

## BUSY BEES Quilt 1

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#### **Materials**

1 panel	Bees 36" Panel - Multi (A)	1414P-44
5∕8 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Lime (B)	1063-64
⅓ yard	Sunflowers - Yellow (C)	1415-44
¾ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Orange (D)	1063-34*
1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yards	Novelty Bee Stripe - Yellow (E)	1416-44
3 ½ yards	Bees in Circles - Yellow (Backing)	1411-44

<sup>\*</sup>Includes binding

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Bees 36" Panel - Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 29 ½" x 34 ½" panel.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Lime (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 33 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Sunflowers - Yellow (C), cut:

• (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (D), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ½" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Novelty Bee Stripe - Yellow (E), cut:

- (2) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 58" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 1/4" x 54" LOF strips.

#### From the Bees in Circles - Yellow (Backing), cut:

• (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 62" back.

#### **Sewing Instructions**

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 29 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 33 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim block to measure 32 ½" x 36 ½".




#### **Quilt Top Assembly** (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)


- 2. Sew together (9) 2 ½" Fabric D squares and (9) 2 ½" Fabric C squares, alternating them, to make (1) side border strip. Repeat to make a second side border strip. Sew (1) side border strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew together (9) 2 ½" Fabric C squares and (9) 2 ½" Fabric D squares, alternating them, to make (1) top border strip. Repeat to make (1) bottom border strip. Sew the resulting strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 4. Center (1) 6 1/4" x 58" Fabric E strip on one side of the quilt top. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 5. Repeat Step 4 to sew (1) 6 1/4" x 54" Fabric E strip to the top and (1) 6 1/4" x 54" Fabric E strip to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top.
- 6. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 2).
- 7. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 2) draw a 45-degree line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt



8. Layer and quilt as desired.

- 9. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to
- end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 10. Bind as desired.
