

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#### **Aubergine Free Quilt Pattern Instructions**

For best results, read the pattern completely first.

#### Flying Geese Block

- 1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 20  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 3 squares.
- 2. Place a 4½" fabric 3 square right side down over a 4½" x 8½" fabric 2 rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim ¼" away from stitch line. Press toward darker fabric.





Repeat step 2 on the opposite side using another 4½" square.
 Make 10.



Make 10, 41/2" x 81/2"

4. Sew a 4½" x 8½" fabric 1 rectangle to the flying geese units from step 3. Make 10.



Make 10, 8½" x 8½"


#### Flying Geese For Outer Borders

- 5. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 16 4½" fabric 8 squares.
- 6. Place a 4½" fabric 8 square right side down over a 4½" x 8½" fabric 4 rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim ¼" away from stitch line. Press toward darker fabric.
- 7. Repeat step 6 on the opposite side using another  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 8 square. Make 8.




#### **Background Block A with Long Seeds Applique**

8. Sew a 2½" fabric 1 strip to each long side of a 4½" fabric 4 strip. Press away from center. Sub-cut the strip set into 2 units, 4½" wide, and 6 units, 2½" wide.



9. Sew a 2½" x 8½" fabric 4 rectangle to a 4½" wide unit from the strip set (step 8). Press away from center. Make 2.



Background Block A, Make 2


 Using your favorite technique, stitch the Applique D 'Long Seeds' shapes to the Background 1 blocks. Make 2.



Applique 2 blocks 8½" x 8½"


#### 11. Background Block B with Long Seeds Applique

12. Sew a 2½" fabric 1 strip to each side of the 4½" fabric 4 strip. Press towards center. Sub-cut the strip set into 6 units, 2½" wide.



Cut 6 - 21/2" wide units

- 13. Sew a 2½" x 8½" fabric 4 rectangle to a 2½" unit cut from step 8. Press out.
- 14. Sew a 2½" unit cut from step 11 to the emerging block. Press out. Finish the block with a 2½" x 8½" fabric 1 rectangle. Press out. Make 6.

15. Using your favorite technique, stitch the Applique D 'Long Seeds' shapes to the Background 2 blocks. Make 6




Applique 6 blocks 8½" x 8½"

## 16. Background Block C with Short Seeds & Petals Applique

17. Using your favorite technique, stitch the Applique A 'Petals' shapes, the Applique B 'Short Seeds', and the Applique C 'Centers' to the 9" x 9" fabric 1 squares.

Make 10. Press well and trim to 8½" x 8½".







Applique 10 blocks  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Flying Geese For Inner Borders: You will be making mirror image units

18. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of  $8 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 1 squares and  $8 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 7 squares.

- 19. Place a 4½" fabric 7 square right side down over a 4½" x 8½" fabric 4 rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim ¼" away from stitch line. Press toward center. Make 4. Repeat with fabric 1 squares. Make 4
- 20. Place a 4½" fabric 4 right side down over the step 17 unit. Stitch on the marked line. Trim ¼" away from stitch line. Press toward center. Repeat on the remaining 3 units. Repeat with the fabric 7 squares, make 4.

21. Assemble the following corner section as illustrated: You will use a 4½" fabric 4 square, Background Block C, and two mirror-image, flying geese inner border units from step 16-18.



#### Make the Hourglass Units.


- 22. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4 9\%" fabric 3 squares.
- 23. Place a 9%" fabric 3 square, right side down, over a 9%" fabric 2 square. Stitch 1/4" away from either side of the marked line. Repeat to make 4 units.
- 24. Mark a second diagonal line on the opposite side square corner to corner. You will make two diagonal slices in the next step.
- 25. Cut between the rows of stitching on the first marked line and take care to not move the pieces. Now make a second cut on the 2 marked line in the opposite direction creating 4 sections. You will have 16 sections.





26. Open the triangles and press toward fabric 2. Place a triangle, right side down, over another triangle set. Stitch ¼" away from the edge. Press open. Make 7 (You will have one remaining.)






Make 7 8½" x 8½"

27. Follow the quilt top assembly diagram below to assemble the quilt top and borders. Begin with the center section and build out, adding the sides first, and then the top and bottom sections. Follow this proceedure for the outer border strips.

- 28. Make your quilt sandwich: layer the quilt top, right side up, over the batting and backing, wrong sides up. Baste layers to secure.
- 29. Quilt as desired.
- 30. Make and attach the binding: Join the 2½" fabric 7 strips together to create one continuous piece. Press in half lengthwise. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt with a ¾" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back of the quilt and stitch by hand with matching thread.
