## Hydrangea Dreams

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 8 panels to approximately 9" x 11-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 9-1/2" x 85" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 12-1/2" square

Fabric D - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares Cut (2) 2" strips Cut (11) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (16) 1-1/4" x 13-1/2" and (16) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

Fabric E - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 6-1/2" squares Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 3-7/8" squares then cut in [half diagonally ☐ for 8 triangles] and (4) 3-1/2" squares Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (28) 3-1/2" squares Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric F - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (44) 3-1/2" squares Cut (2) 2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut
(4) 3-7/8" squares [half diagonally for
8 triangles] and (7) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (45) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end
and cut into (2) 2" x 63-1/2" and
(2) 2" x 60-1/2" borders

Fabric H - Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/2" squares. Trim remaining strip into (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 12" strips.


#### Fabric H - (continued)

Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 81-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 85-1/2" borders. Trim remaining strip to 1-3/4", subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 12" strips. Cut (4) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (12) 1-3/4" x 12" strips

Fabric I - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 6-1/2" squares

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch Fabric H
1-3/4" x 12" strips to right
and left sides of a Fabric A
panel. Add Fabric D
1-1/4" x 12" strips to right
and left of Fabric H strips.



Block 1 - Make 8

Trim Fabrics D and H strip ends even. Add 1-1/4"" x 13-1/2" Fabric D strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 8 **Fabric D**, 24 **Fabric G**, and 16 **Fabric H** 3-1/2" squares.



3. Arrange a **Fabric G** marked 3-1/2" square on corner of a **Fabric E** 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on an adjoining corner as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 1 (6-1/2" square unfinished).









Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Unit 1 - Make 12

4. In the same manner

4. In the same manner make 8 Unit 2 and 4 Unit 3 with fabrics shown.







Unit 2 - Make 8 Unit 3 - Make 4

Arrange 1 each Units 1 and 2 and 2 each Fabrics E, F, G, and H 3-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Block 2 (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Block 3 with units and fabrics shown.






6. Sew Fabrics D and F 2" strips together lengthwise. Make a second pieced strip. From these, cut 32 Unit 4 (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished).

- 7. Sew 2 Unit 4 together alternating fabrics as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 5 (3-1/2" square unfinished).
- Cut 16 Stitch 1 each Fabrics E and F 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 6 (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the Unit 6 same manner, make 8 Unit 7 with Curt 8 fabrics shown.
- 9. Arrange Units 5-7 (U5, U6, and U7) and Fabrics E, F, and G 3-1/2" squares in 4 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 4 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



- 10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (60-1/2" square unfinished).

- 12. Stitch Fabric G 2"x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric G 2"x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 13. Center Fabric B 9-1/2" x 85" borders on all sides of quilt center with navy butterfly edge next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides 1/4" starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt detail center. Do not trim. Press borders out. 8 Quilt ተ Center

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler. mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- 16. The guilt measures approximately 85-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric E) and enjoy!!


