BASIC Duvet Cover - Twin, full, queen, or king with 2 pillowcases

ALL FABRICS ARE 108" WIDE	Fabric A Back, cuff, & 2 pillowcases	Fabric B Top/front of duvet	Ties 3/4" Twill tape or ribbon
Twin-sized (approx. 66" x 85") With 2 Standard cases	3-1/8 yds	2-1/8 yds	3 yds
Full size (approx. 84" x 88") With 2 Standard cases	4-1/4 yds	2-5/8 yds	4 yds
Queen size (approx. 88" x 100") With 2 Queen cases	4-5/8 yds	2-3/4 yds	5 yds
King size (approx. 94" x 100") With 2 King cases	4-3/4 yds	3 yds	5 yds

BASIC Duvet Cover and Pillowcases

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

NOTE: For ease of measuring and pressing hems we used the Dritz 18" x 9" Drapery Hem Gauge.

Twin Size:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 100-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 68" x 100-1/2". From remaining strip cut (2) 37-1/2" x 44" pieces for standard pillowcases

Fabric B - Cut (1) 68" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 68" x 90-1/2" and (4) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces

Twill Tape - Cut (4) 3/4" x 25" strips

Full Size:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 103-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 86" x 103-1/2"

Cut (1) 37-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (2) 37-1/2" x 44" pieces for standard pillowcases

Fabric B - Cut (1) 86" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 86" x 93-1/2" and (5) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces

Twill Tape - Cut (5) 3/4" x 25" strips

Queen Size:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 115-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 90" x 115-1/2"

Cut (1) 41-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (2) 41-1/2" x 44" pieces for queen pillowcases

Fabric B - Cut (1) 90" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 90" x 105-1/2" and (6) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces

Twill Tape - Cut (6) 3/4" x 25" strips

King Size:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 115-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 96" x 115-1/2"

Cut (1) 47-1/2" x 108" strip, subcut (2) 47-1/2" x 44" pieces for king pillowcases

Fabric B - Cut (1) 96" x 108" strip, subcut (1) 96" x 105-1/2" and (7) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces

Twill Tape - Cut (7) 3/4" x 25" strips

NOTE: Yardage is not calculated for custom sizes.

OPTION: Custom Size for Duvet Cover:

Fabric A - Cut (1) piece for duvet that is the (width of comforter + 2") wide by (15-1/2" + length of comforter) and (4 or more) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces

Cut 2 pieces for pillowcases based on measurements under twin or queen sizes above

Fabric B - Cut (1) piece that is the (width of comforter + 2") wide by (5-1/2" + length of comforter)

Sizes shown on duvet cover diagrams are for twin size. Refer to text for measurements for full and queen sizes.

2. Piecing Order:

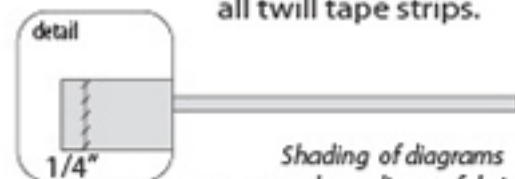
1. On **Fabric B** piece, fold 1 (68" TWIN, 86" FULL, 90" QUEEN, 96" KING) edge to wrong side 1-1/2" and press flat. Fold to wrong side again 3" and press flat. Topstitch hem in place. Topstitch 1/2" from top and bottom folded edges of hem. *Optional:* Use a decorative stitch for 1/2" stitching.



2. Fold a 1-1/2" x 3" **Fabric B** piece into a 1-1/2" square, right side out. Stitch around all raw edges with a zig zag or overcast stitch. Make (4 TWIN, 5 FULL, 6 QUEEN, 7 KING).

