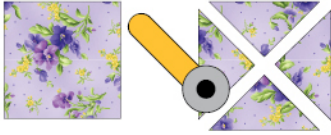

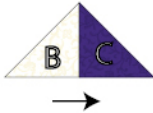

## Instructions

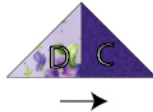
1. Cut the B, C, and D squares twice on the diagonal to make quarter square triangles.



Sew a B triangle to a C triangle. Press in the direction of the C triangle. Make 4.



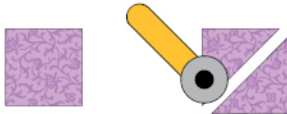
Sew a C triangle to a D triangle. Press in the direction of the C triangle. Make 4



2. Sew the two units from step 1 together. Press seams open. Make 4. Unit is 6" square (unfinished)



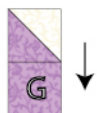
3. Cut the E and F squares once on the diagonal to make half square triangles.



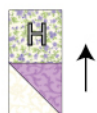
Sew an E triangle to an F triangle. Press in the direction of the F triangle. Make 8. Unit is 3 1/4"



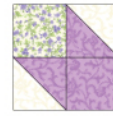
4. Sew a unit from step 3 to G square as shown. Press in the direction of the G square. Make 4.



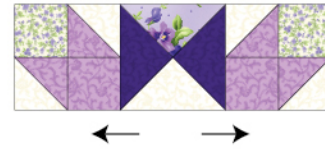
5. Sew a unit from step 3 to H square as shown. Press in the direction of the H square. Make 4.



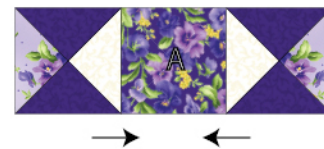
6. Sew a step 4 unit to a step 5 unit as shown. Press open. Combined units make a 6" square (unfinished).



7. Sew a step 2 unit between two step 6 units as shown. Press toward the step 6 units. Make 2.



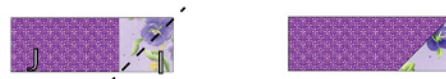
8. Sew the A square in between two step 2 units as shown. Press toward the A square.



9. To make the center block, Sew the rows together as shown. Press all the joining seams open. Block is 17" (unfinished).



10. Place an I square on the right side of a J strip, right sides together. Sew corner to corner along the diagonal as shown. Trim off the excess fabric and press open. Make 2.



11. Place an I square on the left side of a J strip, right sides together. Sew corner to corner along the diagonal as shown. Trim off the excess fabric and press open. Make 2.



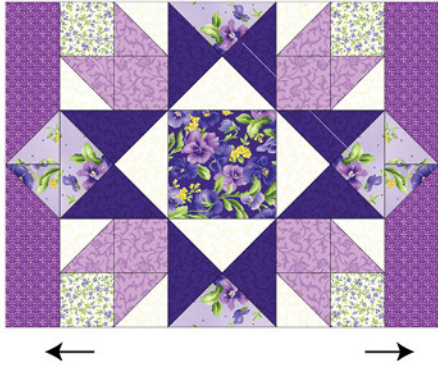
12. Sew a step 10 strip to a step 11 strip as shown. Press open. Make 2.



13. Repeat steps 10 - 12 using K strips and I squares.



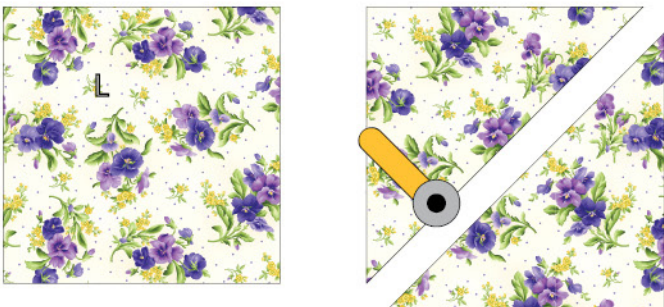
14. Sew the two step 12 strips to the sides of the center block. Press toward the step 12 strips.



