## 1077 Butterfly Haven by Danhui Nai



Queen Quilt: 94" Square



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/4" x 64" and (2) 9-1/4" x 46" multi-stripe borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (6) 10-1/2" strips, subcut (22) 10-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (3) 3-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-3/4" x 50-1/2" borders and (1) 3" x 12" strip

Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end with the (1) 3" x 12" strip and cut into (2) 3" x 64" borders
Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric E** - Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces and (40) 3" squares

Fabric F - Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (48) 3" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 6-1/4" square [then cut in half diagonally 
twice for 4 triangles], (6) 3" squares, and (4) 3-3/8" squares

Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-3/8" squares then cut all 3-3/8" squares in half diagonally for 32 triangles
Cut (7) 3" strips, subcut (98) 3" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 24 triangles Cut (9) 3" strips, subcut (120) 3" squares

Fabrics I and J - From each fabric:
Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (6) 3-3/8"
squares then cut in half diagonally
for 12 triangles

Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabric K - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 6-1/4" square (then cut in half diagonally 
twice for 4 triangles) and (8) 3-3/8" squares (then in half diagonally for 16 triangles) 
Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (16) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabric L - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 6-1/4" square (then cut in half diagonally twice for 4 triangles), (3) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces, and (4) 3-3/8" squares (cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles)
Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (14) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (7) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabric M - Cut (7) 3" strips, subcut (88) 3" squares

Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 94-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 90-1/2" borders

Cut (6) 2-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/4" x 60-1/2" and (2) 2-1/4" x 45-1/2" borders

Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 27" strips


### 2. Piecing Order:

 Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 80 Fabric G 3" squares and 96 Fabric H 3" squares, and 88 Fabric M 3" squares.

2. Arrange 4 marked

Fabric M 3" squares right sides together on corners of a Fabric C 10-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4".

Press triangles out. Make a total of 22 Block 1 (10-1/2" square unfinished).

3. Sew 1 each Fabrics G and K 3-3/8" triangles together along




their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 1b-1d with fabrics indicated.

4. Arrange a marked









Fabric L 3" x 5-1/2" piece. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on other end as shown. Make Make 12 a total of 12 Unit 2a (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 2b-2h with fabrics indicated and seams

angled as shown.

5. Stitch 2 Fabric G 3-3/8" triangles to short edges of







a Fabric L 6-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 3a (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 3b to 3c with fabrics indicated.

6. Arrange 2 Fabric E 3" squares with 1 each Units 1a (U1a) and 1b (U1b) in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.




7. Stitch a Fabric E 3" x 5-1/2" piece to a Unit 3b as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 6 (5-1/2" square unfinished).




8. Arrange 3" squares and units in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Make a total of 8 Block 2 (10-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 Block 3 and 4 Block 4.

- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.
- 10. Stitch Fabric M 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 27" Fabric M strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43" (unfinished).

11. Center Fabric B 9-1/4" x 64" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric B 9-1/4" x 46" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with butterfly stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to 1/4" sides starting and stopping detail 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press 8 borders out. Quilt Center



5. Stitch 2 Fabric G 3-3/8" triangles to short edges of







Unit 3c Make 4

a Fabric L 6-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 3a (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each Units 3b to 3c with fabrics indicated.

Arrange 2 Fabric E 3" squares with 1 each Units 1a (U1a) and 1b (U1b) in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.



Make a total of 8 Unit 5a (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 Unit 5b with fabric and units indicated.


Stitch a Fabric E 3" x 5-1/2" piece to a Unit 3b as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 6 (5-1/2" square unfinished).




8. Arrange 3" squares and units in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Make a total of 8 Block 2 (10-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 Block 3 and 4 Block 4.



- 9. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.
- Stitch Fabric M 1-1/2"x width of fabric strips to sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 27" Fabric M strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43" (unfinished).

11. Center Fabric B 9-1/4" x 64" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric B 9-1/4" x 46" borders on top and bottom of guilt center with butterfly stripe next to guilt center. Stitch borders to 1/4" sides starting and stopping detail 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press 8 borders out. Quilt 小 Center

12. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- 13. Sew **Fabric M** 2-1/4" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric M** 2-1/4" x 45-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 14. Sew **Fabric D** 3" x 64" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 3-3/4" x 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt to complete quilt center (50-1/2" x 70-1/2" unfinished).

- 15. Arrange 7 **Block 1**, 2 **Block 2**, 4 **Block 3**, and 1 **Block 4** on left side of quilt center in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together (20-1/2" x 70-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to left side of quilt center. Make and add right border in the same manner.
- 16. Arrange 4 **Block 1**, 2 **Block 2**, 2 **Block 3**, and 1 **Block 4** on top of quilt center in 7 rows. Stitch into row (10-1/2" x 90-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to top of quilt center. Make and add bottom border in the same manner.
- 17. Sew **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 90-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 94-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 18. The quilt measures approximately 94-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 19. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!




