Queen Quilt: 86 1/4" x 92"

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Bricolage

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 18-1/4", 7-1/4", 7", 5-1/4", and 4-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the number of triangles indicated in [].
Cut all 9-3/8", 4-7/8", 3-7/8", 3-3/4", 2-7/8", and 2-3/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/2" x 90" and (2) 9-1/2" x 84" multi-stripe borders

Fussy cut from dark stripe, (4) 4-7/8" [8], (2) 4-1/2" squares, and (2) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/4" squares [8], (2) 4-7/8" squares [4], and (4) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (10) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 2-7/8" squares [8] and (8) 2-5/8" squares

Fabric C - Cut (9) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 86-3/4" and (2) 3-1/2" x 86-1/2" borders

Fabric D - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/4" squares [8], (4) 4-7/8" squares [8], and (2) 4-1/4" squares [8]

Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 3-7/8" squares [8], (4) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces, and (4) 2" squares

Cut (2) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/8" squares [48]

Fabric E - Cut (3) 18-1/4" strips, subcut (5) 18-1/4" squares [20] and (2) 9-3/8" squares [4]

Cut (1) 9-3/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-3/8" squares [8]

NOTE: Not all cut Fabric E 18-1/4" triangles are used.

Fabric F - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 2-7/8" squares [40]

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (32) 2-3/8" squares [64]

Fabric G - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 7-1/4" square [4], (4) 4-7/8" squares [8], and (3) 4-1/4" squares [12]

Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/2" square, (1) 3-1/2" square, (2) 2-7/8" squares [4], (4) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces, and (8) 2" squares

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (14) 2-7/8" squares [28]

Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (20) 2-3/8" squares [40] and (8) 2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 7-1/4" square [4], (1) 4-1/4" square [4], and (4) 3-3/4" squares [8], and (4) 2-3/8" squares [8]

Cut (2) 7" strips, subcut (11) 7" squares [44] and (3) 2" squares

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-7/8" squares [16] and (9) 2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/4" squares [8], (2) 4-7/8" squares [4], and (5) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares [16]

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" squares [24]

Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (4) 2-5/8" squares and (8) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric J - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 7-1/4" square [4], (2) 4-7/8" squares [4], (3) 4-1/4" squares [12], and (4) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares [48] and (4) 2-3/8" squares [8]

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (16) 2" squares

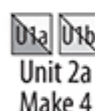

2. Piecing Order:

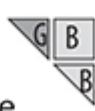
1. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics F and G** 2-7/8" triangles along their long edges. Make a total of 24 Unit 1a (2-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 1b-1d indicated with the fabrics shown.



2. Sew 1 each Units 1a (U1a) and 1b (U1b) together as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 2a (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 2b-2e indicated with the units shown.



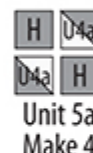
3. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics B and G** 2-7/8" triangles to adjoining sides of a 2-1/2" **Fabric B** square as shown. Add a **Fabric D** 4-7/8" triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 3a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 3b and 3c with the fabrics shown.



4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics F and H** 2-3/8" triangles along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 4a (2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 each Units 4b and 4c with fabrics shown.



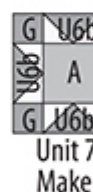
5. Arrange 2 each **Fabric H** 2" squares and Unit 4a (U4a) in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 5a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 5b and 5c with the fabrics and units shown.



6. Stitch 2 **Fabric F** 2-3/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric F** 4-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 6a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 6b-6f with the fabrics shown.



7. Arrange a **Fabric A** 3-1/2" square and 4 **Fabric H** 2" squares, and 4 Unit 6a (U6a) in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 7a (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each Units 7b and 7c with the fabrics and units shown.



8. Stitch 2 **Fabric I** 3-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric H** 7-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 8a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 8b and 8c with the fabrics shown.



9. Sew 4 **Fabric D** 2-3/8" triangles to sides of a **Fabric B** 2-5/8" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 9a (3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 9b and 9c with the fabrics shown.



10. Stitch 2 **Fabric H** 2-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric B** 5-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 8 Unit 10a (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 each Units 10b and 10c with the fabrics shown.

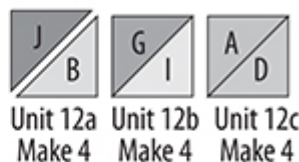


11. Stitch 2 Unit 10a together as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 11a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 11b and 11c with units shown.



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12. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics B** and **J** 4-7/8" triangles along their long edges.



Make a total of 4 Unit 12a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 12b and 12c with the fabrics shown.

