Wall Quilt: 45" x 59"



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Queen Quilt: 82 1/2" x 89 1/2"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Wall Quilt:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42-1/2"



Fabric B - Cut (3) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (15) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 60 triangles 


Fabric C - Cut (1) 5-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 5-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles 

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 32" strips

Fabric D - Cut (2) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice for 32 triangles] and (2) 5-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles]  

Fabric E - Cut (2) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 32 triangles 

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 55-1/2" borders
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders

NOTE: Not all Fabrics D and E triangles cut are used.

2. Piecing Order for Wall Quilt:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **D** 5-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (5-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

2. Arrange 2 **Fabric B** and 1 each **Fabrics D** and **E** 6-1/4" triangles as shown. Stitch together. Make a total of 30 **Block 2** (5-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 30

3. Refer to Wall Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of border, strips, borders, and blocks.

4. Stitch **Fabric C** 4-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/2" x 32" **Fabric C** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 30-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).*

5. Arrange 9 **Block 2** on right and left sides of bordered panel in vertical rows. Stitch into vertical borders (5-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished) then add to sides of bordered panel.

6. Arrange 2 **Block 1** and 6 **Block 2** above and below the bordered panel in horizontal rows. Stitch into horizontal borders 5-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished) then add to top and bottom of bordered panel.

7. Sew **Fabric F** 3" x 55-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

8. The quilt measures approximately 45-1/2" x 59-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.


9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Queen Quilt:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42-1/2"

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Fabric B - Cut (3) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (15) 6-1/4" squares [then cut in half  diagonally twice for 60 triangles] and (1) 5-1/2" x 10" piece

Cut (4) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 5-1/2" x 10" piece and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 84" borders

Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 83" borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 5-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 5-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 4 triangles



Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips


Cut (4) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 77" borders

Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 32" strips

Cut (4) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 68" borders

Fabric D - Cut (2) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/4" squares [then cut in half  diagonally twice for 32 triangles] and (2) 5-7/8" squares [then cut in half  diagonally for 4 triangles]

Fabric E - Cut (2) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half  diagonally twice for 32 triangles

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 55-1/2" borders

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut

(2) 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders

Fabric G - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/4" x 80" and (2) 9-1/4" x 66" multi-stripe borders

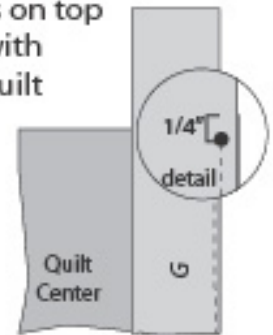
Fabric H - Cut (4) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 80" borders
Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 73" borders

4. Piecing Order for Queen Quilt:

1. Referring to Steps 1-7 in Piecing Order for Wall Quilt make the quilt center (45-1/2" x 59-1/2" unfinished).

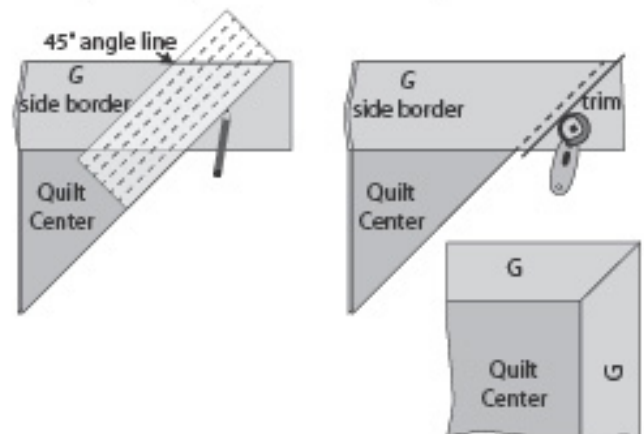
2. Refer to Queen Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of borders.

3. Center **Fabric G** 9-1/4" x 80" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric G** 9-1/4" x 66" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the butterfly stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

4. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



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5. Sew **Fabric C** 3" x 77" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 2" x 68" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

6. Sew **Fabric H** 3" x 80" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 73" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

7. Sew **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 84" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric B** 3-1/2" x 83" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

