# Wilmington Batiks Counterpoint


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.  
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage..


## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabrics A and B** - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (6) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 24 triangles


Cut (10) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (76) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 152 triangles


**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-1/4" square then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles

Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabrics D through R** - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-1/4" square then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles

Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

NOTE: Not all cut 5-1/4" triangles will be used.

## 2. Piecing Order:

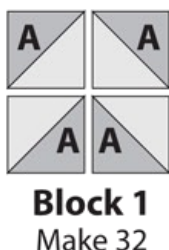
1. Sew 1 **Fabric A** to 1 **Fabric C** 4-7/8" triangle as shown. Repeat to make a total of 128 triangle units all with **Fabric A** and 8 each with **Fabrics C-R** triangles (unfinished 4-1/2" square).



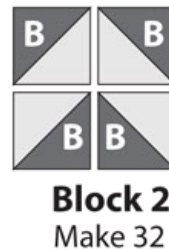
2. Sew 1 **Fabric B** to 1 **Fabric C** 4-7/8" triangle as shown. Repeat to make a total of 128 triangle units all with **Fabric B** and 8 each with **Fabrics C-R** triangles (unfinished 4-1/2" square).



3. Randomly combine 4 **Fabric A** triangle units in 2 rows as shown. Stitch units into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 32 **Block 1** (unfinished 8-1/2" square).



4. Randomly combine 4 **Fabric B** triangle units in 2 rows as shown. Stitch units into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 32 **Block 2** (unfinished 8-1/2" square).



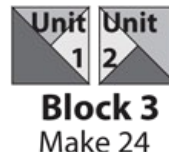
5. Sew a **Fabric A** 5-1/4" triangle to a **Fabric C** triangle as shown. Add a **Fabric B** 4-7/8" triangle to long side. Make a total of 24 Unit 1, 3 each with **Fabrics C-R**.



6. Sew a **Fabric B** 5-1/4" triangle to a **Fabric C** triangle as shown. Add a **Fabric A** 4-7/8" triangle to long side. Make a total of 24 Unit 2, 3 each with **Fabrics C-R**.



7. Arrange 1 each Units 1 and 2 as shown. Stitch together. Make a total of 24 **Block 3** (unfinished 4-1/2" x 8-1/2").



8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of sections and rows.

9. Arrange blocks in 11 rows of 8 blocks each. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together.

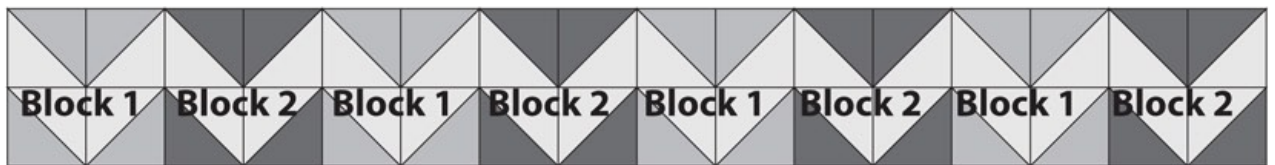
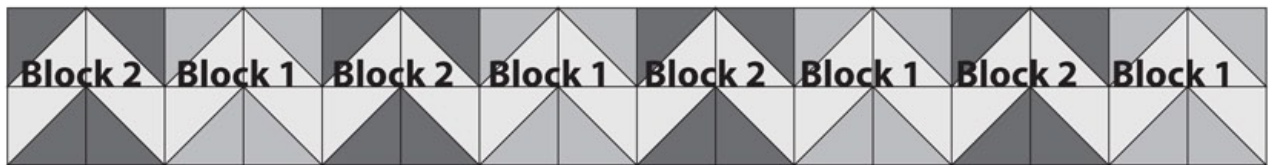
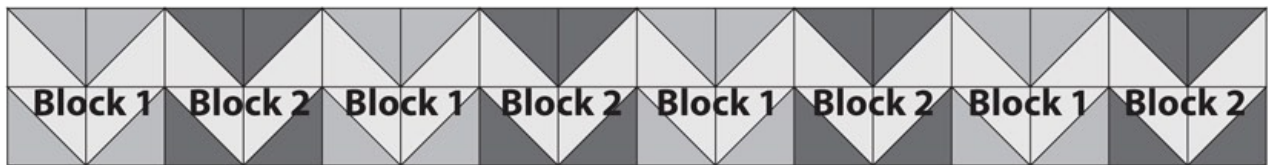
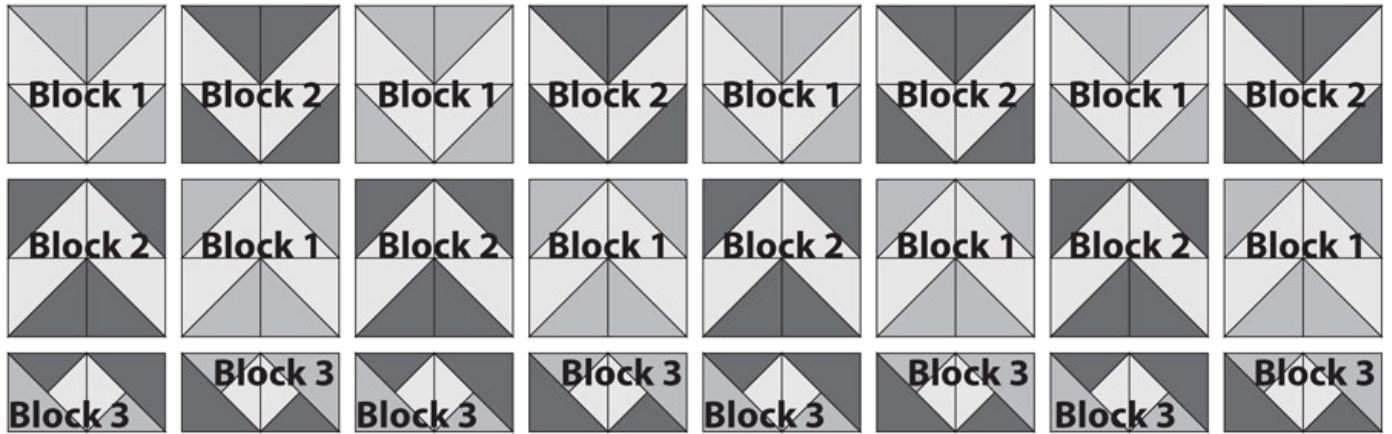
10. The quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 76-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric S**) at least 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!

All Fabrics C-R are shown as the same lightest gray shade, and are randomly placed.

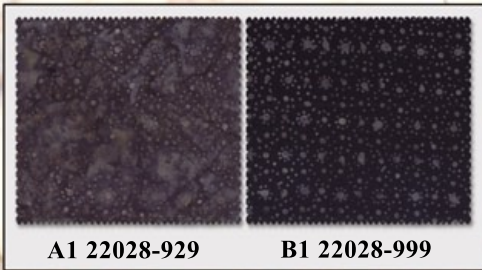

C 22028-333: 1 1/8 yards (*Includes Binding*)

All other fabrics: 1/2 yard

S 45" Backing (*quilter's choice*): 4 1/4 yards