13. Refer to Block Diagrams (Page 4) to make blocks in Steps 14-17.

14. Arrange 4 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" squares, 4 Unit 3a (3a), 4 Unit 2a (2a), and 4 Unit 2b (2b) in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 1a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 1b** and 1c with units and fabrics indicated.

15. Arrange 4 Unit 5a (5a), 4 Unit 8a (8a), and 1 Unit 7a (7a) in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 2b** and 2c with units indicated.

16. Arrange 8 Unit 6d (6d), 4 Unit 9a (9a), 5 **Fabric B** 3-1/2" squares, 4 **Fabric G** 2" squares, and 4 **Fabric G** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 3a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 3b** and 3c with units and fabrics indicated.

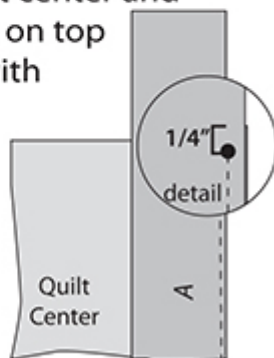
17. Arrange 4 Unit 11a (11a), 4 Unit 12a (12a), and 1 **Fabric A** 4-1/2" square in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 4a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 4b** and 4c with units indicated.

18. Referring to the Pieced Sashing Layout, arrange 12 **Fabric B** 4-1/2" squares, 4 **Fabric H** 3-3/4" triangles, and 22 **Fabric H** 7" triangles in 14 diagonal rows. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together. Trim to 68-1/2" long if necessary. Make a total of 2 pieced sashing strips (6-1/8" x 68-1/2" unfinished).

19. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of blocks, triangles, pieced sashing strips, and borders.

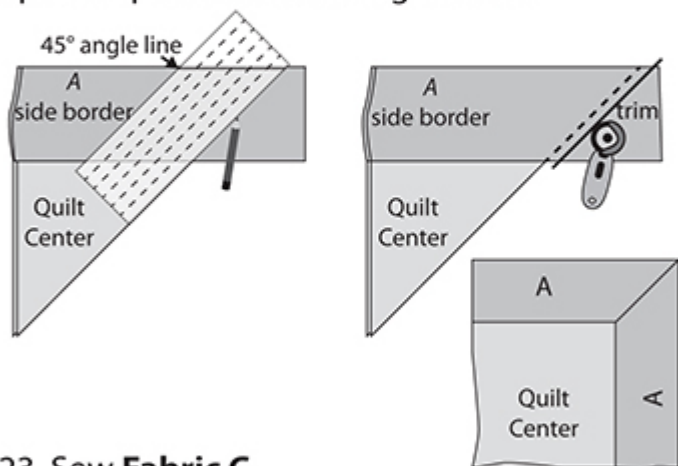
20. Arrange **Blocks 1a, 2a, 3a, and 4a**, 6 **Fabric E** 18-1/4" triangles, and 4 **Fabric E** 9-3/8" triangles in 6 diagonal rows. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together to make Row 1 (17-1/2" x 68-1/2" unfinished). Repeat to make Rows 2 and 3 with blocks shown.

21. Center **Fabric A** 9-1/2" x 90" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 9-1/2" x 84" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the light stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

22. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



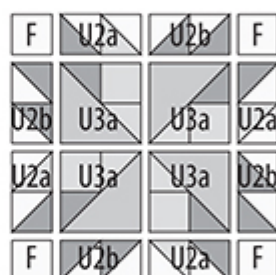
23. Sew **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 86-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 86-3/4" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

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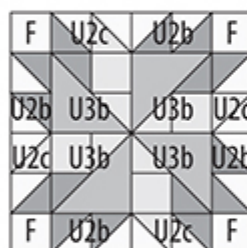
24. The quilt measures approximately 86-3/4" x 92-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

25. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

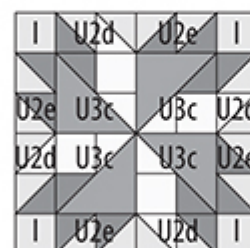

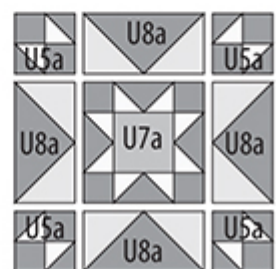

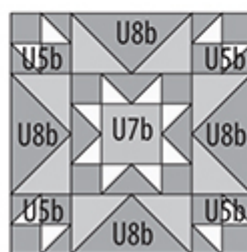
Block 1b - Make 1



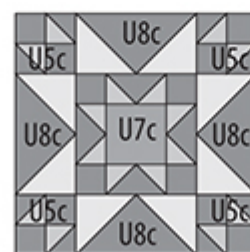

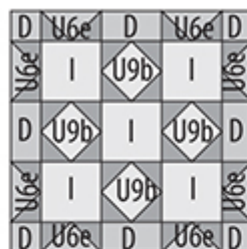

PIECED SASHING LAYOUT

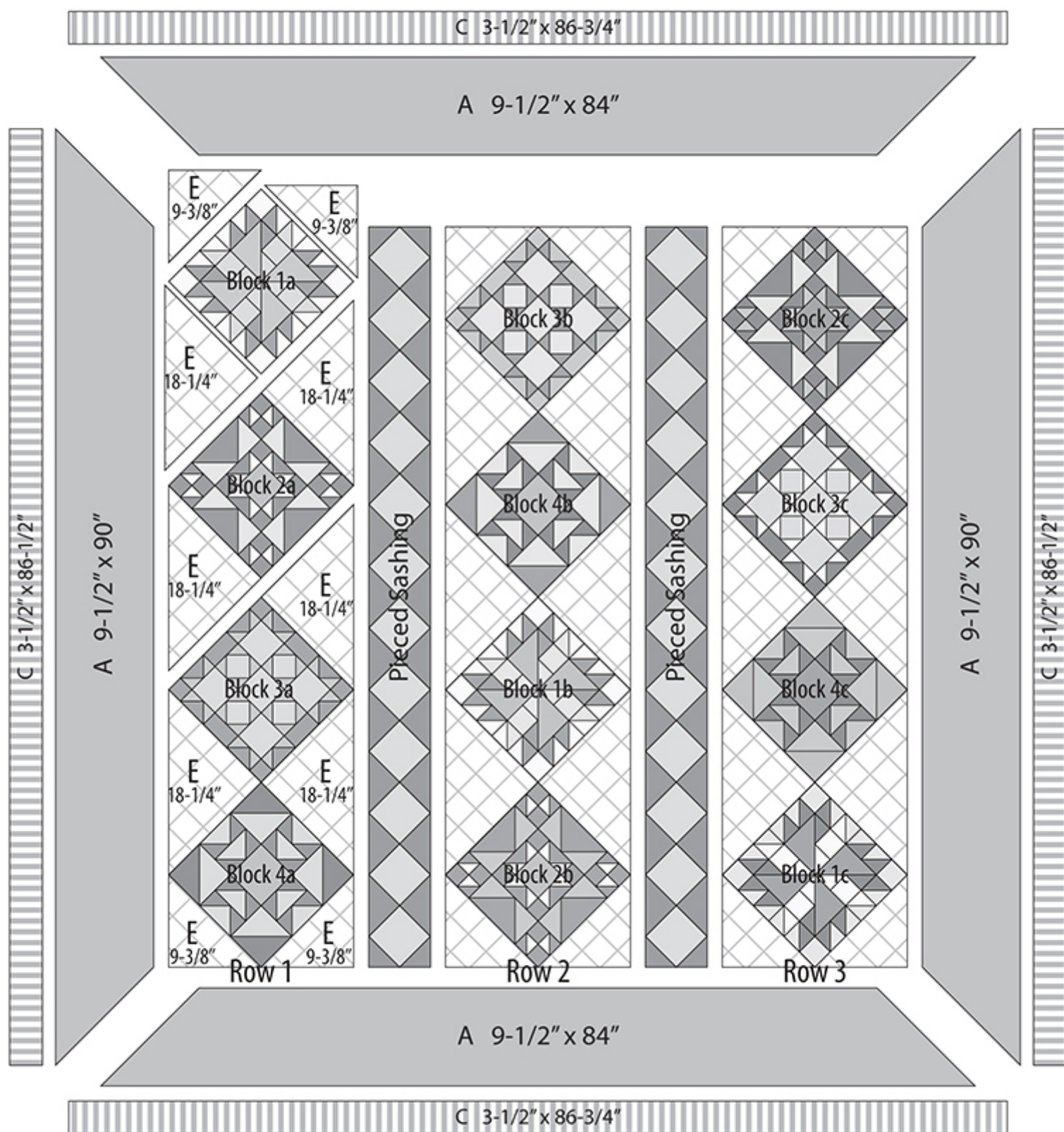

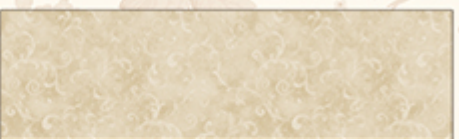
