WHAT YOU'LL NEED


For fabric choices refer to the block diagram

A: 4 squares 2" x 2"

B: 1 square 4 ¼" x 4 ¼", cut twice diagonally

C: 16 squares 1 %" x 1 %"

D: 4 squares 2 %" x 2 %"






4. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS half-squaretriangles layer a light and a dark D square. Make a total of 4 half-square-triangle-units. Trim the units to 2" square. Arrange D/D half half-square-triangle-units into pinwheel as shown. Sew them into rows and press. Join the rows and press to make the center unit.



5. Arrange A squares, units #2 and center unit into three rows as shown. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to complete the block. Block measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".

ASSEMBLY


 ${\it 1.}$ Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS half-squaretriangles layer a light and a dark C square. Make a total of 8 half-square-triangle-units. Trim the units to 1 1/4" square.







3. Sew two units #1 to a B triangle. Press. Make four
