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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:



Fabrics A, H, and R - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (3) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 12 triangles] and (12) 2-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles]

Fabrics B, D, J, and Q - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (12) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Fabrics C, I, M, and S - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles] and (8) 2-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles]

Fabric E - Cut (7) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 71-1/2" and (2) 2" x 61" borders



Fabrics F, G, K, and L - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (8) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces


Fabric N - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (30) 2" squares

Fabrics O and P - From each fabric:


Cut (6) 2" strips

Fabric T - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (3) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 12 triangles] and (12) 2-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles]

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric U - Cut (3) 4-1/4" strips, subcut (20) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 80 triangles] and (8) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (9) 3-1/2" strips, from 5 strips subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares and (80) 2" x 3-1/2" strips

Cut (5) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (80) 2-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 160 triangles]

Fabric U (continued) - Cut (25) 2" strips, from 17 strips subcut (49) 2" x 12-1/2" strips

Cut (7) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 69-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 58" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabrics P** and **U** 2" x width of fabric strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 4 strip sets. From these cut (80) 2" wide Unit 1a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 80 Unit 1b with **Fabrics O** and **U**.



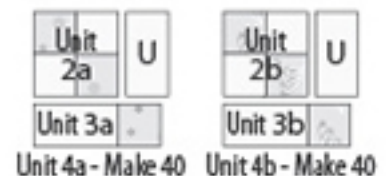
2. Sew 2 Unit 1a together as shown. Make a total of 40 Unit 2a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 40 Unit 2b using 2 Unit 1b.



3. Stitch **Fabric P** 2" x width of fabric and **Fabric U** 3-1/2" x width of fabric strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 2 strip sets. From these cut (40) 2" wide Unit 3a (2" x 5" unfinished). In the same manner, make 40 Unit 3b with **Fabrics O** and **U**.



4. Stitch a **Fabric U** 2" x 3-1/2" strip to side of a Unit 2a as shown. Add a Unit 3a as shown. Make a total of 40 Unit 4a (5" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 40 Unit 4b using fabric and units indicated.



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5. Sew 2 **Fabric T** 2-3/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric U** 4-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 5a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 5b-5h indicated with fabrics shown.

6. Sew 2 **Fabric U** 2-3/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric T** 4-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 6a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 6b-6h indicated with fabrics shown.

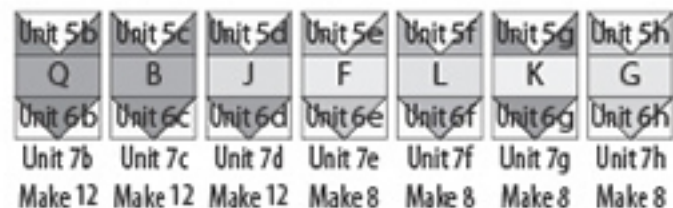

7. Sew a **Fabric D** 2" x 3-1/2" piece between 1 each Units 5a and 6a. Make a total of 12 Unit 7a (3-1/2" x 5" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 7b-7h indicated with units and fabrics shown.

8. Arrange 4 Unit 7a, 1 **Fabric U** 3-1/2" square, and 2 each Units 4a and 4b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 3 **Block 1** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 3

9. In the same manner, make blocks listed with units as indicated and 1 **Fabric U** 3-1/2" square.

- Make 3 **Block 2** with 4 Unit 7b and 2 each Units 4a and 4b
- Make 3 **Block 3** with 4 Unit 7c and 2 each Units 4a and 4b
- Make 3 **Block 4** with 4 Unit 7d and 2 each Units 4a and 4b
- Make 2 **Block 5** with 4 Unit 7e and 2 each Units 4a and 4b
- Make 2 **Block 6** with 4 Unit 7f and 2 each Units 4a and 4b
- Make 2 **Block 7** with 4 Unit 7g and 2 each Units 4a and 4b
- Make 2 **Block 8** with 4 Unit 7h and 2 each Units 4a and 4b

10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, squares, strips, and borders.

11. Arrange blocks, **Fabric N** 2" squares, and **Fabric U** 2" x 12-1/2" strips in 11 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (56" x 69-1/2" unfinished).