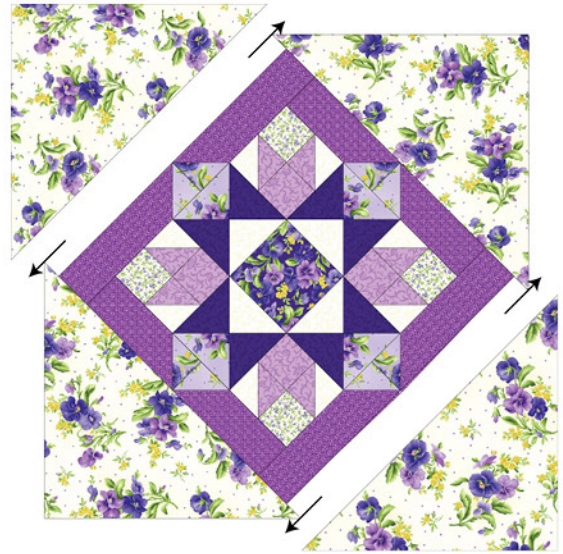
15. Sew the two step 13 strips to the top and bottom of the center block. Press toward the step 13 strips. The block will measure 22½" unfinished.



16. Cut the L squares once on the diagonal to make 4 half square triangles.



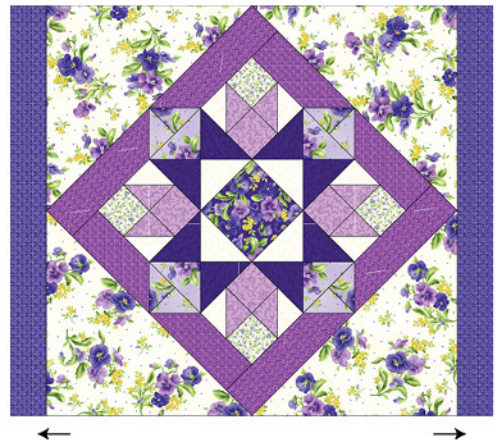
(16 continued) Sew the triangles to the sides of the center block. Press towards the L triangles.



Trim to 31½" square. Make sure to leave ¼" seam allowance for stitching on all sides.



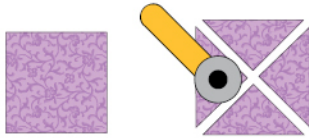
17. Sew an X Inner Border (Fabric 10) strip to each side of the block. Press toward the borders.



18. Sew a Y Inner Border (fabric 10) Strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press away from the center. You should now have a 36½" square block (unfinished).



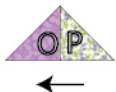
19. Cut the M, N, O, and P squares twice on the diagonal to make quarter square triangles.



Sew an M triangle to an O triangle. Press in the direction of the O triangle. Make 16.



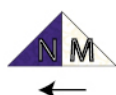
Sew a O triangle to a P triangle. Press in the direction of the O triangle. Make 16.



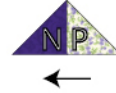
20. Sew the two units from step 18 together. Press seams open. Make 16. At this point, your block should measure 41½" square.



21. Sew a M triangle to a N triangle. Press in the direction of the N triangle. Make 20.



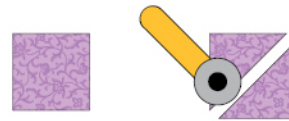
(21 continued) Sew a N triangle to a P triangle. Press in the direction of the N triangle. Make 20.



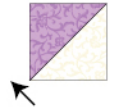
22. Sew the two units from step 20 together. Press seams open. Make 20. At this point, your block should measure 41½" square.



23. Cut the Q, R, S, and T squares once on the diagonal to make half square triangles.



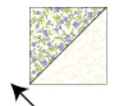
24. Sew a Q triangle to an R triangle. Press in the direction of the R triangle. Make 4.



