## Fabric requirements



Fabric A: 71170702 #3 5/8 yard



Fabric B: 71170705 #2 1/4 yard



Fabric C: 71170701 #3 1/8 yard



Fabric D: 8361/A 01 White (Terry Cloth) 1/2 yard

Finished size: 15" x 26" (Makes Two)

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#### OTHER TOOLS & SUPPLIES

- -needle and coordinating thread
- -sewing machine
- -iron & pressing surface
- -rotary cutter and mat
- -fabric shears
- -straight pins

#### **NOTES**

- -For best results, read through all instructions before starting.
- -Please wash, dry & iron your fabrics before beginning, and trim selvedges.
- -Unless otherwise indicated, sew all seams with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- -Press your seams open as you go.
- -WOF = width of fabric

#### **CUTTING**

#### Fabric A

Cut (1) 17-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- -(2) 16" x 17-1/4" rectangles. These will be referred to as piece (a).
- -(2) 3-1/4" x 17-1/4" rectangles. Trim to 16" long. These will be referred to as piece (b).

#### Fabric B

Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:

-(4) 2-1/2" x 16" rectangles. these will be referred to as piece (c).

#### Fabric C

- -Cut (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:
- -(2) 3-1/2" x 16 rectangles. These will be referred to as piece (d).

#### Fabric D


Cut (1) 16" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

-(1) 16" x 27" rectangle. This will be the backing for the tea towel.




#### **PIECING**

1. Sew the following pieces together from top to bottom, as shown:




#### **ASSEMBLY**

2. Place the pieced unit created in Step 1 on top of the Fabric D backing piece, Right Sides Facing. Pin and sew around all four sides using a 1/2" seam allowance. Note: Be sure to leave a 5" opening on one side.




3. Clip the corners and turn Right Side Out through the 5" opening. Fold the seam allowance into the opening and pin. Top stitch around all four sides at 1/8", making sure to lock in your stitches at the beginning and end.





4. Stitch 'in the ditch' of each of the Fabric B & C strips, making sure to lock in your stitches at the beginning and end of each seam.



5. Repeat Steps 1-4 with the remaining fabric pieces to make a second tea towel.
