Picnic Quilt: 71" Square



Wilmington Prints: A World of Possibilities

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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 6" x 75" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (5) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (5) 2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 13" and (8) 1-1/4" x 11-3/4" strips

Fabric I - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares

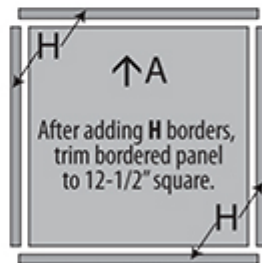
Fabric J - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (5) 2" strips

Fabric K - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric H** 1-1/4" x 11-3/4" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square

Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" **Fabric H** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).* Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



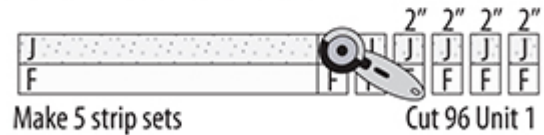
Block 1 - Make 4

2. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 6-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips, and 4 **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 5

3. Sew 1 each **Fabrics F** and **J** 2" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 5 strip sets. From these cut a total of (96) 2" wide Unit 1 (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished).



4. Sew 2 Unit 1 together along long edges, alternating fabrics. Make a total of 48 Unit 2 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



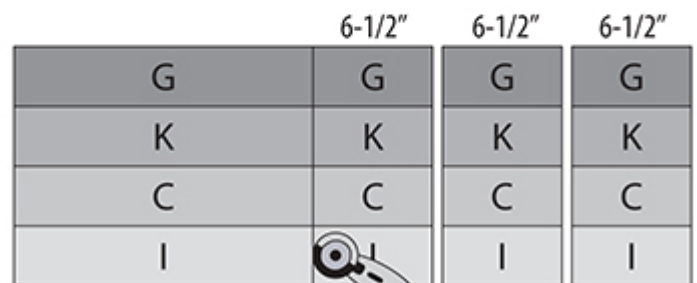

5. Arrange 6 Unit 2 (U2), 2 **Fabric K** 3-1/2" squares, 4 **Fabric G** 3-1/2" squares, and 4 **Fabric H** 3-1/2" squares in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 3 - Make 4

6. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C, G, I,** and **K** 3-1/2" strips together lengthwise as shown. Make a total of 2 strip sets. From these cut a total of (12) 6-1/2" wide Unit 3 (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



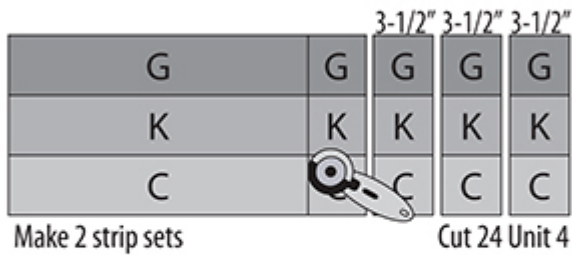
Make 2 strip sets

Cut 12 Unit 3

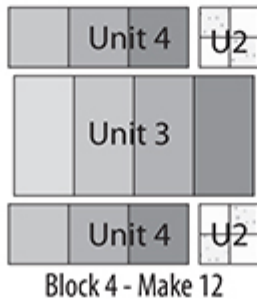
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

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7. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C, G,** and **K** 3-1/2" strips together lengthwise as shown. Make a total of 2 strip sets. From these cut a total of (24) 3-1/2" wide Unit 4 (3-1/2" x 9-1/2" unfinished).



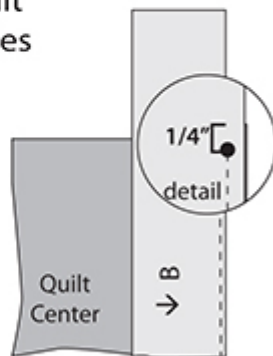
8. Arrange 2 Unit 2 (U2), 2 Unit 4, and 1 Unit 3 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch Units 2 and 4 into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12 **Block 4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



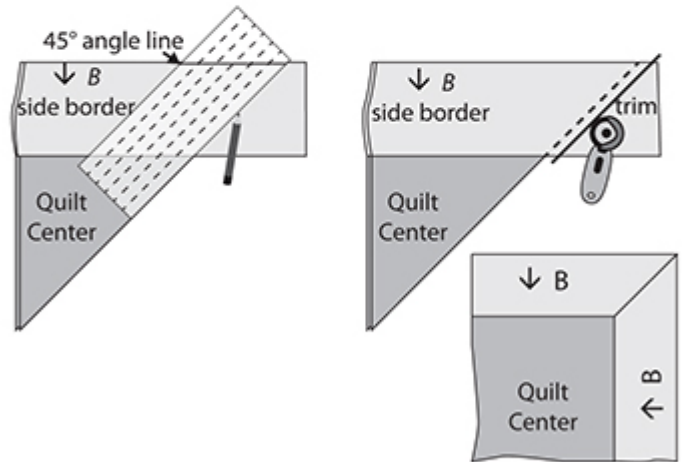
9. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and border.

10. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (60-1/2" square unfinished).

11. Center **Fabric B** 6" x 75" borders on all sides of quilt center with light berry edge next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



12. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



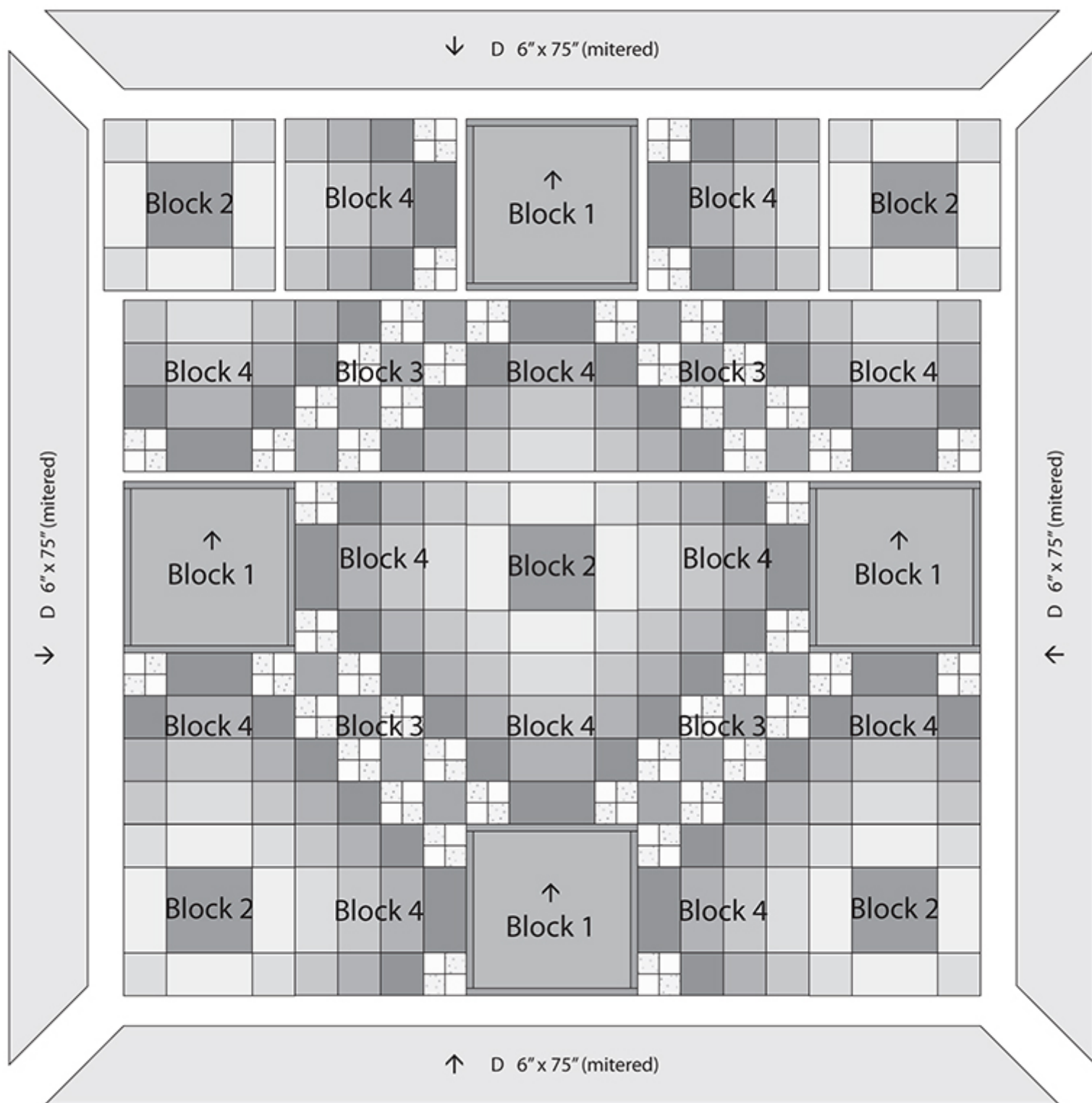
13. The quilt measures approximately 71-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

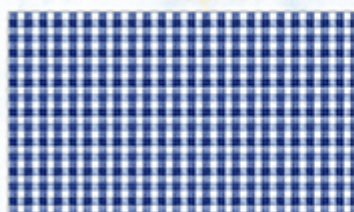

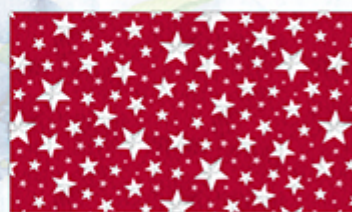
