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FINISHED QUILT SIZE 67" x 81"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

$1\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.4 m) Brown Toss (C7751 Brown)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) Brown Tracks (C7752 Brown)

1 yard (95 cm) Brown Main (C7750 Brown)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) Brown Grain (C7755 Brown)

1 yard (95 cm) Light Brown Grain (C7755 Lt. Brown)

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (50 cm) Brown Weave (C7756 Brown)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) Cream Pinecones (C7754 Cream)

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (85 cm) Brown Antlers (C7753 Brown)

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard (25 cm) Cream Antlers (C7753 Cream)

Binding $\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm)

Backing 5 yards (4.6 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Brown Toss

Cut 8 strips 6" x WOF for Border 4.

Brown Tracks

Cut 1 strip $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 rectangle $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Brown Main

Cut 2 Strips $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF.

Brown Grain

Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 rectangle $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Light Brown Grain

Cut 6 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

Brown Weave

Cut 5 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Cream Pinecones

Cut 1 strip $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 rectangle $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Brown Antlers

Cut 2 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 rectangles $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Cream Antlers

Cut 1 strip $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strip into 1 rectangle $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

Referring to the quilt photo for placement of the assorted prints, sew the $40\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles together to complete the quilt center.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $54\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $44\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $58\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 3

Side borders should be $62\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $56\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 4

Side borders should be $70\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $67\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose Fabric from the Pinewood Acres Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
