Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

five 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

one 10-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: ten 3" squares for the HSTs six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: ten 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles ten 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles eight 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 3" squares for the HSTs four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles eight 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

two 3-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 3-3/8" squares for the Square-in-a-Square units

From Fabric F, cut:

two 3-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 3-3/8" squares for the Square-in-a-Square units

From Fabric G, cut:

fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighteen 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles eighteen 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric H, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 3" squares for the HSTs

six 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-two 2-7/8" squares for the Square-in-a-Square units. Cut each square in half along one diagonal.

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangles two 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangles four 2-1/2" x 19-1/2" rectangles two 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles

- two 14-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-six 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles Trim the remainder of the second strip to 12-1/2" wide, then cut: twenty 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles
- one 12-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: sixteen 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles, for a total of thirty-six

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric C square with a 3" Fabric H square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty C/H HSTs.





Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make sixteen D/H HSTs.

Assemble the Square-in-a-Square Units (SIAS)

Step 3: Sew a 2-7/8" Fabric H triangle to opposite sides of a 3-3/8" Fabric E square. Press seam allowances toward the triangles. Repeat on remaining sides of the Fabric E square. Trim the SIAS block to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty E/H SIAS units.





Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make sixteen F/H SIAS units.

Assemble the Block Borders

Step 5: Sew a 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric H strip to either side of a 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric G strip. Press. Repeat for all 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric G strips, for a total of eighteen.



Step 6: Repeat Step 5 with the 14-1/2" long G and H pieces to make eighteen 14-1/2" long block borders.





Assemble the A Blocks

Step 7: Gather: four Fabric E SIAS units two 12-1/2" block borders (from Step 5) two 14-1/2" block borders (from Step 6) four C/H HSTs two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric C strips two 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric C strips one Fabric A rectangle

Arrange as shown, following the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the 10-1/2" Fabric C strips to the left and right edges of the Fabric A rectangle. Press. Sew a C/H HST to the edges of the 8-1/2" Fabric C strips, placing the Fabric C edges together and noting the orientation of the HST. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric A rectangle. Press.

Step 9: Sew the 14-1/2" block border strips to the left and right edges of the block. Press. Sew a E/H SIAS unit to the edges of the 12-1/2" block borders. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press.



Assemble the B Blocks

Step 10: Repeat the process shown in Steps 7-9 to make four 20-1/2" x 22-1/2" B Blocks, using the Block Assembly Diagram here for fabric placement.

Assemble the Quilt

Step 11: Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to one end of a 2-1/2" x 21-1/2" Fabric H strip. Press. Repeat for all four 21-1/2" Fabric H strips.




Step 12: Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to each end of a 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" Fabric H strip. Press. Repeat to make a second sashing like this.



Step 13: Sew together, in this order: one 2-1/2" x 19-1/2" Fabric H strip one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric C rectangle one 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric H strip one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric C rectangle one 2-1/2" x 19-1/2" Fabric H strip

Press. Repeat to make a second sashing strip like this.



Step 14: Arrange the A and B Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block (from Steps 11 in the top and bottom rows and from Step 12 in the middle row). Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

Step 15: Sew the Step 13 sashings and the block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
