Materials

2/3 yard	Block Scenes - Multi (A)	F1339-33
1 yard	Pinecone Snowflakes - Red (B)	F1340-88*
3/8 yard	Fluffy Solids - Black (C)	Fluffy Solids - Black
7/8 yard	Pinecone Snowflakes - Green (D)	F1340-66
1/2 yard	Plaid - Red (E)	F1345-88
1/4 yard	Branches with Pinecones - Brown (F)	F1344-33
2 yards	Novelty Stripe - Multi (G)	F1346-33
5/8 yard	Animals - White/Multi (H)	F1342-90
4 yards	Winter Scene - Gray (Backing)	F1343-90

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Block Scenes - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (6) 10" squares each centered on a block.

From the Pinecone Snowflakes - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Fluffy Solid - Black (C), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 11 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Pinecone Snowflakes - Green (D), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (96) 2 1/2" squares.
- (2) 2" x 39 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 1/2" strips.

From the Plaid - Red (E), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Branches with Pinecones - Brown (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (G), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 65" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 53" LOF strips.

From the Animals - White/Multi (H), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (6) 8 1/2" squares.

From the Winter Scene - Gray (Back), cut:

- (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 57" x 69" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim to measure 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

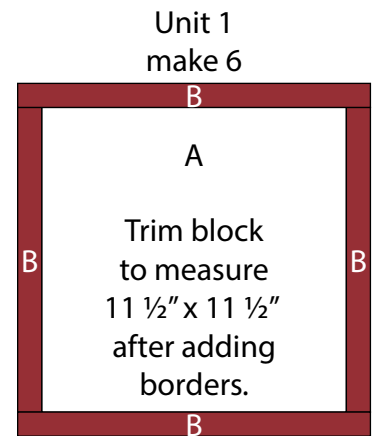

2. Sew (1) 1" x 11 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

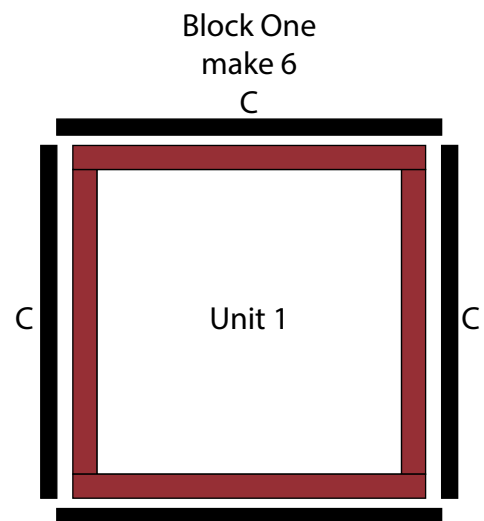

3. Place one 2 1/2" Fabric D square on the left side of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

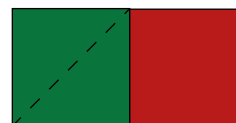

4. Place another 2 ½” Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½” x 4 ½” Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼” seam allowance to make one Unit 2 strip (Fig. 6).

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (48) Unit 2 strips total.

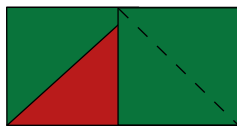

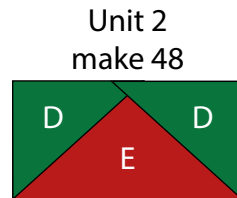

6. Sew together (1) 2 ½” Fabric F square, (2) Unit 2 strips and (1) 2 ½” Fabric F square to make the Block Two top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew (2) Unit 2 strips together end to end to make one side unit. Repeat to make a second side unit. Sew the side units to (1) 8 ½” Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

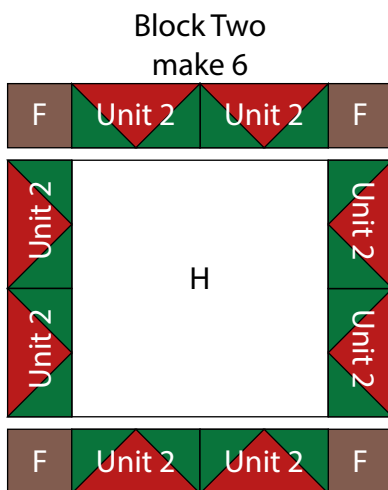

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

8. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

9. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.

