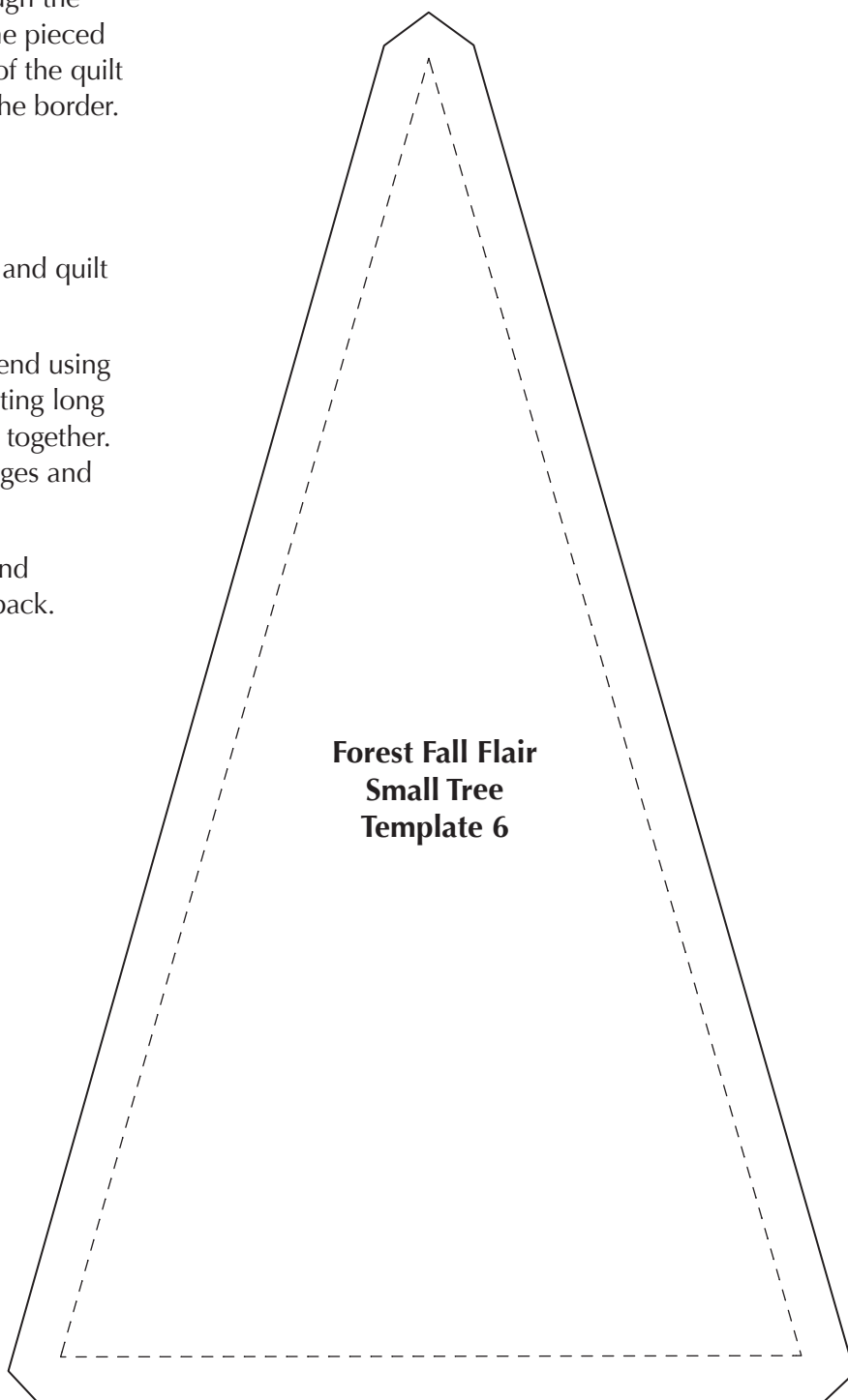


Quilt Assembly Diagram

8. For the border, sew the six 2" x WOF B50239 Basil strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center and cut two strips that length from the pieced strip. Sew one strip to the top and the other strip to the bottom of the quilt top. Press seam allowances toward the border.
9. Measure the length of the quilt top through the center. Cut two strips that length from the pieced border strip. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the border.

