Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric B - Fussy cut (6) 7-1/2" squares with motifs centered

Fabric C - Cut (2) 15-3/8" strips, subcut (3) 15-3/8" squares [then cut in half 🔀 diagonally twice for 12 triangles] and (2) 8" squares [then cut in half diagonally, each in a different direction, for 4 triangles


Fabric D - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 65-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 54" borders Cut (12) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (2) 5-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 5-7/8" squares [then cut in half / diagonally for 24 triangles] and (4) 2-5/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally 🔀 twice for 16 triangles] Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 62-1/2" and (2) 2" x 50" borders Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (17) 1-1/2" squares


2. Piecing Order:

1. Cut 2 identical 24" x width of fabric strips of Fabric A. Fold each, right side out, in half with selvage edges together and prints aligned.



Stack strips on top of each other so the prints are aligned. Pin layers together.

2. From Fabric A stacked strips cut (12) 5-1/2" squares, for a total of 48 squares. Pin squares in each stack



Arrange 4 Fabric A squares from 1 stack in 2 rows as shown. so the print forms a mirror image where the squares meet. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12



Block 1 - Make 12

Block 1 (10-1/2" square unfinished).

 Sew 4 Fabric F 5-7/8" triangles to sides of a Fabric B 7-1/2" square. Make a total of 6 Block 2 (10-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, squares, triangles, and borders.

Arrange blocks, Fabric E 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" sashing strips, Fabric F 1-1/2" squares and 2-5/8" triangle cornerstones, and Fabric C 15-3/8" and 8" setting triangles in 15 diagonal rows. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together into guilt center (47" x 62-1/2" unfinished).

7. Stitch Fabric F 2"x 62-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric F 2" x 50" borders to top and bottom of guilt center.

 Stitch Fabric E 2-1/2"x 65-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric E 2-1/2" x 54" borders to top and bottom of quilt.


The quilt measures approximately 54"x 69-1/2" (unfinished), Make backing (Fabric G) approximately 8" larger than the

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric D) and enjoy!!

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2"x 42-1/2"


Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 6" x 59" and (2) 6" x 40" floral stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 28" strips


2. Piecing Order:

- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, and borders.
- Stitch Fabric C 2"x width of fabric strips to sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2"x 28" Fabric C strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 44-1/2" (unfinished).
- Center Fabric B 6" x 59" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and

Fabric B 6" x 40" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the blue texture next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.




Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints. 4. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 5. The wall quilt measures approximately 36-1/2" x 55-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric D**) 6-8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric C) and enjoy!!