10. Sew (1) 2” x 48 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2” x 39 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

11. Center one 5 ½” x 65” Fabric G strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼” from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a ¼” from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

12. Repeat Step 11 to sew one 5 ½” x 53” Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start ¼” away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 8).

13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 8), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼” seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

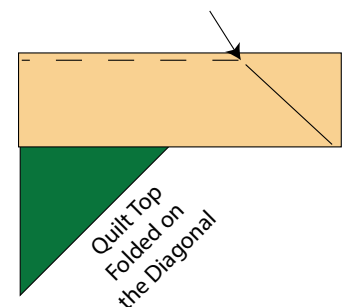
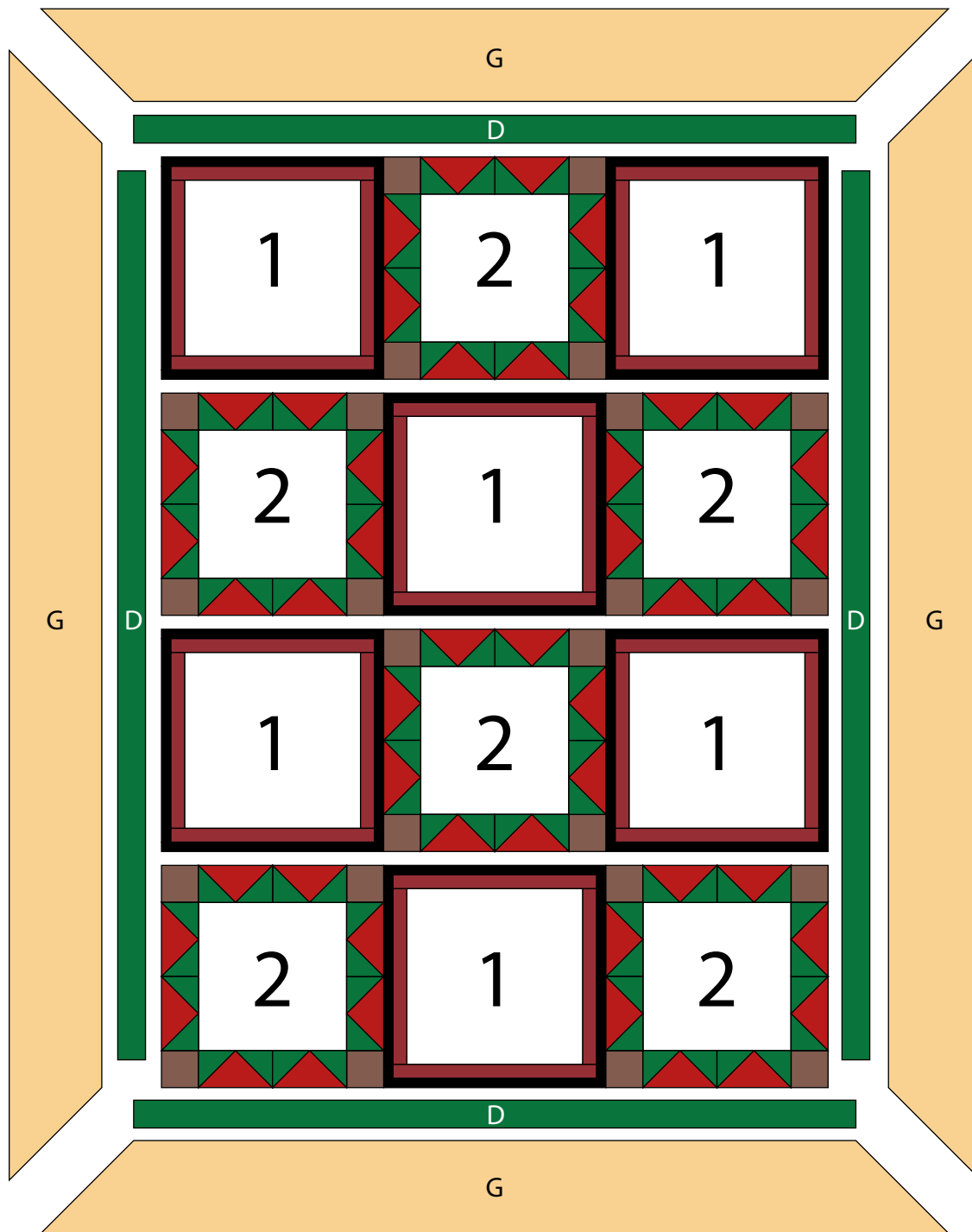

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (6) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
