



Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 36" Cat Panel - Gray (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 20 ½" x 27 ½" panel (A-1), centered on the (4) cats.
- (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " panel (A-2), centered on the vertical yellow and white cat.
- (1) 15 1/8" x 13" panel (A-3), centered on the horizontal yellow cat.
- (1) 11" x 9" panel (A-4), centered on the small brown and white cat.
- (1) $16 \frac{1}{8}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " panel (A-5), centered on the white and gray cat.

From the Splash - Violet (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 18 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 27 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 23 ½" WOF strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 13" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 18 1/8" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 9" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 14" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 10 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 19 1/8" strips.

From the Balls of Yarn - Yellow (C), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 ½" squares.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" x 17" strip and (1) 3" x 13" strip.

From the Yarn Allover - Black (D), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Fusion Illusion - Sunshine (E), cut:

- (2) 2 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 3/8" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) 2" squares.

From the Cat Collage - Gray (F), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Kittens with Yarn - Gray (G), cut:

• (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 6 ½" squares.

From the Cat Paw Prints - Gray (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" x 12 ½" strip and (1) 1 " x 18 ½" strip.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 2 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) 2 3/8" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 13" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (1) 2" x 29 ½" WOF strip and (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strip from each WOF strip.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strip.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1" x 17" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 2" x 47" strip.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56" strip.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 50" strip.

From the Fusion Illusion - Guava (I), cut:

- (3) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ³/₄" x 59" strips.
- (3) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ³/₄" x 52 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Cat Toss - Gray (J), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 61 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 ½" x 52 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the Cat Faces Outlines - Gray (Backing), cut:

• (2) 72" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 81" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 27 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 ½" x 27 ½" **A-1** panel. Sew (1) 2" x 23 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-1 panel. Trim the block to measure 22 ½" x 29 ½" to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1).

Block One Trim to measure 22 ½" x 29 ½" after the borders are added



2. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 10 ½" x 18 ½" **A-2** panel. panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-2 panel. Trim the block to measure 13" x 20 ½" to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).

Block Two

Trim to measure 13" x 20 ½" after the borders are added



3. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric B strip to each side of the 15 1/8" x 13" **A-3** panel. Sew (1) 2" x 18 1/8" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-3 panel. Trim the block to measure 17" x 15" to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 3).

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Block Three

Trim to measure 17" x 15" after the borders are added




4. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric B strip to each side of the 11" x 9" A-4 panel. Sew (1) 2" x 14" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-4 panel. Trim the block to measure 13" x 11" to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 4).





5. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 16 1/8" x 10 1/2" **A-5** panel. Sew (1) 2" x 19 1/8" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-5 panel. Trim the block to measure 18" x 12 ½" to make (1) Block Five rectangle (Fig. 5).

Block Five

Trim to measure 18" x 12 1/2" after the borders are added





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
- 6. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
- 7. Follow Figure 8 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric H square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 9).
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (7) Unit 1 blocks total.




- 9. Repeat Steps 6-7 using (5) 6 ½" Fabric F squares and (20) 2 ½" Fabric H squares to make (5) Unit 2 blocks (Fig. 10).
- 10. Repeat Steps 6-7 using (20) 3 ½" Fabric D squares and (40) 2" Fabric H squares to make (20) Unit 3 blocks (Fig. 11). Note: The 2" Fabric H squares are only on the top (2) corners of the Fabric D square.



11. Place (1) 2 3/8" Fabric E square on top of (1) 2 3/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 12). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 12). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 2" square to make (2) Unit 4 blocks (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (40) Unit 4 blocks total.





12. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square, (2) Unit 4 blocks and (1) 2" Fabric E square together to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (20) Unit 5 blocks total.



13. Sew (1) Unit 5 block to each side of (1) Unit 3 block to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 block to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) row together to make (1) Block Six square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (5) Block Six squares total.





14. Sew (1) 1" x 17" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the (1) 3" x 17" Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 17).



15. Sew (1) Unit 2 block, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 block, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip and (1) Unit 2 block together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 18).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

16. Sew (1) Unit 6 block to the top of (1) Block Three rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric H strip to the right side of the Block Three strip. Sew (2) Block Six squares together and sew this strip to the right side of the Fabric H strip. Sew (1) 3" x 12 ½" Fabric H strip to the left side of (1) Block Five rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to the top of the Block Five strip. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Block Six strip. Sew (1) 2" x 47" Fabric H strip to the bottom of the sewn strip to make the Top Row (Fig. 19).



17. Sew (1) Unit 2 block, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 block, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 2 block, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 block, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip and (1) Unit 2 block together lengthwise. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric H strip to the bottom of the sewn strip to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 20).




18. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 3" x 13" Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 21).



19. Sew together (3) Block Six squares and (2) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric H strips, alternating them. Sew (1) 2" x 29 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Block Six strip to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 22).

20. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to the right side of (1) Block One rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the top of the Block One strip. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to the top of (1) Block Two rectangle. Sew (1) Block Four rectangle to the top of the Unit 9 strip. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Unit 10 strip to make the Bottom Row (Fig. 23).





- 21. Sew the Top and Bottom rows together to make the Center Block.
- 22. Sew (1) 2" x 56" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 50" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 23. Sew (1) 1 ³/₄" x 59" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 52 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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- 24. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 61 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Unit 1 block to each end of (1) 6 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 25. Layer and quilt as desired.

- 26. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 27. Bind as desired.