25. Sew a Q triangle to an S triangle. Press in the direction of the S triangle. Make 8.



26. Sew a Q triangle to an T triangle. Press in the direction of the T triangle. Make 12.



27. Starting with a step 21 unit, sew nine step 19 and 21 units together in a row. Press open. Make 4.



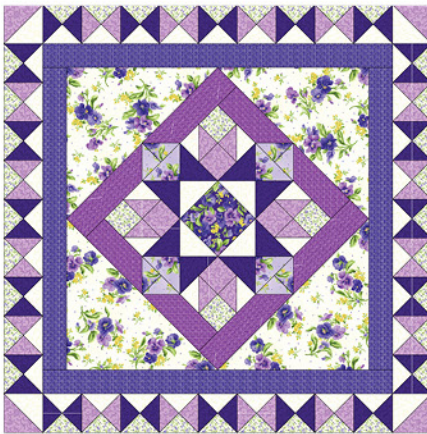
28. Sew two step 23 units to the ends of a step 26 row. Press open. Make 2.



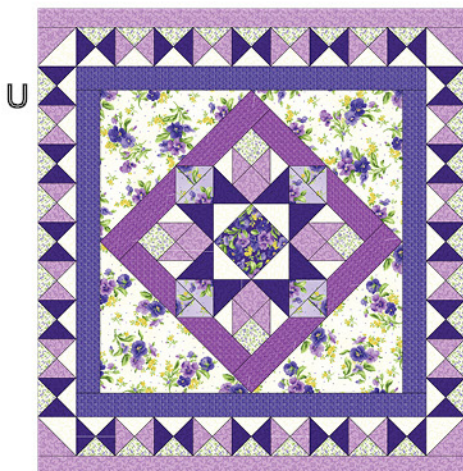
29. Center, pin, and sew the step 26 rows to the sides of the step 17 block. Press toward the center block.



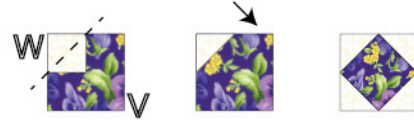
30. Line up, pin and sew the step 27 rows to the top and bottom of the block. Press toward the center block. This is now 44½" square.



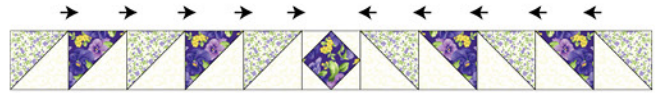
31. Sew the U strips together in pairs end-to-end to make 2 long strips. Trim strips to 44½". Sew to the top and bottom. Press toward the strips.



32. Sew the four W squares to the corners of the V square on the diagonal as shown. Trim off the excess and press toward the center block. Make 2.



33. Using blocks from steps 24, 25, and 31, assemble the row as shown. Press toward the center. Make 2.



34. Center, pin and sew the step 32 units to the top and bottom of the center quilt block. Press toward the center.



35. Sew the first outer border (Fabric 11) strips together in pairs end-to-end to make long strips. Cut the two side borders 56½" and the two top borders 48 1/2" long. Sew the side borders and press seams toward borders. Sew the top borders and press seams toward borders.










36. Match the center of the top and bottom floral borders to the center of the quilt top. Sew the borders (untrimmed) to the quilt, stopping  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge of the quilt top corners. Repeat for the side borders. Miter the corners. 




37. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure.

38. Quilt as desired.

39. Trim the backing and batting flush with the quilt top. Bind the edges using a  $\frac{3}{8}$ " wide seam allowance.

	Fabric 2 MAS9170-V ¼ yd	A: Cut (1) 6" square S: Cut (4) 4⅞" squares V: Cut (2) 4½" squares
	Fabric 3 MAS9177-E ¾ yd	B: Cut (1) 6¾" square E: Cut (4) 3⅝" squares M: Cut (9) 5¼" squares Q: Cut (12) 4⅞" squares W: Cut (8) 2½" squares
	Fabric 4 MAS9177-V 1 yd	C: Cut (2) 6¾" squares N: Cut (10) 5¼" squares Binding: Cut (8) 2½" x WOF strips
	Fabric 5 MAS9172-V2 ¼ yd	D: Cut (1) 6¾" square I: Cut (8) 3¼" squares
	Fabric 6 MAS9177-P ⅝ yd	F: Cut (4) 3⅝" squares G: Cut (4) 3¼" squares O: Cut (8) 5¼" squares R: Cut (2) 4⅞" squares U: Cut (3) 2½" x 24" strips
	Fabric 7 MAS9175-E ½ yd	H: Cut (4) 3¼" squares P: Cut (9) 5¼" squares T: Cut (6) 4⅞" squares
