2/3 yard	Plaid - Blue (C)	F1441-14*
1/4 yard	Stars - White/Multi (D)	F1435-14
1/4 yard	Moon and Clouds - Blue (E)	F1437-11
1/4 yard	Sheep Jumping - Blue (F)	F1436-11
1/4 yard	Sheep Jumping - White/Multi (G)	F1436-14
1/4 yard	Stars - Blue (H)	F1435-11
3/8 yard	Sheep Jumping - Yellow (I)	F1436-44
1/4 yard	Tossed Animals on Check - Gray (J)	F1439-90
1/4 yard	Stars - Yellow (K)	F1435-44
1/4 yard	Moon and Clouds - Gray (L)	F1437-90
1 1/8 yards	Novelty Stripe - Multi (M)	F1440-14
3 yards	Patchwork - Multi (Backing)	F1434-14

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Sleepy Bear Panel - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23 1/2" x 23 1/2" panel

From the Fluffy Solid - Yellow (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 23 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Plaid - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Stars - White/Multi (D), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Moon and Clouds - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Sheep Jumping - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Sheep Jumping - White/Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Stars - Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3" squares.

From the Sheep Jumping - Yellow (I), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Animals on Check - Gray (J), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Stars - Yellow (K), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Moon and Clouds - Gray (L), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (M), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x 35 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 53" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53" x 53" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 23 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 23 1/2" x 23 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 25 1/2" x 25 1/2".

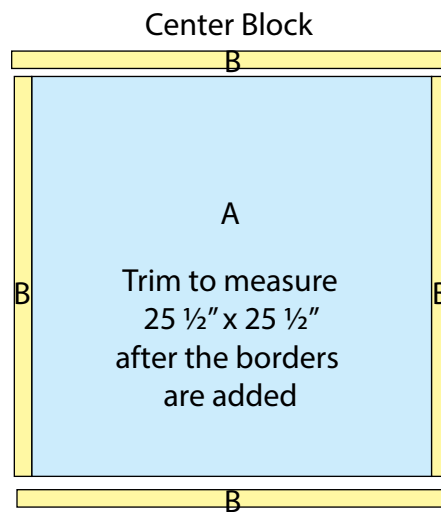

2. Sew together (2) 3" Fabric H squares, (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric J strip, (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric K strip and (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric L strip to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.

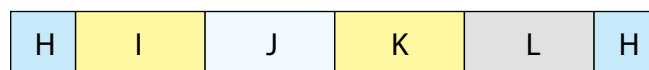

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3. Sew together (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric F strip and (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric G strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 strips total.

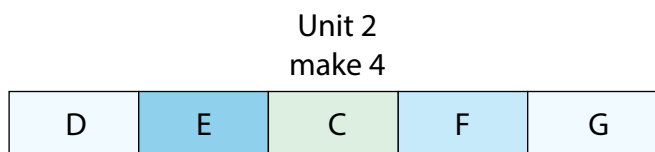

4. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Side Border strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Side Border strip.

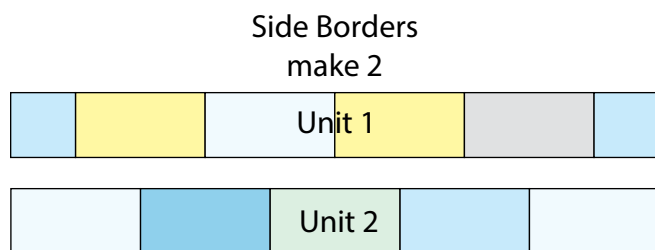

5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip. Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric C square to each end of the sewn strip to make (1) Top Border strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (1) Bottom Border strip.

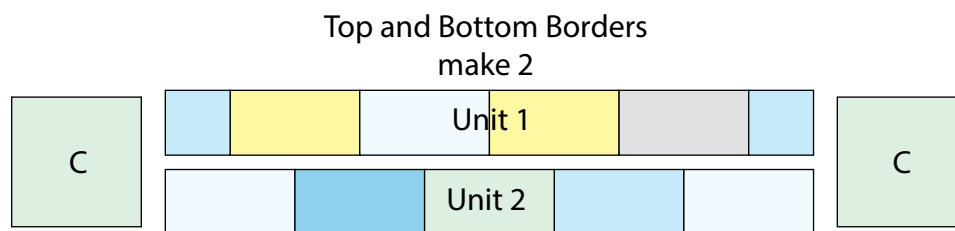

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

Note: The arrows shown in the Quilt Layout represent the direction of the fabric print.

