# **CUTTING DIRECTIONS**

### Note:

WOF= Width of fabric (from selvedge to selvedge)

### A. From the swan picture patches panel print, cut:

- (4) 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles, centering design in each.
- (2) 9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares, centering design in each.

### B. From blue feather, cut:

- (1) 151/2" x WOF. Subcut (16) 2" x 151/2" rectangles.
- (1) 121/2" x WOF. Subcut (16) 2" x 121/2" rectangles.
- (2) 5" x WOF. Subcut (16) 31/2" x 5" rectangles.

### C. From scroll geo blue, cut:

- (1) 151/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (26) 11/2" x 151/2" rectangles.
- (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 31/2" x 5" rectangles.
- (3) 11/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (5) 11/2" x 151/2" rectangles.
- (10) 1" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 1" x 91/2" and (16) 1" x 101/2" rectangles.

### D. From denim feather, cut:

- (2) 31/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 31/2" x 5" rectangles.
- (4) 21/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 21/2" x 141/2" rectangles.

### E. From blue swan, cut:

• (1) 91/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 91/2" squares.

### F. From denim swan, cut:

- (1) 91/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 91/2" squares.
- (2) 31/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 31/2" x 5" rectangles.

### G. From scroll geo denim, cut:

- (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (18) 31/2" x 5" rectangles.
- (1) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strip. Subcut (10) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares.
- (9) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips for binding.

- (3) 15½" x WOF strips. Subcut (62) 1½" x 15½" rectangles.
- (9) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 74<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" and (2) 3" x 87<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (7) 2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2" x 60½" and (2) 2" x 75½" strips.
- (15) 11/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 11/2" x 121/2" rectangles, (16) 11/2" x 101/2" rectangles, and (80) 11/2" x 11/2" squares.
- (8) 1" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 1" x 151/2" rectangles and (8) 1" x 141/2" rectangles.

### I. From scroll geo cream, cut:

- (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (14) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 5" rectangles.
- (1) 31/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (10) 31/2" squares.

### J. From brown feather, cut:

• (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares and (4) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 5" rectangles.

# **BLOCK A**

1. Sew (2) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" denim feather rectangles to the top and bottom of a  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " panel rectangle.



2. Sew (2) 1" x 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" color blends vanilla rectangles to the sides, followed by (2)  $1" \times 15\frac{1}{2}"$  color blends vanilla rectangles to the top and bottom. The block should measure 151/2" x 151/2".





**3.** Repeat for the remaining 10½" x 14½" panel blocks.

### **Block B**

**1.** Sew (2)  $1" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$  scroll geo blue rectangles to the sides of a  $9\frac{1}{2}"$  panel square, followed by (2)  $1" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$  scroll geo blue geometric rectangles to the top and bottom to make a block center.



Sew (2) 1½" x 10½" color blends vanilla rectangles to the sides of the block center, followed by
 (2) 1½" x 12½" color blends vanilla rectangles to the top and bottom.

**3.** Sew (2)  $2" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$  blue feather rectangles to the sides of the block center, followed by (2)  $2" \times 15\frac{1}{2}"$  blue feather rectangles to the top and bottom to complete 1 block.




**4.** Repeat with the remaining 9½" panel squares to make a total of 8 blocks.

# **SETTING UNITS**

**1.** Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " color blends vanilla rectangles to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " scroll geo blue rectangle to complete a sashing unit. Make 31 sashing units.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 1½" color blends vanilla square. Place a marked square on a 3½" scroll geo cream square, right sides together. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal triangle. Repeat on the remaining corners to complete a snowball cornerstone. Make 10 scroll geo cream and 10 scroll geo denim snowball cornerstones.



# **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for the following steps

**1.** Lay out the blocks, sashing units, and snowball cornerstones.

**2.** Sew the blocks and vertical sashing units into 4 rows. Sew the snowball cornerstones and horizontal sashing units into 5 rows. Join the rows to complete the quilt center.

**3.** Sew the 2" x  $75\frac{1}{2}$ " color blends vanilla strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by the 2" x  $60\frac{1}{2}$ " color blends vanilla strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**4.** Arrange and sew together (26) 3½" x 5" print rectangles to make a side border. Make 2 side borders, and sew them to the sides of quilt center.

**5.** Join (20)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangles to make the top border. Add a 5" brown feather square to each end of the border. Repeat for the bottom border. Add the borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

**6.** Referring to the quilt diagram on page 1, sew the  $3" \times 87\frac{1}{2}"$  color blends vanilla strips to the sides of the quilt, followed by the  $3" \times 74\frac{1}{2}"$  color blends vanilla strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

# FINISHING

**1.** Cut the backing fabric into two 2<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>-yard pieces. Join the pieces lengthwise.

- **3.** Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 4. Quilt as desired.

**5.** Use the 2¼"-wide scroll geo denim strips to make double-fold binding. Sew the binding to the quilt.
