Finished Size: 48 1/2" x 48 1/2" (123.19cm x 123.19cm)



Supplies Needed

Quilt Front (Farm Fresh Collection)

- 1 yd. (91.44cm) 13804-Blue (Indigo Floral)*
- 7/8 yd. (80.01cm) 13807-White (Wild Flowers)
- ³⁄₄ yd. (68.58cm) White
- 1/2 yd. (45.72cm) 13799-Yellow (Gold Floral)
- ¹/₂ yd. (45.72cm) 13801-Orange (Orange Tonal)
- 1/2 yd. (45.72cm) 13803-Blue (Multi Bubbles)
- 3/8 yd. (34.29cm) 13798-White (Vases)
- 3/8 yd. (34.29cm) 13800-Blue (Lt. Blue Flowers)
- 3/8 yd. (34.29cm) 13802-White (Hens)
- ¹/₈ yd. (11.43cm) 13806-Red (Strawberries)

- * Includes binding
- 2 1/2 yds. (228.6cm) 13803-Blue (Multi Bubbles) for backing

Additional Supplies Needed:


- 56" x 56" (142.24cm x 142.24cm) Cotton batting
- 17" x 117" (43.18cm x 297.18cm) Lightweight fusible web
- 18" (45.72cm) Black embroidery floss
- Scotch Tape
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Print templates at full scale and check that print size matches scale of template. wof = width of fabric

Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below. Reserve the fabric for the appliqué pieces and follow the instructions in Steps 2 and 3.



Sewing


2. Tape the pieces of the Pitcher and Circle templates together overlapping the grey areas. Use the templates provided to trace the appliqué pieces on the paper side of lightweight fusible web leaving ¼" (6mm) between pieces (Dia. A). **Note:** *Templates are full size and have been reversed for tracing.* Cut out pieces ½" (3mm) outside the traced line. Carefully cut out the inner circles exactly on the line so they can be used to make the 8" (20.32cm) and 7" (17.78cm) circles. This will reduce stiffness from multiple layers of fusible on top of each other.

3. Refer to Diagram B to place the fusible web appliqué pieces, adhesive side down, on the **wrong** side of the fabrics. Following the manufacturer's directions, press to fuse. Cut out shapes on the outside traced lines. *Note:* DO NOT cut the fabric centers out of the 10" (25.4cm) and 8 ³/₄" (22.225cm) Circles.





Cut 2 - 7" Circles Appliqué

4. Fold the White square 23 ¹/₂" x 23 ¹/₂" (59.69cm x 59.69cm) in half and lightly press a crease to mark the center. Unfold and repeat in the crosswise direction. Use the creases as a guide and refer to Diagram C to place the appliqué pieces as shown. Remove paper backing as each piece is placed.

Center "Farm Fresh" 1" from the top and 2" from each side.


Center the Pitcher 2" (5.08cm) down from the letters. Place the ends of the handle slightly under the Pitcher. Continue placing the remaining pieces as shown.

Fuse in place according to the manufacturer's directions.

Use a coordinating thread and small buttonhole or zig-zag stitch to secure and finish the edges of the appliqué pieces.

Transfer the markings for the Bird's feet to the background. Use two strands of black embroidery floss and a backstitch to make the feet.


The Center Appliqué should measure 23 ¹/₂" x 23 ¹/₂" (59.69cm x 59.69cm).



Pin and sew the two Gold Floral (13799-Yellow) strips 1" x 23 ½" (2.54cm x 59.69cm) RST to the sides of the Center Appliqué 23 ½" x 23 ½" (59.69cm x 59.69cm) made in Step 4; press. Pin and sew the two Gold Floral (13799-Yellow) strips 1" x 24 ½" (2.54cm x 62.23cm) to the top and bottom; press. The Center Unit should measure 24 ½" x 24 ½" (62.23cm x 62.23cm) (Dia. D).




6. Refer to Diagram E to Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of the Wild Flowers (13807-White) squares 13" x 13" (33.02cm x 33.02cm). Place a Wild Flowers square on top of a Gold Floral (13799-Yellow) square 13" x 13" (33.02cm x 33.02cm) with RST and sew ¼" (.635cm) away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line; press. **Note:** *Two squares yield two Half-Square Triangle Units*. Repeat to make a total of 4 HST Units 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75 cm) (square up if necessary).




7. Remove paper backing from one Indigo Floral (13804-Blue) 10" (25.4cm) circle and one Multi Bubbles (13803-Blue) 8 ¼" (22.225cm) circle. Position Indigo Floral circle ½" (1.27cm) from right edge, and 1" (2.54cm) from bottom edge of one HST Unit made in Step 6, as shown. Place adhesive side down on the right side of the HST. In the same manner, center the Multi Bubbles circle on the Indigo Floral circle. Following the manufacturer's directions, fuse the shapes in place. Use a coordinating thread and small buttonhole or zig-zag stitch to secure and finish the edges of the appliqué pieces (Dia. F). Block 1 should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75 cm).

