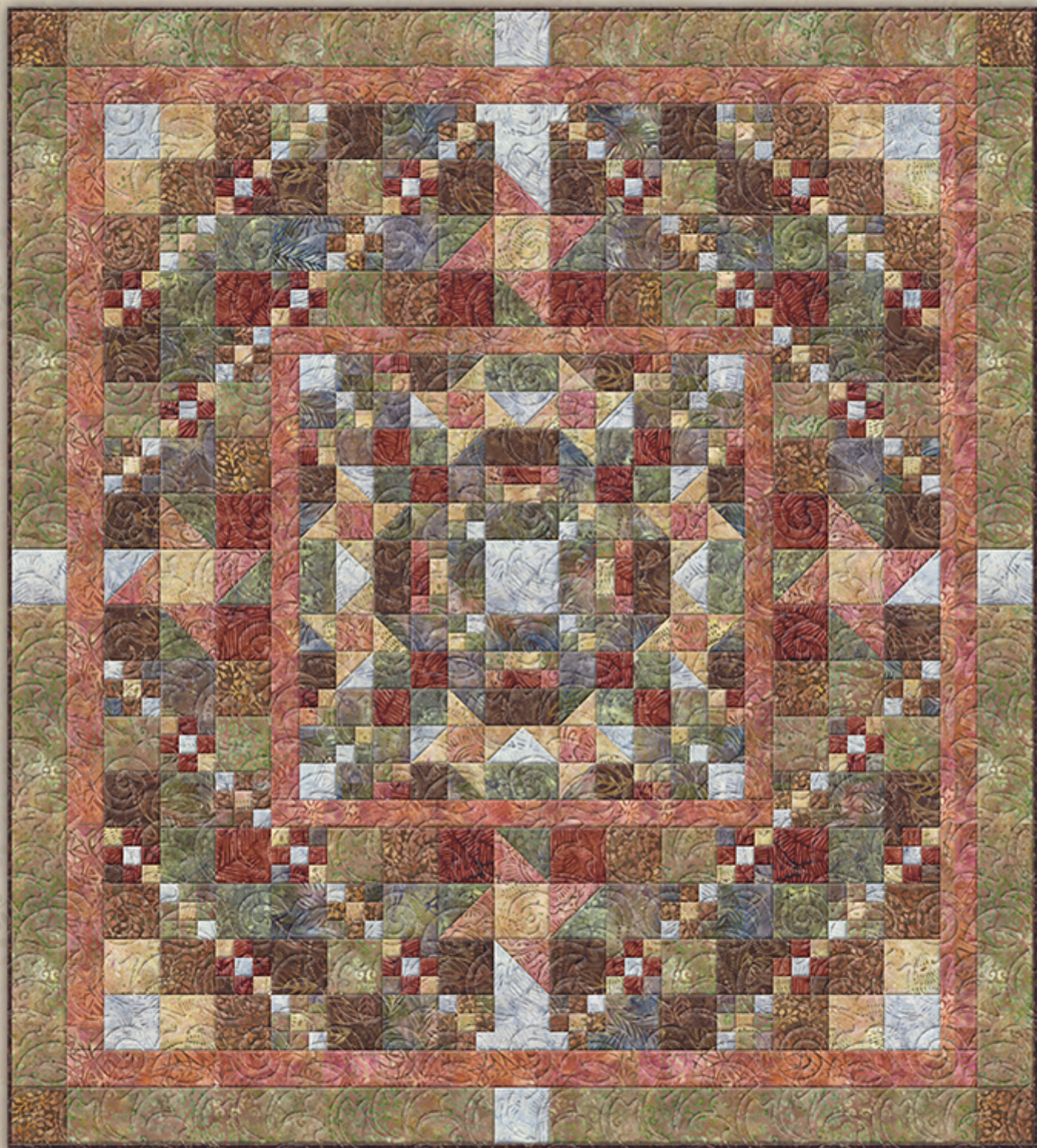

# Inside Out

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


## 1. Cut the following:

*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*

**Fabric A** - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (8) 2-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles]

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (10) 3-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (76) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares


Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (16) 2-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 32 triangles] and (4) 1-1/2" squares  
Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (84) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric C** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/2" squares


Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (64) 1-1/2" squares


**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares and (16) 1-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles] and (4) 1-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (28) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (8) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 26-1/2" strips, (4) 3-1/2" x 23-1/2" strips, (16) 3-1/2" squares, and (48) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric G** - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles] and (2) 1-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares and (14) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 12 triangles] and (16) 1-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric I** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares and (12) 1-1/2" squares  
Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (84) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric J** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares and (12) 1-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (28) 1-1/2" squares

**Fabric K** - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" borders

Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 27-1/2" and (2) 2" x 24-1/2" borders

**Fabric L** - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange 2 **Fabric H** and 1 each **Fabrics A** and **B**



1-1/2" squares in 2 rows.