6. Sew (1) Side Border strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Top Border strip to the top of the Center Block and (1) Bottom Border strip to the bottom of the Center Block.

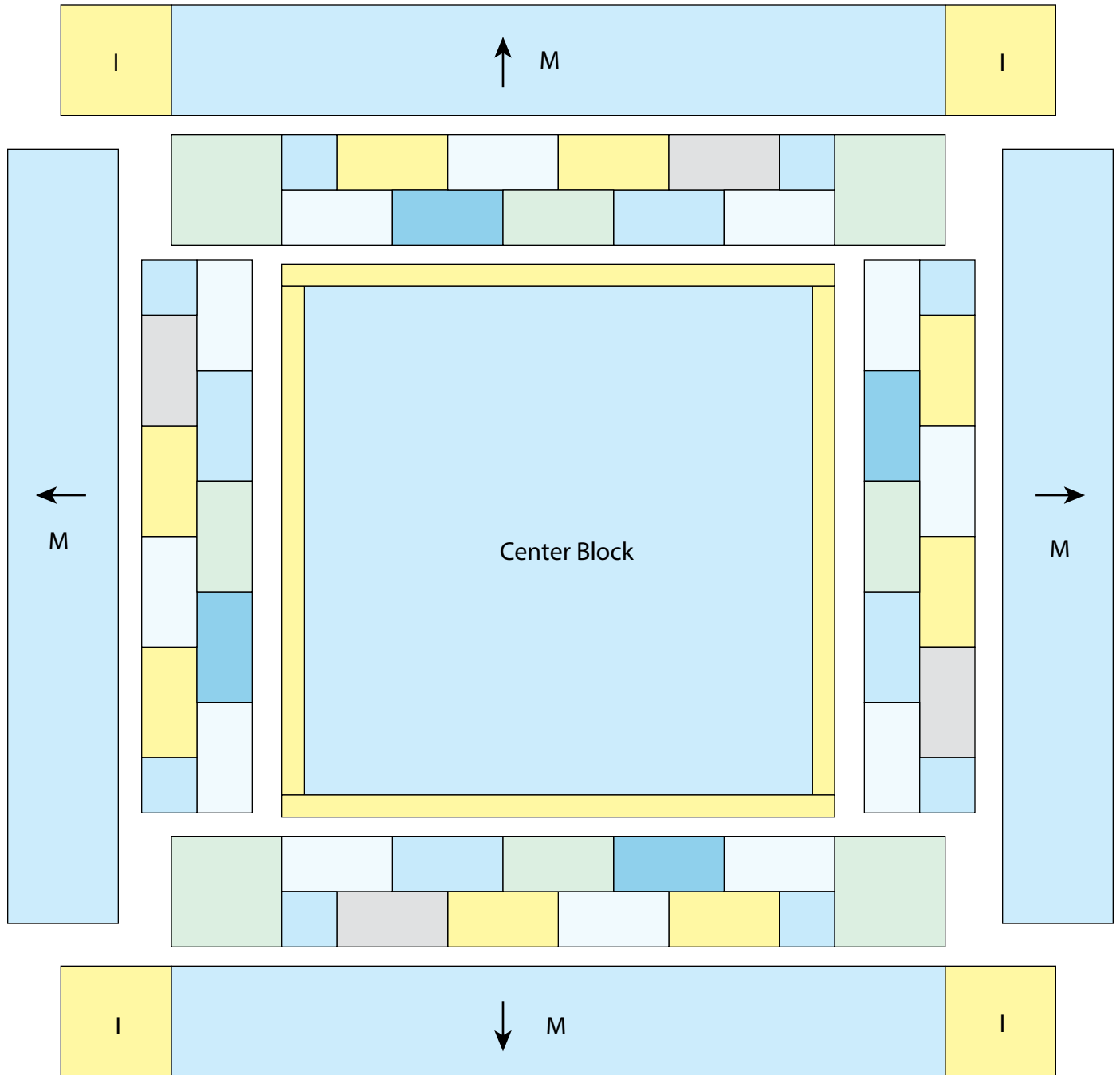
7. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 35 1/2" Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips. Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric I square to each end of (1) 5 1/2" x 35 1/2" Fabric M strip to make (1) Top Outer Border strip. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Outer Border strip. Sew the border strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.

8. Layer the quilt as desired.

9. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

10. Bind as desired