Note: Label each block with the Block #, referring to the diagram to pin the number at the top of the block.




8. Follow Step 7 and refer to Diagram G using the remaining three HST Units 12 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" (31.75cm x 31.75 cm) made in Step 6 for the background and position the designated circles as shown to make Blocks 7, 4 and 10.


Block 7: One Indigo Floral (13804-Blue) 10" (25.4cm) circle and one Multi Bubbles (13803-Blue) 8 ³/₄" (22.225cm) circle, place ¹/₂" (1.27cm) from left edge, and 1 ³/₄" (4.445cm) from bottom edge.

Block 7 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm)




Block 4: One Orange Tonal (13801-Orange) 8" (20.32cm) circle and one Multi Bubbles (13803-Blue) 7" (17.78cm) circle, place 1 ¹/₄" (3.175cm) from left edge, and 1" (2.54cm) from bottom edge.

Block 4 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm)




Block 10 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm) Block 10: One Orange Tonal (13801-Orange) 8" (20.32cm) circle and one Multi Bubbles (13803-Blue) 7" (17.78cm) circle, place ³/₄" (1.905cm) from left edge, and 2 ³/₄" (6.985cm) from bottom edge.

9. Follow Step 7 and refer to Diagram H using the backgrounds and positioning the circles as shown to make Blocks 2, 8, 3, 9, 5, 11, 6 and 12.




Block 8 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm) Two Multi Bubbles (13803-Blue) squares 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (31.75cm x 31.75 cm); two Orange Tonal (13801-Orange) 8" (20.32cm) circles; two Hens (13802-White) 7" (17.78cm) circles.

Block 2: Place 1" (2.54cm) from right edge and 1" (2.54cm) from bottom edge

Block 8: Place ³/₄" (1.905cm) from right edge and 1 ¹/₄" (3.175cm) from bottom edge.

Block 9 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm)

Two Vases (13798-White) squares 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75 cm); two Indigo Floral (13804-Blue) 10" (25.4cm) circles; two Wild Flowers (13807-White) 8 ¾" (22.225cm) circles.

Block 3: Place $\frac{3}{4}$ " (1.905cm) from left edge and 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (3.175cm) from bottom edge.

Block 9: Place $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm) from right edge and $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm) from top edge.




Two Hens (13802-White) squares 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75 cm); two Indigo Floral (13804-Blue) 10" (25.4cm) circles; two Wild Flowers (13807-White) 8 ¾" (22.225cm) circles.

Block 5: Place $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm) from right edge and $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm) from bottom edge.

Block 11: Place 1" (2.54cm) from left edge and ³/₄" (1.905cm) from bottom edge.



Two Lt. Blue Flowers (13800-Blue) squares 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75 cm); two Orange Tonal (13801-Orange) 8" (20.32cm) circles; two Wild Flowers (13807-White) 7" (17.78cm) circles.

Block 6: Place 1" (2.54cm) from left edge and 1 ¹/₄" (3.175cm) from top edge.


Block 12: Place 1" (2.54cm) from right edge and 1 ¼" (3.175cm) from bottom edge.

10. Follow Diagrams I-L to make the borders.

11. Place the borders as shown. Pin and sew the Side Borders 12 ¹/₂" x 24 ¹/₂" (31.75cm x 62.23cm) made in Step 10 RST to the Center Unit (24 ¹/₂" x 24 ¹/₂" (62.23cm x 62.23cm) made in Step 4; press. Pin and sew the Top and Bottom Borders 12 ¹/₂" x 48 ¹/₂" (31.75cm x 123.19cm). made in Step 10 to the top and bottom; press. The Quilt Top should measure 48 ¹/₂" x 48 ¹/₂" (123.19cm x 123.19cm) (Dia. M).




- 12. To make the Multi Bubbles (13803-Blue) backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 21" x 56" (53.34cm x 142.24cm), one piece 15" x 42" (38.1cm x 106.68cm) and one piece 14 ¹/₂"x 15" (36.83cm x 38.1cm). Pin and sew the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges, then sew one 21" x 56" (53.34cm x 142.24cm) piece on each side, along the long edges to make a Backing 56" x 56" (142.24cm x 142.24cm) (Dia. N).
- 13. Press finished quilt top and backing. Tape the backing wrong side up to a firm surface. Layer batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins.


14. Refer to quilting Diagram (O) for a simple yet creative quilting design. Quilt "in-the-ditch" (next to the seam) between the blocks to anchor the layers together. Use the quilting template provided to quilt flowers in each block. Tip: Sewing with an even-feed foot is helpful when guilting through layers. This feeds the fabric more evenly and prevents wrinkles on the back of the guilt.



- 15. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the quilt top.
- 16. To make the binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the 2 1/2" x 42" (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one Indigo Floral (13804-Blue) continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end 1/4" (6mm) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded binding even with the edge of the quilt top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold binding over to back and hand stitch.





Finished Care Instructions


Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using Shout[®] Color Catcher[®]. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.


