Materials

1 panel	Scenic Panel 24 inches - Navy (A)	9308P-77
3/4 yard	Starlet - Papaya (B)	6383-Papaya*
1/4 yard	Fish with Bubbles - Navy (C)	9316-77
3/8 yard	Starlet - Yellow (D)	6383-Yellow
5/8 yard	Coral - Ivory (E)	9314-41
1/4 yard	Tossed Fish and Co. - Navy (F)	9313-77
1/4 yard	Jelly Fish - Blue (G)	9310-75
2/3 yard	Mini Fish - Navy (H)	9312-77
1 3/4 yards	Underwater Scene - Blue (I)	9309-70
3 1/4 yards	Mini Fish - White (Backing)	9312-01

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic Panel 24 inches - Navy (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 21 1/4" x 41 1/2" panel.

From the Starlet - Papaya (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 24 1/4" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Fish with Bubbles - Navy (C), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Starlet - Yellow (D), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1" x 4 1/2" strips.
- (5) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Coral - Ivory (E), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Fish and Co. - Navy (F), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Jelly Fish - Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Mini Fish - Navy (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Underwater Scene - Blue (I), cut:

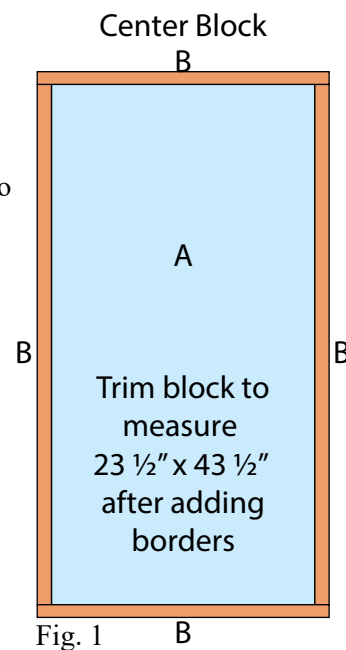
- (2) 5 1/2" x 58 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 48 1/2" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the Mini Fish - White (Backing), cut:

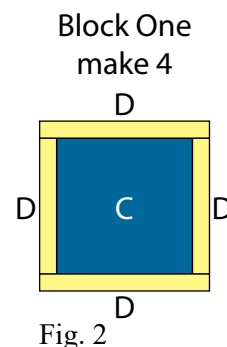
- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 76" back.

Sewing Instructions

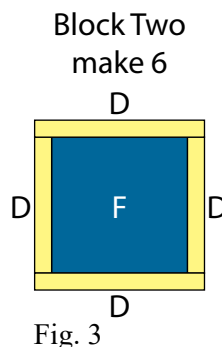
1. Sew (1) 2" x 41 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 1/4" x 41 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 24 1/4" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 23 1/2" x 43 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



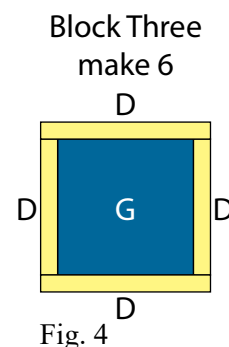
2. Sew (1) 1" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1" x 5 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



3. Sew (1) 1" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric F square. Sew (1) 1" x 5 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



4. Sew (1) 1" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square. Sew (1) 1" x 5 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Block Three squares total.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 25 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

6. Sew together (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Block Three square, (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Block Two square, (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Block Three square, (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Block Two square and (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square in that order to make (1) Side Strip. Repeat to make a second Side Strip. Sew (1) Side Strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.

7. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Block Two square, (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Block Three square, (1) 5 ½" Fabric E square and (1) Block One square in that order to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the borders to the Center Block, paying attention to the orientation of the strips.

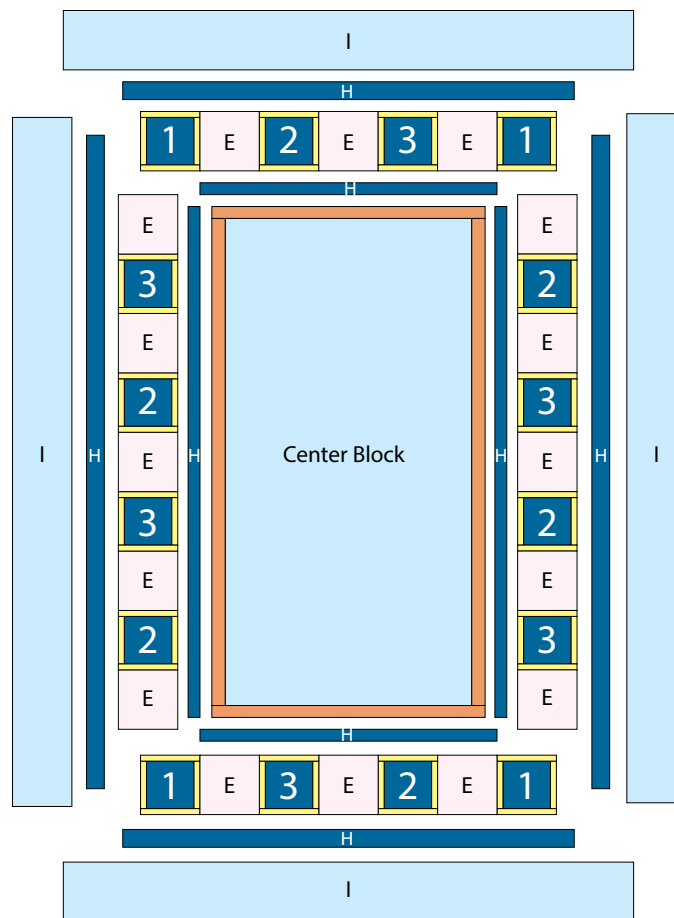
8. Sew (1) 2" x 55 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 38 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