8. The quilt measures approximately 83" x 90" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!

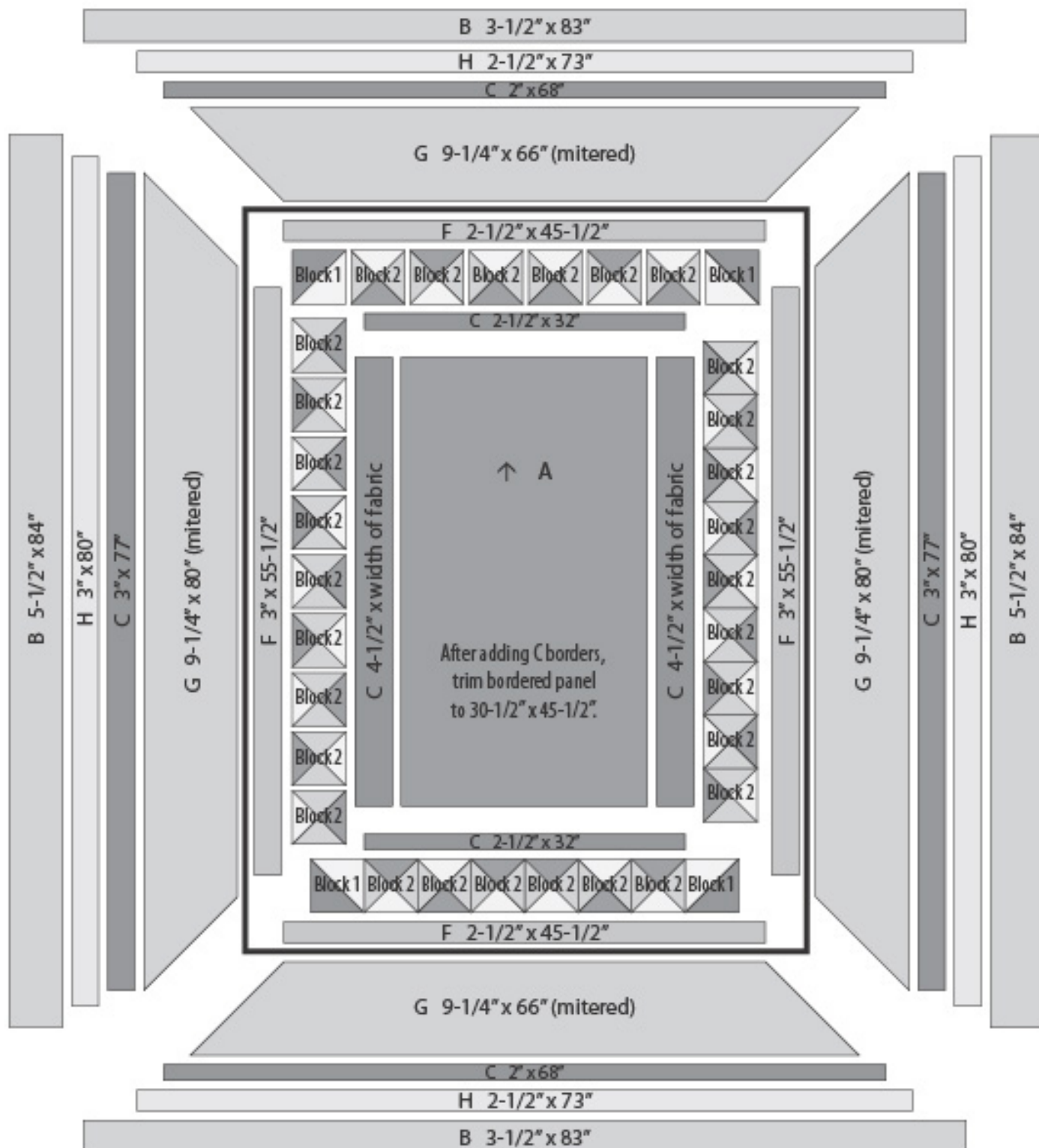
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QUEEN QUILT LAYOUT

Arrow indicates orientation of directional print.

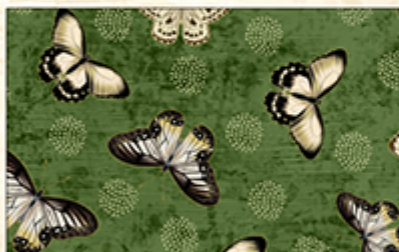

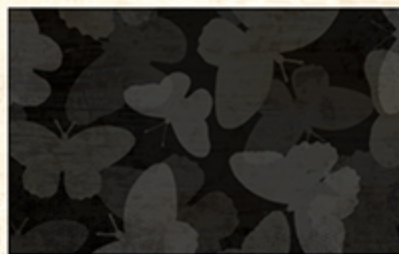

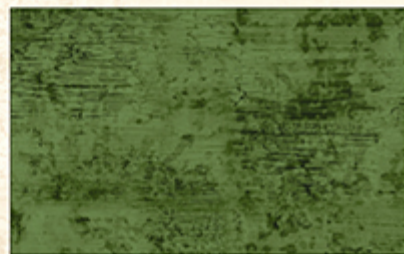

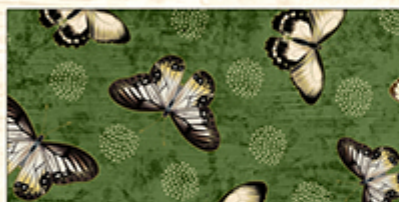