12. Stitch **Fabric U** 1-1/2" x 69-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric U** 1-1/2" x 58" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

13. Stitch **Fabric E** 2" x 71-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 61" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

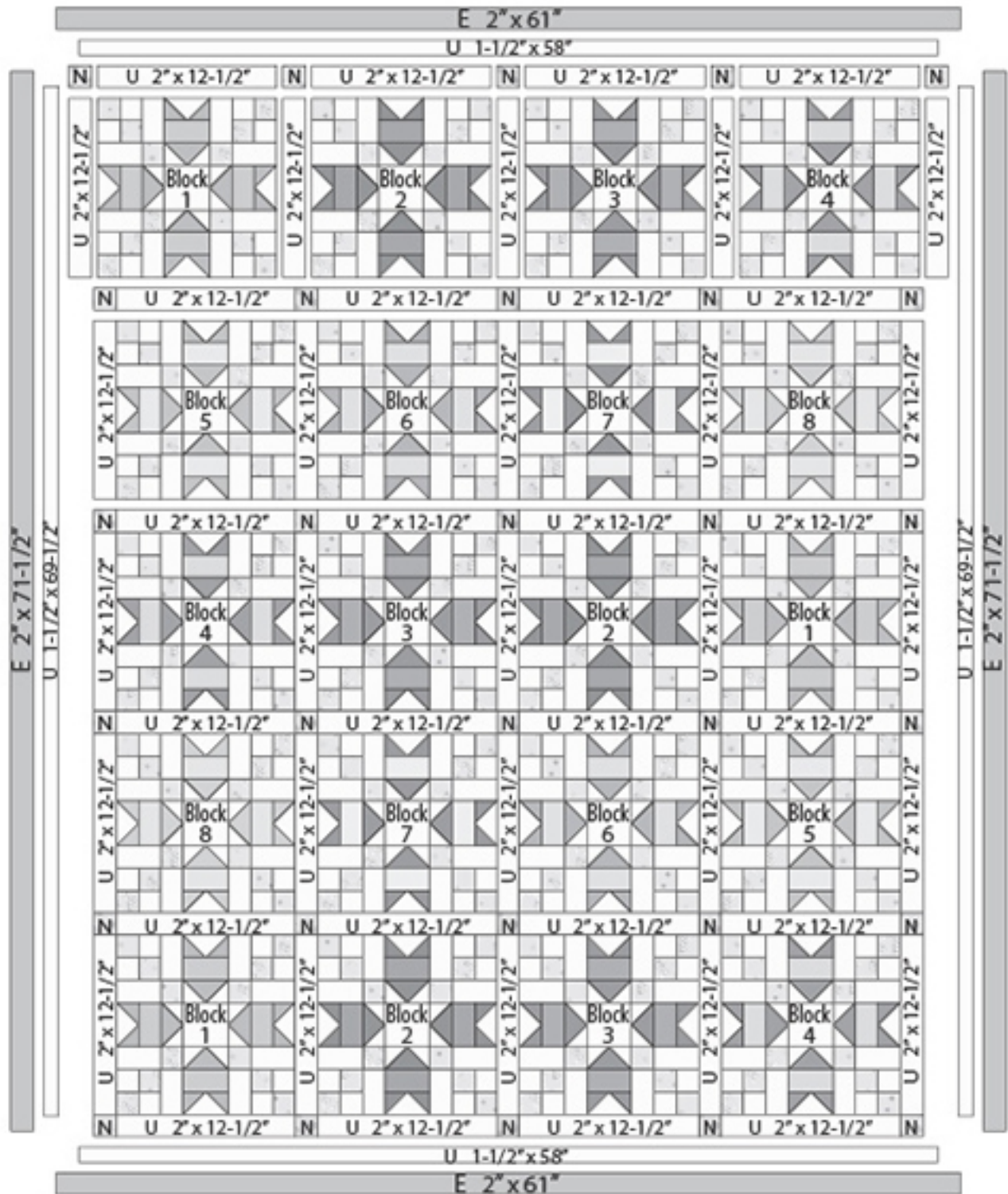
14. The quilt measures approximately 61" x 74-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric V**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric T**) and enjoy!!

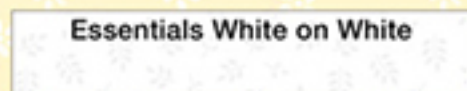
