# 7<sup>TH</sup> INNING STRETCH

Full Quilt: 81 1/2" x 93"



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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 2 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square and 3 panels to approximately 8-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/4" x 88-1/2" multi-stripe borders with word stripe on bottom and (2) 3" x 82" word stripe borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (3) 12-3/4" strips subcut (8) 12-3/4" squares

**Fabric D** - Cut (3) 9" strips, subcut (10) 9" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 84-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders  
Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/4" x 13", (4) 1-1/4" x 11-3/4", (6) 1-1/4" x 10", (6) 1-1/4" x 8-3/4" strips

**Fabric F** - Cut (4) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 6-7/8" squares and (12) 3" squares  
Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (4) 2" x 9-1/2" strips

**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 7-3/8" strips, subcut (6) 7-3/8" squares

**Fabric H** - Cut (2) 16" strips, subcut (24) 3" x 16" strips


**Fabric I** - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (72) 3-1/2" squares  
Cut (6) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (12) 3-3/8" x 18" strips  
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (36) 2" squares

**Fabric J** - Cut (3) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (16) 6-7/8" squares  
Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (12) 3" squares  
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (8) 2" x 9-1/2" strips

**Fabric K** - Cut (2) 7-3/8" strips, subcut (6) 7-3/8" squares  
Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)


## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 11-3/4" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).** Make a total of 2 **Block 1**.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.


2. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 8-3/4" strips to sides of an 8-1/2" square **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 10" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 9-1/2" square (unfinished).** Make a total of 3 **Unit 1**.



3. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of 24 **Fabric I** 2" squares, 72 **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares, 12 **Fabric F** 3" squares, and 12 **Fabric J** 3" squares.




4. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric I** 2" squares right sides together on ends of a **Fabric J** 2" x 9-1/2" strip as shown. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 8 **Unit 2a** (2" x 9-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 **Unit 2a** with **Fabric F** 2" x 9-1/2" strips.




Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

5. Arrange 1 **Unit 1**, 4 **Fabric I** 2" squares and 4 **Unit 2a** as shown. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2a** (12-1/2" square unfinished).




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6. In the same manner, make 2 **Block 2b** with fabrics and units indicated.




Block 2b - Make 2

7. Sew 2 **Fabric H** 3" x 16" strips lengthwise centered on long edges of a **Fabric I** 3-3/8" x 18" strip. Make a total of 12 Unit 3a (8-3/8" x 18" unfinished).




Unit 3a - Make 12

8. Arrange a 12-1/2" square ruler centered diagonally on a Unit 3a. Trim ends. Make a total of 12 Unit 3b.

9. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric J** 3" squares, right sides together, on opposite corners of a **Fabric G** 7-3/8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Cut the **Fabric G**



square in half diagonally as shown creating 2 Unit 4a (7-3/8" x 7-3/8" x 10-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 Unit 4b with fabrics indicated.




Unit 4a - Make 12      Unit 4b - Make 12

10. In the same manner, make the number of Units 5a-5b listed with 6-7/8" and 3-1/2" squares of fabrics indicated.




Unit 5a - Make 32




Unit 5b - Make 40

11. Center and sew 1 each Units 4a and 4b to long edges of a Unit 3b as shown. Make a total of 12 **Block 3** (12-1/2" square unfinished).




Block 3 - Make 12

12. Mark the center point of all edges of a **Fabric C** 12-3/4" square. Trim corners from center point to center point. Repeat on remaining **Fabric C** 12-3/4" squares to make (8) 9" squares.




Trim 8 Fabric C Squares

13. Stitch 4 Unit 5a to all sides of a **Fabric C** 9" square as shown. Make a total of 8 **Block 4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

14. Stitch 4 Unit 5b to all sides of a **Fabric D** 9" square as shown. Make a total of 10 **Block 5** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

15. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

16. Arrange blocks in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (60-1/2" x 84-1/2" unfinished).

17. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 84-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

18. Sew **Fabric B** 9-1/4" x 88-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric B** 3" x 82" borders to top and bottom of quilt.


19. The quilt measures approximately 82" x 93-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!


