$1 / 3$ yard Fusion Illusion - Guava (I)
$17 / 8$ yards Cat Toss - Gray (J)
4 yards Cat Faces Outlines - Gray (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 36" Cat Panel - Gray (A), fussy cut:
-(1) $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 27 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ panel (A-1), centered on the (4) cats.

- (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 18 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ p panel (A-2), centered on the vertical yellow and white cat.
- (1) $15 \frac{1}{8 \prime}$ " $13 "$ panel (A-3), centered on the horizontal yellow cat.
-(1) 11" x 9" panel (A-4), centered on the small brown and white cat.
-(1) $16 \frac{1}{1}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ panel (A-5), centered on the white and gray cat.

From the Splash - Violet (B), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 271 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 231 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) $2 " \times 13 "$ strips.
- (1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) 2 " $\times 18 \frac{1}{8} "$ strips.
-(1) $2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) $2 " \times 9 "$ strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) $2 " \times 14 "$ strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) $2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2 "}$ strips.
-(1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut
(2) $2 " \times 191 / 8 "$ strips.

From the Balls of Yarn - Yellow (C), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
-(1) $3 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $3 " \times 17 "$ strip and
(1) $3 " \times 13 "$ strip.


## From the Yarn Allover - Black (D), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Fusion Illusion - Sunshine (E), cut:

- (2) $23 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $23 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) $2 "$ squares.

From the Cat Collage - Gray (F), cut:
-(1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Kittens with Yarn - Gray (G), cut:
-(2) $61 / 2 \prime$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Cat Paw Prints - Gray (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" x $121 / 2 "$ strip and
(1) 1 "x $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $23 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) $23 / 8 "$ squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) $2 "$ squares.
- (1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " x 13 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (1) $2 " \times 291 / 2 "$ WOF strip and
(1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 91 / 2 "$ strip from each WOF strip.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 341 / 2 "$ WOF strip.
- (1) 1 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 " x 17 " WOF strips.
- (2) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 2 " x 47 " strip.
- (3) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 56 "$ strip.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 50 "$ strip.

From the Fusion Illusion - Guava (I), cut:

- (3) $13 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 59 "$ strips.
- (3) $13 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Cat Toss - Gray (J), cut:

- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the Cat Faces Outlines - Gray (Backing), cut:
-(2) $72 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $72 " \times 81 "$ back.

## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 271 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $201 / 2 " \times 27^{1 / 2 "}$ A-1 panel. Sew (1) 2" x $231 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{A}-1$ panel. Trim the block to measure $221 / 2 " \times 291 / 2 "$ to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1).

## Block One

Trim to measure $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 291 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
after the borders are added

2. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 181 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $101 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ A-2 panel. panel. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-2 panel. Trim the block to measure 13 " $\times 201 / 2$ " to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).

Block Two
Trim to measure $13^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1 / 2 \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ after the borders are added

3. Sew (1) 2 " x 13 "

Fabric B strip to each side of the $15^{1 / 8 "}$ x 13 " A-3 panel. Sew (1) 2" x 18 1/8" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-3 panel. Trim the block to measure 17 " $\times 15$ " to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 3).

## Block Three

Trim to measure $17^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$
after the borders are added

4. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric B strip to each side of the 11 " x 9" A-4 panel. Sew (1) 2" x 14 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-4 panel. Trim the block to measure 13 " x 11 " to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 4).

5. Sew (1) $2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $16 \frac{1 / 8 "}{} \times 101 / 2 "$ A-5 panel. Sew (1) 2 " x $191 / 8$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-5 panel. Trim the block to measure 18 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ to make (1) Block Five rectangle (Fig. 5).

## Block Five

Trim to measure $18^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ after the borders are added

6. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square on the top left corner of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.
7. Follow Figure 8 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric H square to each of the remaining corners of the $61 / 2$ " Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 9).
8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (7) Unit 1 blocks total.

9. Repeat Steps $6-7$ using (5) $61 / 2$ " Fabric F squares and (20) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H squares to make (5) Unit 2 blocks (Fig. 10).
10. Repeat Steps 6-7 using
(20) $31 / 2 /$ Fabric D squares and (40) 2" Fabric H squares to make (20) Unit 3 blocks (Fig. 11). Note: The 2"
Fabric H squares are only on the top (2) corners of the Fabric D square.

11. Place (1) $23 / 8$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) $23 / 8$ " Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 12). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 12). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 2 " square to make (2) Unit 4 blocks (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (40) Unit 4 blocks total.

12. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square, (2) Unit 4 blocks and (1) 2" Fabric E square together to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (20) Unit 5 blocks total.

14. Sew (1) 1 " $x 17$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the (1) 3 " x 17 " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 17).

15. Sew (1) Unit 2 block, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip,
(1) Unit 1 block, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip and
(1) Unit 2 block together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 18).

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

16. Sew (1) Unit 6 block to the top of (1) Block Three rectangle. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the right side of the Block Three strip. Sew (2) Block Six squares together and sew this strip to the right side of the Fabric H strip. Sew (1) $3 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the left side of (1) Block Five rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to the top of the Block Five strip. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Block Six strip. Sew (1) 2" x 47 " Fabric H strip to the bottom of the sewn strip to make the Top Row (Fig. 19).

17. Sew (1) Unit 2 block, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 block, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 2 block, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 block, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 6 \frac{112 "}{}$ Fabric H strip and (1) Unit 2 block together lengthwise. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the bottom of the sewn strip to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 20).

18. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 13$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 3" x 13 " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 21).
19. Sew together (3) Block Six squares and (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 91 / 2$ " Fabric H strips, alternating them. Sew (1) 2 " x $291 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Block Six strip to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 22).
20. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to the right side of (1) Block One rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the top of the Block One strip. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to the top of (1) Block Two rectangle. Sew (1) Block Four rectangle to the top of the Unit 9 strip. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Unit 10 strip to make the Bottom Row (Fig. 23).

21. Sew the Top and Bottom rows together to make the Center Block.
22. Sew (1) 2" $\times 56$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 50$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
23. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 59 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

24. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 611 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Unit 1 block to each end of (1) $61 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
25. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
26. Bind as desired.
27. Layer and quilt as desired.