Stitch into rows. Sew rows

together. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (2-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner make 8 each Units 1b and 1c with fabrics indicated.

2. Arrange 1 each Units 1a -1c, 1 each **Fabrics A** and **I** 2-1/2" squares, and 2 each **Fabrics E** and **J** 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows.



Stitch into rows. Sew rows

together. Make a total of 8 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

3. Sew **Fabrics B** and **E** 2-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 2a (2-1/2" square unfinished). Make a total of 16 Unit 2b with

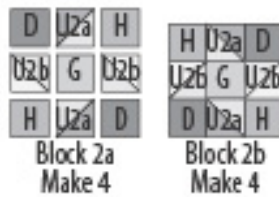


**Fabrics A** and **B** 2-7/8" triangles.

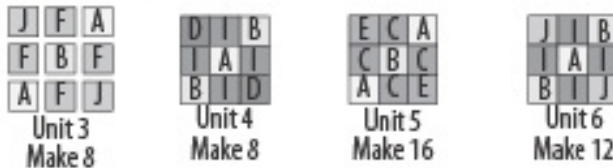

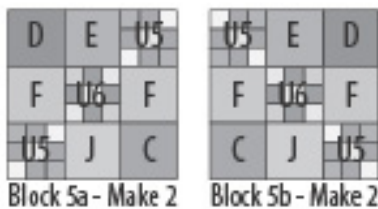
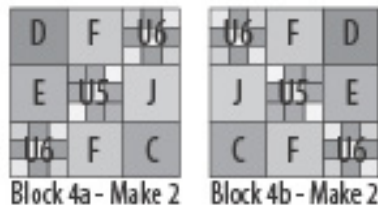
4. Arrange 2 each Units 2a and 2b, 1 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" square, and 2 each **Fabrics D** and **H** 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 2a** (6-1/2" square unfinished). Make 4 **Block 2b** with fabrics and units arranged as shown.



5. Arrange 1-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to make 8 each Units 3 and 4, 16 Unit 5, and 12 Unit 6 with fabrics indicated (3-1/2" square unfinished).



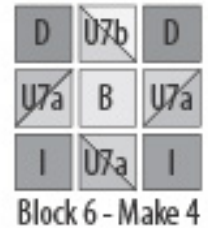
6. Arrange 1 Unit 3, 2 Unit 4, 2 each **Fabrics C** and **H** 3-1/2" squares, and 1 each **Fabrics B** and **I** 3-1/2" squares in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (9-1/2" square unfinished). Make 2 each **Blocks 4a, 4b, 5a, and 5b** with fabrics and units arranged as shown.



7. Sew **Fabrics G** and **H** 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 12 Unit 7a (2-1/2" square unfinished). Make a total of 4 Unit 7b with **Fabrics A** and **G** 3-7/8" triangles.



8. Arrange 3 Unit 7a, 1 Unit 7b, 2 each **Fabrics D** and **I** 3-1/2" squares, and 1 **Fabric B** 3-1/2" square in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 6** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



9. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, units, borders, strips, and squares.

10. Arrange **Blocks 1, 2a, and 2b** in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (24-1/2" square unfinished).

11. Sew **Fabric K** 2" x 24-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric K** 2" x 27-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

12. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 5a, 5b, and 6** on each side of quilt center. Stitch into vertical rows (9-1/2" x 27-1/2" unfinished). Sew to sides.

13. Arrange 2 **Block 3** and 1 each **Blocks 4a, 4b, and 6** in rows above and below quilt center. Stitch into rows (9-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Add to top and bottom of quilt center.

14. Arrange 2 each Units 3 and 5, 3 **Fabric A** 3-1/2" squares, and 2 each **Fabrics B, C, D, and E** 3-1/2" squares in rows above and below quilt. Stitch into rows (3-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished) then sew to top and bottom of quilt (45-1/2" x 51-1/2" unfinished).

15. Sew **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

16. Sew a **Fabric A** 3-1/2" square between 2 **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 26-1/2" strips (3-1/2" x 55-1/2" unfinished). Make 2. Sew to right and left sides of quilt.

