

Cutting Notes: It is very important to mark and store your cutting pieces according to the block they have been assigned to, as this will make it much easier when you start piecing. Also, mark any pieced triangles and squares to avoid confusion as you assemble the quilt. Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin.





Subcut (2) 8" squares, cut once on diagonal for Corner Setting Triangles. (2) 6-1/4" x 42" strips. Subcut (12) 6-1/4" squares, cut twice on diagonal.

Star Block Assembly

1. Sew the short sides of a 3-3/8" I triangle to both sides of a 6-1/4" L triangle to make a Flying Geese unit. Square up to $3" \times 5-1/2"$. Make (4).





2. Sew a 3" **E** square to both short ends of the Flying Geese unit to make Row 1 of the block. Square up to 10-1/2" x 3". Make (2).

ROW 1

3. Sew a Flying Geese unit to both sides of a 5-1/2" **C** square. This will be Row 2 of the block. Square up to 10-1/2" x 5-1/2".

ROW 2






4. Sew a Row 1 in Step 2 to the top of Row 2. Rotate and sew the remaining Row 1 to the bottom of the block to complete. Square up to 10-1/2". Make (12).



STAR BLOCK

Log Cabin Block Assembly

5. Sew the long side of a $1-1/2" \times 2-1/2"$ **H** strip to the left side of a 2-1/2" **K** square. Sew a $1-1/2" \times 2-1/2"$ **G** strip to the right side as shown.



6. Sew a 1-1/2" **N** square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 2 -1/2" **H** strip. Sew to the top of the unit in Step 5.



7. Sew a 1-1/2" **N** square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" **G** strip. Sew to the bottom of the unit in Step 5. This completes Round 1 of the block.







ROUND 1



8. Sew a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" A strip to the left side of Round 1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" D strip to the right side of the block.



9. Sew a 1-1/2" N square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" A strip. Sew to the top of the block.



10. Sew a 1-1/2" N square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" D strip. Sew to the bottom of the block to complete Round 2. Square up to 6-1/2".






ROUND 2

11. Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" B strip to the left side of Round 2. Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" J strip to the right side of the block.



12. Sew a 1-1/2" N square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" B strip. Sew to the top of Round 2.



13. Sew a 1-1/2" N square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" J strip. Sew to the bottom of the block to complete Round 3. Square up to 8-1/2". **ROUND 3**

Sunshine & Shadow

14. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" **O** strip to the left side of Round 3. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" **M** strip to the right side of the block.



15. Sew a 1-1/2" **N** square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" **O** strip as shown. Sew to the top of Round 3.



16. Sew a 1-1/2" **N** square to both short ends of a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" **M** strip as shown. Sew to the bottom of Round 3 to complete the block. Square up to 10-1/2". Make (20).





LOG CABIN BLOCK

17. The quilt center is set on point, so it will be sewn together in diagonal rows using side setting and corner setting triangles from **Fabric L**. Following diagram on Pg. 6 for placement and rotation of each block, sew each row in the order stated from left to right. **[Note: that the Log Cabin blocks are all turned the same direction.]**

18. *Row 1:* Sew the short side of a **L** Side Setting Triangle to both sides of a Log Cabin. Sew a **L** Corner Setting triangle to the top of the Log Cabin.


19. *Row 2:* Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star block, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.

20. Row 3: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.

21. *Row 4:* Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Corner Square Triangle.

22. *Row 5:* Corner Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.

23. Row 6: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.





24. Row 7: Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Star, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle.

25. *Row 8:* Side Setting Triangle, Log Cabin, Side Setting Triangle. Sew a Corner Setting Triangle to the bottom of the Log Cabin Block.


Inner Border

26. Sew the 1" x 71-1/2" I strips to the left and right sides of the quilt. Sew the 1" x 58-1/4" I strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Outer Border

27. Sew the $4-1/2'' \ge 72-1/2'' = F$ strips to the left and right sides of the quilt. Sew the $4-1/2'' \ge 66-1/4'' = F$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

28. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; quilt as desired. Using the 2-1/2" **F** strips, bind the edges to finish.