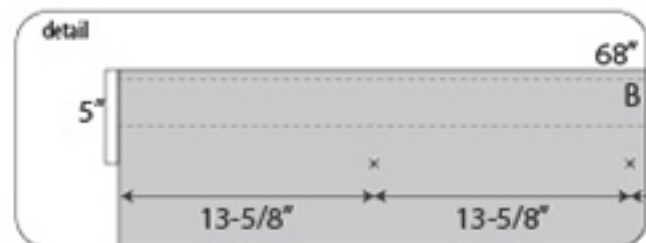


3. Fold both short ends of a piece of twill tape to 1 side 1/4", then 1/4" again. Hand stitch down folded ends. Repeat on all twill tape strips.

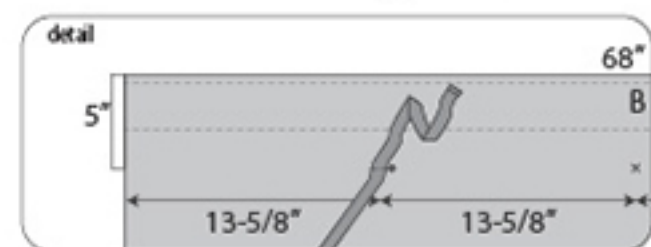

4. Measure 5" down from hemmed top on right side of **Fabric B** and mark (4 TWIN, 5 FULL, 6 QUEEN, 7 KING) equally spaced marks across the width (approximately 13-5/8" TWIN, 14-3/8" FULL, 12-7/8" QUEEN, 12" KING).



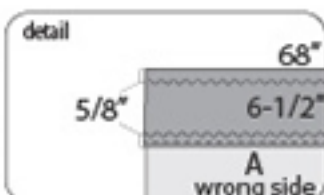
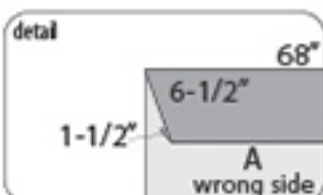
5. On 1 mark, pin a strip of twill tape (12" from each end and hemmed side face up) as shown. On the wrong side of fabric, center a prepared **Fabric B** 1-1/2" square from Step 2 behind the mark and catch it with the pin as well.



6. Using a narrow zigzag stitch, sew through all layers where pinned. Repeat to add remaining strips of twill tape.



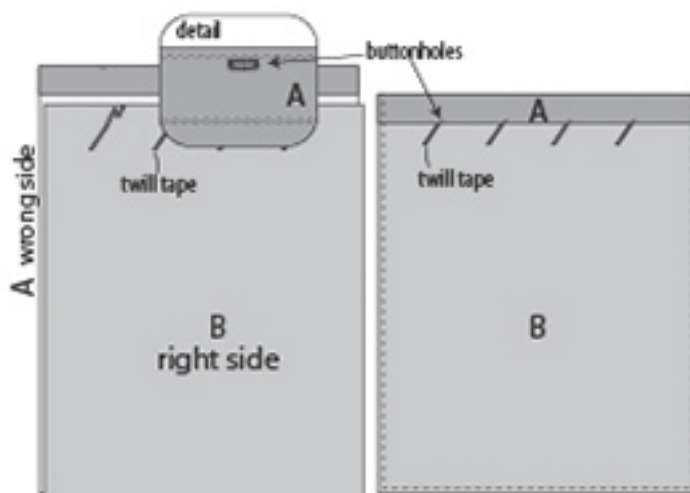
7. On **Fabric A** piece top fold 1 (68" TWIN, 86" FULL, 90" QUEEN, 96" KING) edge to wrong side 1-1/2" and press flat. Fold to wrong side again 6-1/2" and press flat. Topstitch hem in place. Topstitch 5/8" from top and bottom folded edges of hem (use decorative stitch if desired).



8. In the same manner as Step 4, measure 5/8" down from top on wrong side of **Fabric A** and make (4 TWIN, 5 FULL, 6 QUEEN, 7 KING) equally spaced marks across the width (approximately 13-5/8" TWIN, 14-3/8" FULL, 12-7/8" QUEEN, 12" KING).