17. Sew a **Fabric A** 3-1/2" square between 2 **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 23-1/2" strips. Add **Fabric C** 3-1/2" squares to ends (3-1/2" x 55-1/2" unfinished). Make 2. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

18. The quilt measures approximately 55-1/2" x 61-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

19. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric L**) and enjoy!!

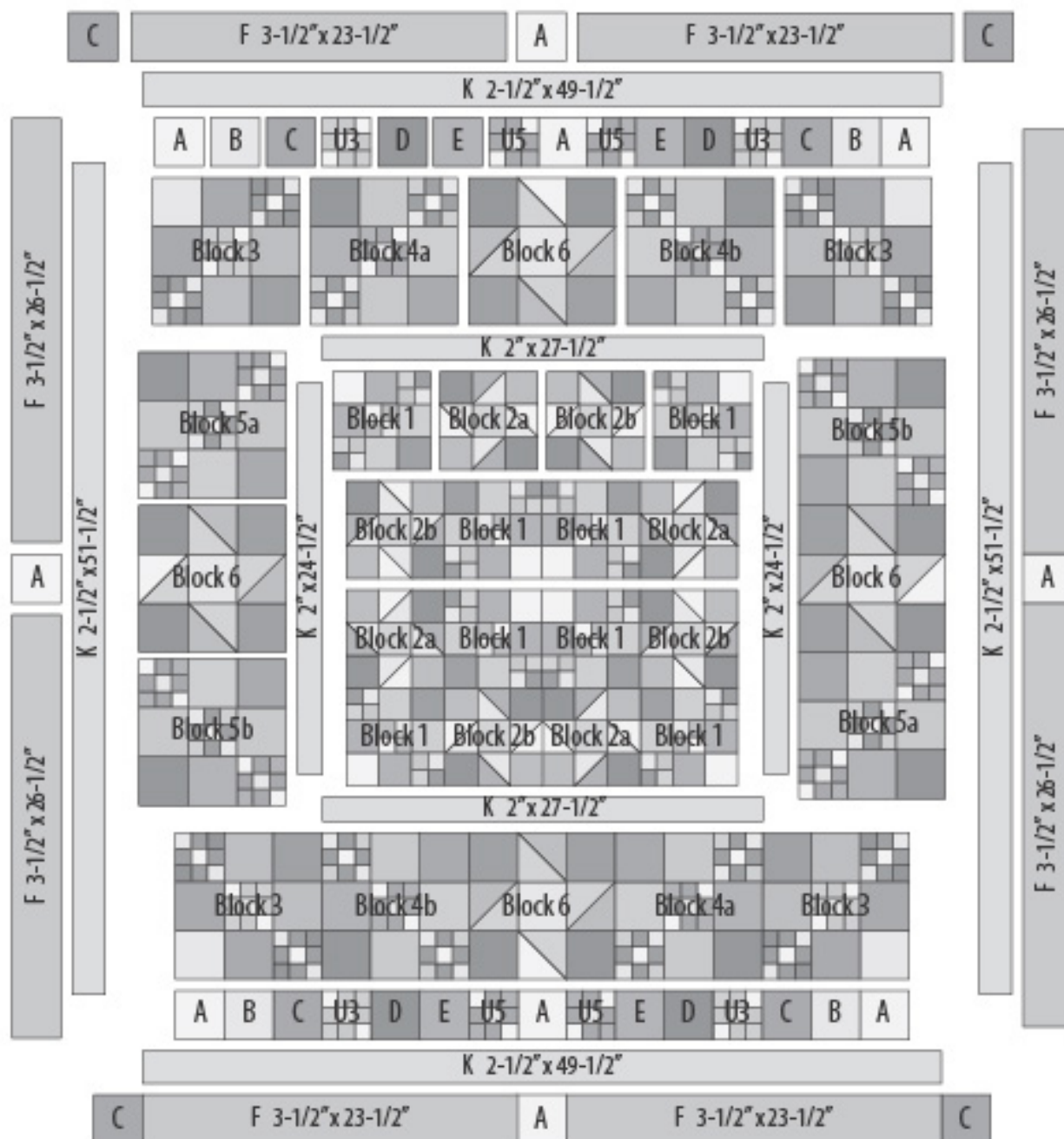

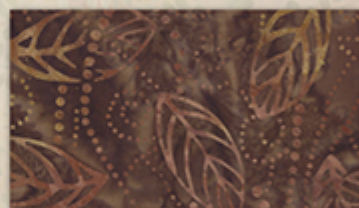
