Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42". From bottom of panel cut a 23-1/2" square. Cut remaining panel into 4 squares approximately 9" square.

Fabric B - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 8 triangles. Cut remaining strip into (2) 3" strips, subcut (8) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces. Cut (2) 5-7/8" strips, subcut (14) 5-7/8" squares

then cut in half diagonally for 28 triangles Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (48) 3" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 24 triangles

Cut (8) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (52) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 24 triangles

Cut (8) 3" strips, subcut (104) 3" squares Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips

Fabric F - Cut (5) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 5-1/2" squares

Cut (8) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 86" and (2) 4-1/2" x 78" borders

Fabric G - Cut (4) 3" strips

Fabric H - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice

for 8 triangles


Cut (2) 5-7/8" strips, subcut (14) 5-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 28 triangles

Fabric I - Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut
(2) 2" x 28" and (2) 2" x 24" strips
Cut (8) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to
end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 78" and
(2) 1-3/4" x 75-1/2" borders
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips. Subcut 1 strip into
(2) 1-1/2" x 11" and (2) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips.
Subcut with remaining strips in the same
manner for a total of 8 each strip.

Fabric J - Cut (4) 3" strips Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips

2. Piecing Order:


1. Stitch Fabric I 2" x 24" strips to sides of the Fabric A 23-1/2" square panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 28" Fabric I strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim Block 1 to 25-1/2" square (unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 1

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Stitch **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** 9" square panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 11" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim to 10-1/2" square (unfinished)*. Make a total of 4 Unit 1.



3. Sew **Fabrics B** and **H** 5-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 28 Unit 2 (5-1/2" square unfinished).



4. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all 3" **Fabric D** squares.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

5. Arrange 2 **Fabric D** marked 3" squares right sides together on a **Fabric C** 5-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 16 each Units 3a and 3b (5-1/2" square unfinished).

6. In a similar manner, add 2 **Fabric D** marked 3" squares right sides together on adjacent corners of a **Fabric C** 5-1/2" square as shown, working with 1 corner at a time. Make a total

of 5 each Units 4a-4d (5-1/2" square

unfinished).

7. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics C** and **D** 6-1/4" triangles as shown. Sew triangles together. Make a total of 6 Unit 5a (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 6 Unit

5b and 4 Unit 5c with fabrics indicated (5-1/2" square unfinished).


8. Stitch **Fabrics G** and **J** 3" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 4 strip sets (5-1/2" x width of fabric unfinished). From these cut (8) 5-1/2" square Unit 6 and (32) 3" x 5-1/2" Unit 7.

9. Sew 2 Unit 7 together lengthwise, alternating fabrics. Make a total of 16 Unit 8 (5-1/2" square unfinished).



10. Stitch **Fabrics E** and **J** 1-3/4" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 6 strip sets (3" x width of fabric unfinished). From these cut (8) 3" square Unit 9 and (112) 1-3/4" x 3" Unit 10.



11. Sew 2 Unit 10 together lengthwise, alternating fabrics. Make a total of 48 Unit 11 (5-1/2" square unfinished).




12. Arrange 2 **Fabric B** 3" squares and 2 Unit 11 (U11) in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 12 (5-1/2" square unfinished).


13. Sew 2 Unit 10 (U10) to ends of a Unit 9 (U9) alternating fabrics. Add a **Fabric B**3" x 5-1/2" piece as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 13 (5-1/2" square unfinished).

14. Arrange units and 2 **Fabric F** 5-1/2" squares in 5 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together into **Block 2a** (25-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2a - Make 1

- 15. In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 2b-2d** referring to **Block Layouts** (Page 5).
- 16. Arrange units and **Fabric F** 5-1/2" squares as shown. Sew units 3a and 4b together and stitch to left side of Unit 1. Sew Units 3a, 4d, and 5b and 1 **Fabric F** 5-1/2" square into rows then sew rows together and add to right side of Unit 1. Sew remaining units into rows. Sew all rows together into **Block 3a** (25-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 3a - Make 1

17. In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 3b-3d** referring to **Block Layouts** (**Page 5**).


- 18. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 19. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (75-1/2" square unfinished).
- 20. Sew **Fabric I** 1-3/4" x 75-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I** 1-3/4" x 78" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 21. Sew **Fabric F** 4-1/2" x 78" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 4-1/2" x 86" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 22. The quilt measures approximately 86" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric H**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 23. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size.