9. Referring to your sewing machine's manual, make a 1-1/4" wide buttonhole centered over each mark, parallel to the stitching. Repeat to make a buttonhole over each mark.



10. Arrange **Fabric A** and **Fabric B** wrong sides together, aligning long edges and the bottom, unhemmed edge. Fold hemmed edge of **Fabric A** over top of **Fabric B** 6". Stitch bottom and side edges together with a 3/8" seam allowance. Trim corners.

11. Turn wrong side out and press flat. Sew bottom and side edges with 5/8" seam allowance enclosing raw edges and previous seam.

12. Turn right side out. Twin finished size approximately 66" x 85". Full finished size approximately 84" x 88". Queen finished size approximately 88" x 100". King finished size approximately 94" x 100".

13. Insert comforter. Slide 1 end of each twill strip into its corresponding buttonhole. Tie ends of each twill strip together.

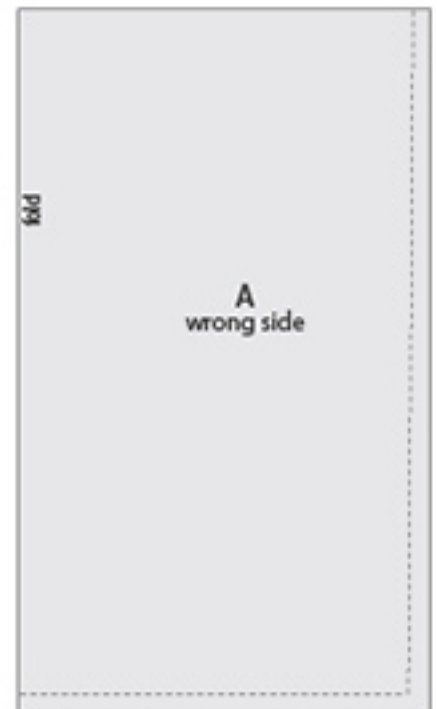
To Make Pillowcases:

14. Fold a **Fabric A** (37-1/2" x 44" TWIN/FULL, 41-1/2" x 44" QUEEN, 47-1/2" x 44" KING) pillowcase piece in half, wrong sides together, so it measures (37-1/2" x 22" TWIN/FULL, 41-1/2" x 22" QUEEN, 47-1/2" x 22" KING).

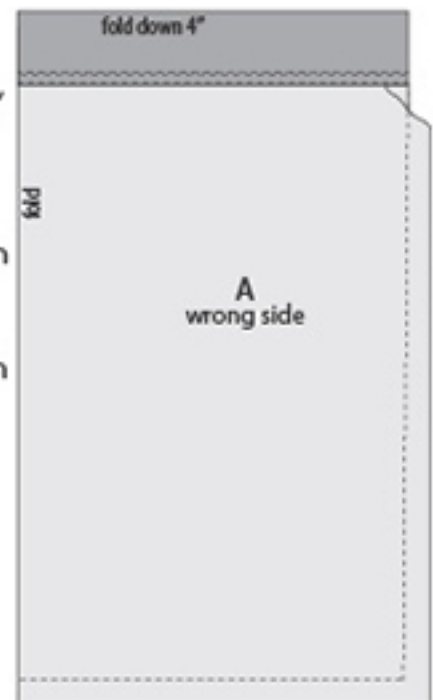
Stitch open side and bottom together with 3/8" seam allowance. Clip corners.



15. Turn wrong side out. Stitch side and bottom seams with 5/8" seam allowance enclosing the first seam.



16. Fold open edge down to wrong side 1/2" and then 4" and press. Topstitch close to fold. Topstitch 1/2" from first line (use decorative stitch if desired).



17. Turn right side out. Make a second pillowcase.

18. Twin/full size finished pillowcase each approximately 21" x 32". Queen size finished pillowcase each approximately 21" x 36". King size finished pillowcase each approximately 21" x 42".
