Block Assembly

- **1.** Place (1) **B** 3" square on the top left corner of (1) **A** 5-1/2" square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
- **2.** Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a **B** 3" square to each of the remaining corners of the **A** 5-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 1** square (Fig. 4).
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (10) Unit 1 squares total.










4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 5-9 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (10) **Unit 2** squares, (40) **Unit 3** squares, (40) **Unit 4** squares, (40) **Unit 5** squares and (40) **Unit 6** squares. **NOTE: The arrow in Figures 6 and 7 denotes fabric print direction.**

- **5.** Sew (1) **Unit 5** square to each side of (1) **Unit 4** square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 4** square to each side of (1) **Unit 1** square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) **Block One** square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (10) **Block One** squares total. Pay attention to the orientation of the units.
- **6.** Sew (1) **Unit 6** square to each side of (1) **Unit 3** square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 3** square to each side of (1) **Unit 2** square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) **Block Two** square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (10) **Block Two** squares total. Pay attention to the orientation of the units.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)

- 7. Sew (2) **Block One** squares and (2) **Block Two** squares together, alternating them, to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three** and **Row Five**.
- **8.** Sew (2) **Block Two** squares and (2) **Block One** squares together, alternating them, to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.
- **9.** Sew the (5) rows together in numerical order to make the **Center Block**.
- **10.** Sew (1) **M** 2-1/2" x 75-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **M** 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

Finishing

- 11. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **12.** Sew the (8) **N** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- **13.** Bind as desired.