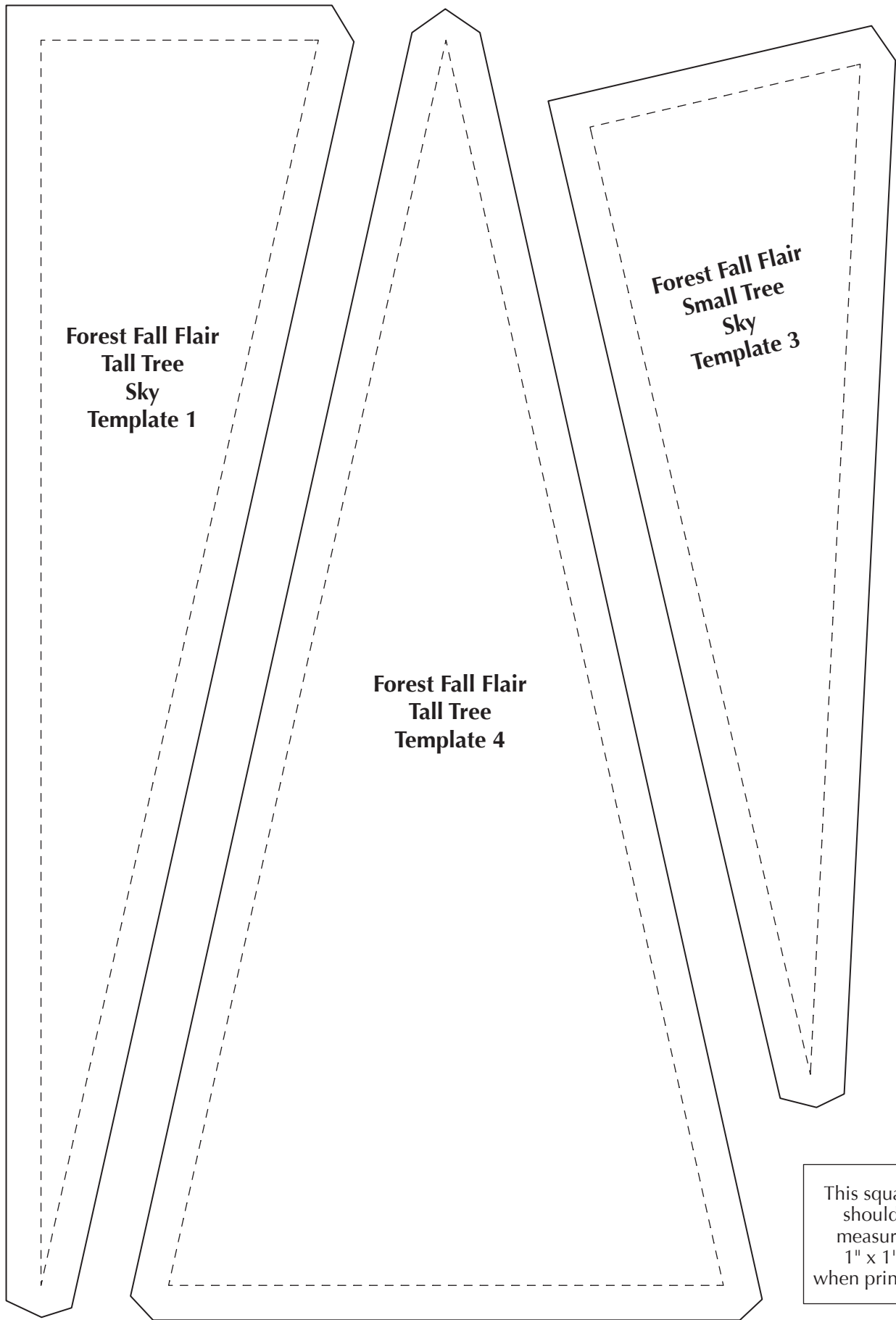
Finishing

10. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
11. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
12. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
